**This Afternoon:** The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the middle affair in a three-game season-opening series at the Dayton Dragons, the High-A affiliate of the Cincinnati Reds. The Nuts won the season opener last night and have defeated the Dragons in their last five meetings in the Gem City.

**Last Night:** Lugnuts 1, Dragons 0. James González, Mitch Myers and Colton Johnson (making his first MiLB appearance in 945 days) combined on a four-hit shutout and Cameron Masterman doubled home Will Simpson with two outs in the sixth inning, helping the Lugnuts spoil Rhett Lowder's professional debut on Opening Night at Day Air Ballpark.

**2023 Retrospective:** The Lugnuts finished the season with a 60-71 record... catcher **Daniel Susac** won the Midwest League batting title with a .303 average... 11 former Lugnuts (**Ryan Noda**, **Hogan Harris**, **Mason Miller**, **Garrett Acton**, **Samad Taylor**, **Tyler Sodestrom**, **Lawrence Butler**, **Hagen Danner**, **Drew Millas**, **Joey Estes** and **José Espada**) made their Major League debuts, bringing the total to 184 MLB Lugnuts all-time... **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.** who played in the 2016 Crosstown Showdown, won the 2023 All-Star Home Run Derby... reliever **Kumar Nambiar** represented the Minor League Baseball Players' union in a panel of new labor unions with President Biden and Vice President Harris at the White House; Nambiar retired at the end of the season and now works in the Baltimore Orioles' analytics department... the World Series was won by the Texas Rangers, with assistant hitting coach **Seth Conner** (2013-14 with Lansing), over the Arizona Diamondbacks, starring 2019 Nuts catcher **Gabriel Moreno** and 2014 pitcher **Miguel Castro**.

**A Good First Impression:** The Lugnuts played the Michigan State Spartans on Wednesday in the 16th Crosstown Showdown exhibition, winning easily 18-0. Pitchers **Grant Judkins**, **Hunter Breault** and **Yehizon Sanchez** combined to hold the Spartans to two base runners on a pair of base hits while the offense blasted four home runs: a solo shot and a grand slam from **Will Simpson** and three-run homers by **Joshwan Wright** and **Henry Bolte**. Wright reached base in all four plate appearances (single, homer, two walks), but was outdone by **Colby Halter**, who reached base five times thanks to two singles, two walks and an HBP.

**Prospecting:** The Nuts' Opening Day roster includes two MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects in outfielder **Henry Bolte** (No. 12) and first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 30). Bolte, the A's No. 2 outfield prospect, was selected 56th overall in 2022 from Palo Alto High School, where he led all California high schoolers with 13 home runs. He spent the 2023 season with Single-A Stockton, where he slashed .257/.356/.421 in 112 games, collecting 17 doubles, five triples, 14 home runs and 32 stolen bases. Simpson, the A's No. 2 first base prospect, impressed with a .319/.367/.543 line in his professional debut after he was drafted in the 15th round from the University of Washington last year.

**Familiar Faces:** Lansing returns 17 players from the 2023 ballclub, not including second-year manager **Craig Conklin** and fourth-year pitching coach **Don Schulze**. The returners include **James Gonzalez**, **Euribiel Angeles**, **Brayan Buelvas**, **Jonny Butler** and **Joshwan Wright**, each of whom appeared in games for the Lugnuts in both 2022 and 2023, as well as lefty **Jack Owen**, who has pitched effectively for the Lugnuts during each of the last three seasons.

**Come Together:** The Lugnuts' Opening Day roster includes players representing 10 states, Puerto Rico, and five countries: Canada, Colombia, Dominican Republic, Panama and Venezuela.

**Pure Fire:** On Tuesday, 2022 Lugnut **Mason Miller** delivered the five fastest pitches clocked in the Majors this year in a two-inning scoreless stint vs. Boston, ranging from 101.4 mph to 102.4 mph. Miller's third and final appearance for the Lugnuts was on September 10, 2022, vs. the Dayton Dragons, whiffing seven batters in three hitless innings. He made his Major League debut seven months later.

### TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**1996:** The Lugnuts notch their first ever victory, steamrolling the Rockford Cubbies, 18-3.

**2010:** Opening Day at Cooley Law School Stadium saw Noah Syndergaard strike out six in three scoreless innings, Anthony DeSclafani strike out four in three scoreless innings, Great Lakes starter Jarret Martin commit three throwing errors (leading to two unearned runs), and Kevin Patterson's RBI single in the eighth inning push the Lugnuts to a 3-2 win over the Loons. It was the first of seven straight wins to open the Lugnuts' season.

**Home Cooking:** Also from Tucson: Alex Verdugo, four-time All-Star Ian Kinsler, two-time All-Star J.J. Hardy, Cardinals All-Star catcher Tom Pagnozzi and Ron Hassey... in all, Tucson ranks second behind Phoenix in producing Major Leaguers from the Grand Canyon State.

**Glory Days:** Boasting a 96 mph fastball, Dicochea was highly regarded coming out of Sahuarita High School, ranked the No. 1 prep prospect in Arizona by Baseball America entering the 2019 draft... twirled a no-hitter in the state semifinals... signed for \$400,000... signing scout: Scott Cousins... signed away from commitment to University of Arizona... senior year stats: 1.30 ERA, 54 IP, 24 H, 10 ER, 11 BB, 86 K... in addition to pitching, also starred at shortstop.

**Minor League Path:** Dicochea opened his professional career in the 2019 Arizona League after signing, but his 2021 campaign was halted in Single-A Stockton due to injury on June 6 after only six appearances, five starts... returned from Tommy John surgery on August 12, 2022, and made two appearances in the Arizona Complex League before returning to Stockton on August 26, 2022... finished the year with three appearances for the Ports.

**Bagels in April:** Opened 2023 as the Ports' No. 4 starter, firing four scoreless innings at Fresno on April 11... that was the start of three consecutive scoreless outings to begin the year, finishing April with 13 2/3 scoreless innings... didn't allow first run until May 3 vs. Fresno, entering in relief in the fifth inning and allowing two runs in the fifth and two more in the seventh in a 5-4 Ports win... in total with Stockton, posted a 2.42 ERA with a .132 average against in five road starts (22 1/3 IP) compared to 4.24 ERA, .200 avg. in four home appearances (17 IP)... lefties hit .111/.243/.175 compared to righties' .205/.279/.308... base stealers went 2-for-2.

**Rave Reviews:** Dicochea was promoted from Single-A Stockton to Lansing on June 13, 2023, to replace Jack Perkins, who was transferred up to Double-A Midland... coincidentally, an article about Dicochea had just been written by MLB.com A's beat writer Martin Gallegos a day earlier, quoting A's GM David Forst in including Dicochea's name among the top pitching prospects in the system (Royber Salinas, Gunnar Hoglund, J.T. Ginn and Joey Estes). Wrote Gallegos about Dicochea, "Dicochea, an eighth-round selection by the A's in the 2019 MLB Draft out of Sahuarita (Ariz.) High School, ranks just outside Oakland's Top 30 Prospects list. But his inclusion in that group from Forst speaks volumes about how highly he is viewed. In nine games (seven starts) for Single-A Stockton this season, Dicochea holds a 3.20 ERA with 47 strikeouts against 17 walks in 39 1/3 innings. He has held opposing batters to a .163 average, which ranks lowest among all California League pitchers with at least 30 innings pitched. Dicochea's development hit a snag early in his pro career after he underwent Tommy John surgery in 2021. Since his return from injury, the 22-year-old right-hander is taking a big step forward this season, showing off a fastball that consistently hits 95 mph along with a solid slider and a changeup he's recently added to his mix. A's assistant general manager and director of player personnel Billy Owens added, "He's off to a promising start. Averaging well over a strikeout per inning. Overall, his command has taken a step forward. He's definitely an interesting arm on the horizon."
