Last Time Out: Matt Hardy threw a career-high five innings in a spot start but Biloxi was held to just two hits in a 9-1 defeat on Sunday afternoon... Ryan Aguilar had one of Biloxi's two hits, a solo home run... By dropping Sunday's game, the Shuckers lost their series against Pensacola 4-2.

At the Plate: Brice is Nice: Brice Turang homered for the first time as a member of the Shuckers on Saturday night, launching a three-run blast in the bottom of the sixth inning... It was part of a 3-for-5 night where Turang recorded 4 RBI's and came up a triple shy of the cycle... His 4 RBI's was a new career high for the 2018 first-round pick... Turang ended the Pensacola series hitting .308 with 1 HR, 1 2B and 4 RBI's.

Movin' on Up; RHP Bowden Francis was promoted to Triple-A Nashville on Satruday. In his second stint with the Shuckers, Francis had a 3.86 ERA in a team leading 21 innings of work... Alongside Francis, RHP Jake Cousins was also promoted to Nashville... Cousins, who was working as the Shuckers closer, pitched two scoreless inngings for Nashville in their Friday night win over the Columbus Clippers.

Slammin' Shuckers: Brent Diaz hit a grand slam in the top of the 7th inning on 5/23 against the Smokies.. It was the second grand slam in three days for Biloxi... David Fry hit a grand slam in the third inning on Friday, part of an 8-6 win.

Good Eye: Biloxi drew a franchise-record 16 walks against the Barons on May 6... They did fall short of the Southern League record for walks in a game (19 - Huntsville vs. Columbus 4/20/89)... The Shuckers 13 walks in the 6th inning is more than the record for base on balls in a single inning in both the American League (11 - Yankees in '49) and National League (9 - Cincinnati in '57)... Every batter drew at least one walk in the 6th as Biloxi sent 18 men to the plate against four differnt Barons pitchers... The lone hit of the inning was a 2 RBI single by Brice Turang.

On the Mound: No-Hitter!: Ethan Small, Zach Vennaro, Nathan Kirby and Matt Hardy combined to toss nine no-hit innings against the Mississippi Braves on 5/15.. Small tossed the first five innings, striking out six in the longest outing of his career, picking up his first win.... It is the second no-hitter in Shuckers' history, after Biloxi no-hit the Tennessee Smokies on 8/15/17 in Game 2 of doubleheader, with four pitchers (Hiram Burgos, Forrest Snow, Nick Ramirez, Jorge Lopez) combining to blank the Smokies in a 1-0 win.

Caught in the Webb: After recorded his first save of the season on Thursday night, Braden Webb allowed a go-ahead grand slam in the top of the ninth inning on Friday night vs. Pensacola... The grand slam ended a streak of six straight scoreless appearance, spanning 7.2 innings.... Webb appeared in four of the Shuckers six games against the Blue Wahoos and leads the Double-A South in appearances (11).

Heating up Down South: Nick Bennett made his first start at the AA level on 5/29 against Pensacola... Bennett turned in a quality out in his start, tossing 6.0 innigns and allowing three earned runs while not issuing a walk and striking out seven.

Two-Way Player: Lucas Erceg made his fifth appearance as a pitcher on Sunday afternoon, pitching 1.0 inning and allowing three runs... As a position player this season, he's hitting .256/.347/.395 with 3 2B, HR, 2 RBI, 6 BB and 6 K...The Shuckers have had a two-way player on the roster in each of the last four season (Nick Ramirez: 1B/LHP - 2017 & 2018, Clayton Andrews: LHP/OF - 2019)

What's Shuckin: International Duty: INF Luis Castro and OF Alexander Palma are on the temporary inactive list as they are away from the team playing with the Venezuelan National Team for Olympic Qualifiers... The Venezuelan National Team picked up a 6-5 win over Cuba on Monday and is scheduled to play Columbia on Tuesday and Canada on Wednesday (12 pm CST).

#ShuckersInTheShow: Ten players from the 2019 Biloxi Shuckers have made their Major League debut: Anthony Bender (Miami), Alec Bettinger (Brewers), Mario Feliciano (Brewers), Trent Grisham (Brewers), Angel Perdomo (Brewers), Cody Ponce (Pirates), Drew Rasmussen (Brewers), Corey Ray (Brewers), Justin Topa (Brewers), and Devin Williams (Brewers)...
