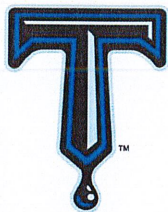

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

RHP Roque Gutierrez (7-1, 4.73 ERA)

The 23-year-old was signed by the Los Angeles Dodgers as an international free agent on September 10, 2020, out of Mexico.

In his professional career, Gutierrez is 23-12 with a 4.94 ERA in 128 games (31 starts) while giving up 360 hits, 222 runs, 198 earned runs, 48 home runs and 140 walks with 382 strikeouts in 360.2 IP.

In 2025, Gutierrez pitched for Great Lakes and Tulsa. He was a combined 7-2 with a 4.69 ERA in 25 games (12 starts) while giving up 95 hits, 53 runs, 49 earned runs, 14 home runs and 42 walks with 103 strikeouts in 94.0 IP.

In his 14 games (11 starts) for Tulsa in 2025, Gutierrez was 2-2 with a 5.56 ERA while giving up 67 hits, 38 runs, 34 earned runs, 9 home runs and 23 walks with 52 strikeouts in 55.0 IP.

In his 21 games (7 starts) in 2026, Gutierrez is 7-1 with a 4.73 ERA while giving up 62 hits, 40 runs, 35 earned, 13 home runs and 28 walks with 51 Ks in 66.2 IP.

In his 35 career games (17 starts) for Tulsa, Gutierrez is 9-3 with a 5.10 ERA while giving up 129 hits, 78 runs, 69 ERs, 22 HRs and 51 walks with 103 Ks in 121.2 IP.

In his last appearance on August 16 against Arkansas, Gutierrez pitched 2.1 innings and gave up 1 hit, 0 runs and 2 walks with 2 Ks.

In his last start on July 21 against Arkansas, Gutierrez pitched 5.1 innings while giving up 2 hits, 0 runs and 2 walks with 5 Ks.

In his relief appearances in August, Gutierrez is 0-0 with a 21.00 ERA while giving up 7 hits, 7 runs, 3 HRs and 3 walks with 2 Ks in 3.0 IP.

In his one start against Amarillo on June 7, Gutierrez pitched 3.0 innings and gave up 3 hits, 1 run and 2 walks with 4 Ks.

Gutierrez is 4-0 with a 3.86 ERA in 10 games (2 starts) at ONEOK Field. In 11 road games (4 starts), he is 3-1 with a 5.27 ERA.

In his six starts, Gutierrez is 2-0 with a 3.86 ERA. In 15 relief appearances, Gutierrez is 5-1 with a 5.19 ERA.

Right-handed hitters are batting .193 in 150 at-bats against Gutierrez and left-handed hitters are batting .330 in 100 ABs.

Gutierrez has given up the most runs this season in the fourth inning with 12. Opponents are batting .341 in the fourth.

Gutierrez is 3-1 with a 7.09 ERA in 8 day games (2 starts) and is 4-0 with a 3.15 ERA in 13 night games (4 starts).

GAMEDAY NOTES

The Drillers are 9-10 and batting .273 with a 5.10 ERA on Sundays. In day games, Tulsa is 12-9 and is batting .267 and has a 5.14 ERA.

The last time a Tulsa player had an 100 RBI season was Joe Koshansky (109) in 2006. The last time a player scored 100 runs in a season was Tim Wheeler (105) in 2011. Both are single season franchise records. De Paula currently has 95 RBI and 95 runs scored. Carlos Pena is the only Drillers player to ever finish a season with 100 RBI and 100 runs, doing it in 2000.

Tulsa is currently 2.0 games behind Springfield in the TL North Second Half with 19 games remaining in the regular season. The Drillers have never won both the first and second half titles in the same season. If the Drillers win both halves, the second best team in the second half of the TL North will clinch the playoff berth. Tulsa also leads by 12.0 games for the best overall record. The 2018 Drillers were the last team to have the best overall record in the TL finishing 74-65.

The Drillers 63.0% winning percentage puts them on an historic pace as no Drillers team has ever won 60% of its games for an entire season, and it has been nearly 60 years since a Tulsa professional team has won at a better pace. The 1968 Tulsa Oilers, who played in the Triple-A Pacific Coast League, finished with a 95-53 record and a .642 winning % and were the last Tulsa team to win at a higher %. The winningest Drillers team by total wins were the 1998 & 2019 squads that each finished with 78 victories. The Drillers team with the best winning % was the 1992 team. They finished with a 77-59 record and a .566 winning %.

The Drillers currently have the second-best full-season record among full-season Minor League teams. Bowling Green has the best record in Minor League Baseball at 76-41.

The Drillers have a team batting average of .259 against Amarillo this season and have a 4.87 team ERA. De Paula leads qualified Drillers players batting .298 with four HRs and 16 RBI, and pitchers Cam Day, Carson Hobbs and Christian Ruebeck have not allowed an earned run against Amarillo in 16.2 combined IP.

This week against Amarillo, Tulsa has the second lowest batting average in the TL at .210 and a 4.40 ERA.

The Drillers are 7-4 in the first 11 games of the two-week home stand and are batting .252 and have a 4.63 ERA during this stretch.

The Drillers have hit 48 home runs in the last 23 games, which trails only Triple-A Columbus for the most in all of Minor League Baseball during that span.

The Drillers are currently 10-9 in August and have a team batting average of .242. Tulsa has a 4.73 ERA in August and has struck out 217, which is the most in Double A.

Over the past 56 games, Tulsa has a .255 team batting average, the fifth highest in the TL, and has drawn 282 walks, the most in the TL during that span. Tulsa starting pitchers are 12-13 and have a 5.96 ERA over the last 56 games, which is the third highest in Double A, and the relievers are 21-10 have a 3.61 ERA in that span, which is the lowest in Double A. Tulsa pitchers have also given up 65 home runs during that span with 57 coming in the last 45 games.

The Drillers have recorded 399 of their 692 RBI this season and 85 of their 168 home runs while batting .261 against relievers compared to batting .267 against starters.

Tulsa's 40 home wins are the most in Double A and 35 road wins are tied with Amarillo for the most in Double A.

Since the Drillers ended their season-long, five-game losing streak on May 16, they are 55-27 and second in Double A batting .270 and in hits with 752. Tulsa leads in runs scored (527), home runs (130), walks drawn (422) and OPS (.839). Tulsa has also scored at least six runs in 51 of the last 82 games.

Tulsa has 42 comeback victories this season with 24 coming at ONEOK Field and 18 on the road. The Drillers have scored 125 combined runs in the eighth and ninth innings, which are the second most in the TL. The Drillers largest comeback win was when they rallied from five runs down twice on April 22 at Frisco in game two of a DH and on June 13 against Wichita.

The Drillers are 41-15 when scoring first and have scored first in 33 of 58 road games and in 23 of 60 home games.

De Paula is currently second for the highest average in the TL at .312 and leads in hits with 138, runs scored with 95, RBI with 32 and OPS at .965.

The Drillers have allowed a combined 254 runs (226 ER) to score in the first, second and third innings for a 5.70 ERA, which is the second highest ERA in those innings in Double A. Tulsa's offense also leads Double A for the most combined runs scored in the first, second and third innings with 259.

Tulsa's pitching staff has issued 584 walks, which are the most in Double A. The Drillers offense leads Double A in walks drawn with 605.

The Drillers have a 1.60 ERA in the ninth inning, the second best in the Double A and are hitting .274 in that inning, the third best in Double A.

Cam Day has not allowed a run in his last six outings, spanning 10.1 IP. Jacob Kmatz has not allowed a run in any of his five appearances for the Drillers across 7.2 IP.

De Paula has reached base in seven straight games and 12 times total during that span. During the streak, he is batting .321 with 9 hits, 1 double, 3 home runs, 3 walks and 9 RBI.

Kole Myers has earned a hit in five straight games and eight total during that span.

DRILLERS DROP SECOND STRAIGHT— After rallying from four runs down, the Amarillo Sod Poodles scored three of the game's final four runs to defeat the Tulsa Drillers 7-6 on Saturday night at ONEOK Field. Amarillo gained a 4-0 advantage in the first inning when Alberto Barriga hit an RBI single and Angel Ortiz hit a three-run homer. Tulsa used two home runs to take a 5-4 lead using a solo blast from Taylor Young and a grand slam by Chris Newell. The Sod Poodles scored the next three runs using an RBI single, a wild pitch and Avery Owusu-Asiedu's solo home run. The Drillers scored a final run in the eighth inning when Jake Gelof blasted his 26th homer of the season.
