LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox fell to the Erie SeaWolves last night by a 10-4 final. Things started promising for Bowie, as Zach Watson launched a solo home run on the first pitch of the bottom of the first and Billy Cook drove in a run on an RBI single. However, Erie would bounce back in a big way. Jake Holton would deliver a solo home run in the top of the second, before the SeaWolves plated six runs in the top half of the third. All six runs were charged to the tab of right-handed reliever Garrett Stallings, who gave up seven hits and only recorded two outs in the nine batters he faced. Colt Keith began the onslaught with a two-run home run to give Erie the lead, before RBI hits from Grant Witherspoon, Ben Malgeri, and Daniel Cabrera. Keith then drew a bases loaded walk against right-hander Xavier Moore for the final run of the frame. The SeaWolves added three additional runs with a bases clearing double by Dillon Dingler in the fifth. Billy Cook hit a two-run home run for Bowie in the bottom of the sixth, but it was only consolation in what was the fourth loss for the Baysox in their last five games, and the eighth loss in their last ten.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The SeaWolves enter tonight with a record of 12-14 and sit in third place in the Southwest division standings. The Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, The SeaWolves have hit 10 home runs in the series and lead the Eastern League with 30 home runs on the season. However, Erie has the worst staff ERA in the league at 5.76. SeaWolves arms has allowed the most hits (252), earned runs (151), and home runs (31) in the league. The SeaWolves welcome back Gabe Alvarez for his second season as the team's manager, alongside a mostly new staff. Erie's roster consists of nine of the Tigers' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline. Position players include infielders Colt Keith (No. 4 DET/ No. 94 overall), Wenceel Perez (No. 8 DET) and Gage Workman (No. 29 DET), along with C Dillon Dingler (No. 14 DET). Right-handers Wilmer Flores (No. 3 DET/ No. 85 overall), Ty Madden (No. 5 DET), Dylan Smith (No. 15 DET), and Elvis Alvarado (No. 23 DET), alongside left-hander Brant Hurter (No. 21 DET) feature on the mound.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

For the second time this series, Erie looks to start left-hander Brant Hurter on the mound. Hurter was incredibly effective against the Baysox through Tuesday's series opener, when he went five innings and only allowed one, unearned run on three hits, striking out a season-high seven. Hurter has been one of the most dominant arms in the Eastern League this season, allowing just one earned run across his five starts (21 innings) in 2023. Hurter's 0.43 ERA is the best in the Eastern League among qualifiers, and his .173 opposing average is tied for third-best in the league with today's projected Baysox starter, Chayce McDermott. Hurter is currently ranked as the No. 21 prospect in the Tigers' system, per MLB Pipeline. Originally a 7th round pick by Detroit in the 2021 draft out of Georgia Tech, his arsenal features a low-mid-90s sinker, a mid-80s slider, and a changeup.

AVOIDING THE TRAFFIC

Out of the 20 home runs hit by the Baysox this season, all of them have been either solo or two-run shots. Bowie is the only Eastern League team that has yet to hit a three-run homer or a grand slam in 2023. More specifically, 14 of the 20 home runs hit by the Baysox this season have been solo bombs, accounting for 70% of their long ball production. Only Portland has a higher portion of solo home runs in the Eastern League, at 76.5% (13/17).

HESTON IS BESTON

OF/1B Heston Kjerstad has shown out as one of the top bats in the Eastern League so far this season. Kjerstad launched his eighth home run of the season Friday night, putting him back atop the League leaderboards in that category. Beyond the home runs, the Orioles' No. 5 prospect has also demonstrated plenty offensive consistency - leading the Eastern League in slugging percentage (.671) and sitting third in OPS (1.044) among qualifiers, while standing second in extra-base hits (14) and total bases (59). Kjerstad has the most home runs and extra-base hits throughout the Orioles' system, while his OPS is third best and his slugging percentage is second. Kjerstad's standout start to the season earned him Orioles Minor League Player of the Month honors for April.

HAIL CESAR

INF Cesar Prieto continues to pace the Eastern League with his 35 hits and .361 batting average. Last night's 2-5 performance was Prieto's third-consecutive multi-hit game and his 11th multi-hit contest in his first 24 games of 2023. Prieto is currently riding a five-game hit streak, while his 11-game hitting streak last month is the second-longest in the Eastern League this season and is also the longest streak for any Orioles minor leaguer. Prieto's average leads Baltimore minor leaguers and hit total is second best on the Orioles' farm.

HOBBLING AT HOME

The Baysox have not enjoyed much success at home this season. Bowie is just 4-12 in games played at Prince George's Stadium this season - the worst home record in the Eastern League. The Baysox have been outscored by their opponents 89-62 at home this season. The Baysox have struggled containing the long ball in particular. Bowie arms have given up 25 of the staff's 30 home runs at home in 2023. The 25 home runs surrendered at home are the most in the Eastern League.

- Acquired by the Orioles this past July as a part of the Trey Mancini trade. Final start as an Astros farmhand was against Aberdeen, the team he would join four days later.
- Older brother Sean played in the NBA for the Memphis Grizzlies during the 2020-21 season

CAREER NOTES

- Pitched to a 6.08 ERA in Bowie across 6 starts and 26.2 innings last season. Held opponents to a .179 average but struggled with 20 walks and 7 home runs given up in a Baysox uniform.
- Made his Double-A debut for Bowie on 8/17 after making two brief appearances with High-A - his first two in the Orioles system. Surrendered 14 earned runs in his first two starts (8 IP) for Bowie, before finishing the season by allowing 4 ER in his final 4 starts (18.2 IP).
- Played two-plus seasons at Ball State. Originally drafted by the Houston Astros in the 4th round of the 2021 draft.
- Struck out 199 batters for Ball State in two seasons, across 139 innings. Redshirted his first season at Ball State in 2018 while recovering from Tommy John Surgery.
- Comes from a long legacy of Indiana basketball. Older brother Sean, played in the NBA for the Memphis Grizzlies during the 2020-21 season, and collegiately at Butler. Mother, Kim, played at Indiana State. Grandfather, Alan Danner, was a high school basketball coach who won two Indiana state titles, also in the Indiana Basketball Hall of Fame. Uncles, Linc and Tige, played at Purdue and Appalachian State, respectively. Uncle Linc was head men's basketball coach at D2 Florida Southern and won a national championship in 2015 - also coached Wisconsin-Green Bay and reached the March Madness tournament in 2016. Linc was Associate Head Coach at Ball State in 2022.

NOTES BY OUTING

- 4/12 Allowed a leadoff single in the first inning, but worked a double play. Allowed two doubles, but did not allow any runners to third base. After an efficient opening, 25 pitches in the fifth inning kept him from going further.
- 4/18 Labored over 21 pitches and two baserunners in the first inning, but retired eight consecutive batters into the fourth. Struck out five over four innings, but an error helped cut his fifth inning short, and a reliever allowed two inherited runners to score.
- 4/25 Relieved Houston Roth in tandem, allowed a triple to the first batter he faced, and a double to the same batter later (Tyler Fitzgerald) Both runs came from the same batter.
- 5/2 Walked first batter and allowed a home run to the second. Allowed a second home run later in the inning. 28 pitch first inning followed by six strikeouts over the next three scoreless innings.

Johnson's playing career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State.	Forrest Herrmann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitching coach of the Aberdeen IronBirds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series.
