CARDIAC FREDNATS: After another walk-off win last night - Fredericksburg's Single-A leading eighth of the season - the FredNats can earn a series win for the first time in a month with one more victory on the weekend against Salem. Tonight's Saturday Theme Night is Harry Potter presented by Red Door Pro Wash. Tonight, LHP Liam Sullivan makes his fourth start for Fredericksburg since returning from Tommy John surgery in July. In his first three starts, Sullivan has covered 12.2 innings and allowed just seven hits and three runs. He has 18 strikeouts and only two walks, and is coming off a scoreless start in Myrtle Beach last week. He faces Salem righty Jesus Travieso, who has not faced the FredNats this season.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Fredericksburg and Salem were at a scoreless stalemate until the 5th inning of last night's Fredericksburg Frogs game, and then the FredNat offense scored single runs in the 5th and 6th to take a 2-0 lead into the 7th. Salem's Maximus Martin blasted a three-run homer to give the Sox a lead, but FBG tied the game in the 7th on Nick Hollifield's RBI single, and then got three straight hits in the 9th to tie the game at four. Hollifield again drove in the tying run. Then, with the winning run at third base and Luke Dickerson at the plate, Salem's Eybersson Polanco balked in the winning run for a 5-4 FredNat walk-off victory.

STANDINGS WATCH: With Fredericksburg's win and Carolina's loss last night, the FredNats are now just 1.0 game out of first place in the 2nd half in the North Division. Fayetteville, Carolina's opponent this week, is nipping at the FredNats' heels, just 1.0 game behind FBG and 2.0 games behind Carolina. Fredericksburg and Fayetteville square off next week at VACU Stadium in what will be a very big series for the 2nd half standings, and then Carolina will visit VACU Stadium the last week of the regular season in a series that could decide the title.

HE'S INEVITABLE: FredNat outfield prospect Cristhian Vaquero picked up his MiLB-leading fourth walk-off hit of the season last home stand, and overall, he's enjoyed a very strong second half of the season offensively, pairing his hot bat with his exceptional outfield defense. In 29 second half games, Vaquero is fifth in the league in batting average (.310), fifth in OPS (.858), and he leads the league among active players in slugging (.496). He's also fifth in hits (40) and sixth in extra-base hits (11). He also picked up his 11th outfield assist of the season last week.

INSTANT IMPACT: Fredericksburg currently has four members of Washington's 2025 draft class on the roster, and each player has made an instant impact since arriving to the team. Wyatt Henseler (9th round - Texas A&M) leads the group with nine games played and a slash line of .345/.472/.379 for an OPS of .851, and he has hits in seven out of nine games played. Ethan Petry (2nd round - South Carolina) has four hits and four walks in his first four games, Nick Hollifield (14th round - UAB) has five hits, five RBI and five runs scored in six games, including two game-tying RBI singles in the 7th and 9th innings last night. Jacob Walsh (15th round - Oregon), also has two hits including an RBI double in his first three professional games with Fredericksburg.

START EARLY: The FredNats are 53-53 overall this season, but are 18 games over .500 (32-14) when scoring first in 2025. In the first two innings this season, Fredericksburg has been outscored 77-115 (-38).

WHY TRY IT?: Fredericksburg's MiLB-leading caught stealing total is up to 82. Heading into play today, Kevin Bazzell leads MiLB by six with 53 caught stealings and owns the best CS% of all MiLB catchers who have played at least 400 innings this year, throwing out 43% of would-be base stealers. Fredericksburg has excelled the most at throwing out base runners against Salem, nabbing 12 out of 24 potential base stealers this season.

THE STAFF: After Jake Lowery's third season as Manager of the FredNats ended in a Carolina League championship in 2024, the FredNats welcome Billy McMillon as the third Manager in Fredericksburg franchise history. McMillon, 53, has spent the last three seasons in the Nationals organization as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. He also played parts of six seasons in the Major Leagues with Oakland, Detroit, Philadelphia and Florida. He's joined on the staff by returning Pitching Coach Justin Lord, returning Hitting Coach Mike Habas, Development Coach Luis Ordaz, returning Athletic Trainer Jacob Meyer, Strength & Conditioning Coach Mike Reiskind, and Performance Analyst Samantha Unger.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014. The franchise won its first league title as the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2024, defeating the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers two games to one to win the title at Virginia Credit Union Stadium.

LAST TIME OUT: Sullivan dominated a piping-hot Myrtle Beach offense in his last start on 8/8. The lefty led the way with 4.2 innings of one-hit, one-run ball, striking out eight Pelicans in the process. Since his return from injury, Sullivan has had eight strikeouts in two of his three starts.

OVER BEFORE IT STARTED: Sullivan got off to a promising start in 2024, making two strong starts in which he allowed a total of just two earned runs in 9.1 innings with a remarkable 17 strikeouts. Unfortunately, that's where his year came to an end. After his second start, the lefty was placed on the full-season injured list and underwent season-ending elbow surgery.

BEACH BALL: In the last step of his recovery process this year, Sullivan pitched in eight games at the FCL level before being activated from the injured list on 7/18. Across 20 innings, the third-year pro allowed only eight hits and three earned runs, as he struck out 28 hitters.

GO DAWGS: Sullivan was taken by the Nationals in the 13th round of the 2023 MLB Draft out of the University of Georgia, where he enjoyed a fantastic career with the Bulldogs. In three SEC seasons, the Sandy Springs native posted a 4.95 ERA across 151 innings with 178 strikeouts. During his final season in 2023, he threw Georgia's first SEC complete-game shutout since 2014, when he allowed just four hits in nine innings against 10th-ranked Kentucky.

BILLY MCMILLON - MANAGER

1st Season | Previously: Development Coach, Triple-A Rochester

McMillon, 53, joined Washington in 2022 and has spent the last three seasons as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. McMillon played parts of six Major League seasons with four different organizations, including the Oakland Athletics (2001-04), Detroit Tigers (2000-01), Philadelphia Phillies (1997), and Florida Marlins (1996-97). The former Clemson Tiger was a three-time International League All-Star and the 1996 IL Rookie of the Year with Charlotte, earning him induction into the IL Hall of Fame in 2019 and Charlotte's Round Table of Honor in 2022. McMillon was initially selected in the eighth round of the 1993 MLB Draft by Florida. He replaces Jake Lowery, who managed the FredNats the last three seasons, culminating in a championship last year. Lowery will manage High-A Wilmington in 2025.

Prior to joining Washington, McMillon coached in the Boston Red Sox organization for over a decade. He managed the Worcester Red Sox (Triple-A) in their inaugural season in 2021 after managing Boston's former Triple-A affiliate Pawtucket in 2019. He was set to lead the PawSox again in 2020 before the cancellation of the MiLB season. Prior to managing at the Triple-A level, McMillon was the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for Boston from 2016-18 after managing for six seasons in the organization with Double-A Portland (2014-15), High-A Salem (2012-13), and Single-A Greenville (2010-11). His coaching career began in 2008 when he was Greenville's Hitting Coach.

3rd Season | Previously: Pitching Coach, Double-A Harrisburg

Lord, 45, returns to Fredericksburg for a third season in 2025 after leading the FredNats' championship pitching staff last season, including the 2024 Carolina League Pitcher of the Year Travis Sykora.

This is Lord's fifth total season coaching in the Washington organization after a six-year professional playing career and several seasons coaching in the Baltimore system. The Alabama native and Florida State alum was scheduled to be the Fredericksburg Pitching Coach in the canceled 2020 season, and was the Pitching Coach for one season in Double-A Harrisburg prior to joining the FredNats in 2023.

While coaching with Gary, he was also the Head Coach at Prairie State College, a Junior College in the Chicago area.
