Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Yorman Gomez** to the mound tonight, looking to run the winning streak to four (7-1 in last 8G). The Mets will counter with RHP **Jack Wenninger**. Columbus is 47-31 (.603) versus right handers this year. Wenninger has never pitched against Columbus in his career, as today will be his 20th career game in the International League.

vs. the Mets

The Clippers have won the season series in five of the last seven years they have played the Mets (lost in 2023, split in 2019) and have triumphed in 36 of 55G (.655) dating to 6/11/15. They were 2-4 in Syracuse in 2024 (5-1 in the home slate) and 2-3 at Syracuse in 2023. Individually, **George Valera** has hit .319 (15x47) with 7HR and 16RBI against Syracuse in 13G of his career (6HR in 7G at NBT).

Jump Start

Columbus has outscored the opposition 51-9 in the first four innings of the last 8G, taking a lead of at least three into the 5th of each one. Opponents have then outscored Columbus 33-17 from the 5th-9th, but have managed to complete only one comeback (Toledo on Saturday). Overall, Columbus is 59-23 when taking a lead this year (.719, 4th best in the IL) and 34-50 when trailing (.405, leads the IL).

Getting Offensive

Over the last 8G, the Clippers have plated a total of 68 runs (most in the IL, 8.5 per game), after coming out of the All-Star Break with 35 runs in the first 9G (16th in the IL, 3.9 per). Columbus had 2HR in 288AB of those first 9G, but have shaken off the rust to the tune of an IL-best 22HR in the last 265AB. The last week plus has seen a collective OPS of 1.006 (Scranton/WB is 2nd at .911).

Ingle is Back

In 20G since his option, **Cooper Ingle** is 34x84 (.405), drawing 12BB (.474OBP) with 14XBH (5HR, .690SLG). He is one of two in the IL (**Max Anderson**, Toledo), hitting .300/.400/.500, but his 11G hit streak was snapped last night (.479, 23x48 with 4HR and 15RBI from 7/23-8/4, multi-hit in eight straight). At catcher, Ingle has a 1.347OPS (14HR) in 38G (.675OPS and 3HR in 32G between DH and LF).

Major Players

David Fry (4/29/23) and **Kyle Manzardo** (8/30/24) have joined the team today, years since their last appearances on the active roster (Fry had a pair of rehab stints: 8/25-8/30/23, 5/26-5/30/25). Combined, the pair bring 48HR in 905AB in their Clipper careers, producing an .865OPS. **Daniel Schneemann** joined the Clippers last week (first game since 5/31/24; 1.039OPS in last 38G in Triple-A).

Take it on the Road

Ralph Velazquez had his 5G RBI streak snapped on Sunday, but finished the home stand 5x21 with a double, 3HR and 7RBI (6RBI in previous 13G). He was hitless over the last roadtrip (0x21 in St. Paul), but is 4x9 with 2HR and 4RBI this trip (first road HR since 7/8 at LHV). Velazquez owns a .670OPS in 27G on the road (4HR in 109AB), compared to .883 in 29G at home (5HR in 103AB).

Out of a Slump

After doubling twice on 6/25 at Omaha, **George Valera** hit .111 (8x72) with a .139SLG in his next 20G (6/27-7/28). On 7/30, he was 2x3 with a HR (snapped 124AB homerless streak) and his 150th career RBI as a Clipper (38th most all-time), and he has hit safely in six straight (.348, 8x23, .826SLG). Valera has scored eight times in his last 5G, crossing the 150 threshold there (38th all-time).

Serious Growth

Kody Huff clubbed his 17th HR of the season yesterday (all in last 277AB; had 17HR in previous 904AB, 6/1/23-4/5/26). Having already established career highs in runs, triples, RBI, walks, and steals, Huff is just four hits and four doubles from personal bests. He is 10x44 in his last 13G (5HR) and his .893OPS is 13th best in the IL (.682OPS in MiLB career prior; **Cooper Ingle** leads: 1.030).

Rare Company

Dating to the nightcap vs. Scranton/WB on 6/19, **Milan Tolentino** is 28x96 (.292) in his last 31G, collecting 16XBH (.583SLG) and 20RBI (was 5x39, .128, in 13G prior). He is one of 11 in the IL with at least 13HR and 13SB, along with **Kahlil Watson** (Columbus and Omaha are only IL teams with two). Tolentino is tied for the most homers in the IL since the start of the 2025 season (34; 0HR off LHP).

This Date in Clipper History

8/6/2004

Chien-Ming Wang shutout Indianapolis over 8.0 innings, scattering 5 hits with 4 strikeouts. It was the 2nd of Wang's 5 straight wins to end the year, but more importantly, the 1-0 victory put Columbus in sole possession of 1st place in the IL West. The Clippers would not look back, going 22-11 over the remainder of the season to capture the division title by 13.0 games. It was the Clippers' 12th IL West crown.

First Half Wrap

Despite being eliminated from playoff contention on the penultimate Sunday of the first half, the Clippers were 41-33 and finished with their first winning record in the front half since the season was split in 2023 (averaged 32 wins from 2023-25, topping out at 34-38, .472, last season). From 4/22-6/17, they spent every day between 3.0 and 6.0 games off the lead, while occupying anywhere between 4th and 13th in the standings. A late push (15-6 from 5/16-6/9) got them to within 2.5 before derailing with a 3G losing streak at Indy to seal their fate. On the back half, Columbus has posted just one winning record, clinching a playoff berth in 2024 with a mark of 48-26 (.649).

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,469 to 1,414).

Challenging Times

The Clippers are 158-125 (.558) in pitch reviews, with batters going 82-77 (.516) and pitchers/catchers going 76-48 (.613). They have run out of challenges in 43G and have not challenged in 5G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 5-4 in extra innings this year, after having gone .500 in each of the last two seasons. Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 55-37 when playing past regulation (.598, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 27-17 at home (.614; 5-7 in last 12G). Of the 92G to require extra play, 73 have been resolved after one frame (including nine DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 on 9/20/22 at Toledo).

On the Runs

Starting with the embiggened 150G schedule in 2022, the Clippers scored over 800 runs in three consecutive seasons from 2022-2024 (855, 808 and 805 runs, respectively; accounting for the 3rd, 4th and 5th best totals in team history). Following a steep decline last season (670, fewest scored in a full season since 2018), Columbus is looking to top 800 again (on pace for 826, would rank as 4th most all-time; record is 898 scored in 1983).

On the Run

On the basepaths, the Clippers are making a run at the franchise mark in stolen bases, with 127 through 108G (on pace for 174SB). The team record was set in 2024 when Columbus swiped an even 200, but the team speed was throttled last year (129SB; still, the 2nd highest total since the Cleveland affiliation started in 2009). However, with 35CS so far, the Clippers are also pacing for the 3rd most times caught stealing of the Cleveland affiliation (48; nabbed 51 times in 2024).

Crazy Eighth's

From the 8th inning on, the Clippers have scored an IL-best 159 runs while crafting an .899OPS (nearly 100 points better than all other teams). On the flipside, Columbus has given up 98 runs from the 8th on, resulting in a +61 run differential (Clippers are getting outscored 253-158 from innings 5-7).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 79 grand slams and 1,976RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

In Big Trouble

The Clipper pitching staff is trending toward the worst ERA in club history, sitting at 5.33 through the first 109G. Since the reorganization of the minor leagues in 2021, Columbus has twice finished the season with a 5+ ERA (current record is 5.32, set in 2023), after having done so just once in the first 43 seasons (5.08 in 1983). Additionally, the staff is pacing to give up 197HR (average of 182 per season since the Year of the Homer in 2019).

Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 6th in the IL this year (.981), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 60G this season (36-24, .600), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

Good Baseball

CJ Kayfus bunted a runner into scoring position with a single on 7/5 vs. Louisville, with that runner kicking off a 5-run inning that led the Clippers to victory. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 90-23 (.796) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 7-2 mark this season (.778, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers have the 4th most last at bat wins this year (14, four off the lead) while playing in the 7th most games decided in the last at bat (26, Memphis has 31). Since the start of the 2024 season, Columbus has played in 100G decided in the last at bat (2nd most in the IL), going 48-52 (.480, 16th best winning percentage; 3rd most wins, 2nd most losses).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 445-456 (.494), 415-410 with Columbus (.503).

Injury Delay:

Gomez was slated to make his Triple-A debut during the season-opening series at Iowa, but injured his shoulder in his last preseason bullpen to wind up on the shelf (missed 72G; Clippers went 40-32). He was sent to Arizona at the end of May to rehab, appearing in 4G for the Guardians.

Rocky Start:

When he did make his Triple-A debut, 6/20 vs. Scranton/WB, Gomez was touched for a 2-run homer in the 1st inning, but settled down to retire 10 of the next 12BF (7K). He has allowed only one run in the 1st inning since. While with the AZL Guardians, he gave up 5ER over the course of 4.0IP in the 1st inning and 2ER in 6.1IP thereafter.

Right Stuff:

While in the Rookie League, Gomez mowed down opposing right-handers, racking up 10K against 21BF (48%; 4K to 23BF on the left side, 17%). When they did put the bat on the ball (5x20, .250), righties notched 3XBH (all doubles; .400SLG), compared to 0XBH from lefties (5x17, .295). His strikeout rate in Triple-A is tilts left (20K against 65BF from the left and 16K vs. 65BF from the right), but right handers are still teeing off when they do connect (13x56, 4HR, .500SLG).

Racking Up Strikeouts:

Since his Triple-A debut on 6/20, Gomez has averaged 10.5K/9IP, good for the 2nd best rate in the IL (36K, 31.0IP), trailing only **Logan Allen** (10.7K/9IP; **Trenton Denholm** is 3rd, 10.2K/9IP). In terms sheer numbers, his 36K rank 10th in the IL (Allen is 1st, 44K, and Denholm is 2nd, 43K). As a team, the Clippers have the 4th most strikeouts in the league since 6/20 (332K in 37G, 9.0 per game; ranked 12th in the IL prior, 630K in 72G, 8.8 per).

Party Time:

Gomez has dominated on Fridays and Saturdays with Columbus, registering a 1.45ERA over 4GS (18.2IP, 3ER). After allowing 2ER in his first 1.0IP for the weekend, he has allowed just 1ER since, while posting 21K against 7BB. On all other days, his ERA sits at 10.22 (12.1IP, 14ER) and he has 15K to 7BB.

House of Horror:

Splitting his starts almost evenly between Huntington Park (4) and the rest of the IL (3), Gomez has allowed over four times more runs at home (14ER, has 3ER on the road) in just a few more innings (17.0IP at home, 14.0IP on the road).
