SUNDAY SUCCESS: INF Ryan McBroom hit a three-run homer in the first inning and **INF Emmanuel Rivera** hit a two-run homer in the second inning to help propel the Omaha Storm Chasers to a 7-4 win over Louisville on Sunday at Werner Park. The win gave the Chasers a series win over the Bats and improved Omaha's record on Sunday to 7-0 this season. **LHP Daniel Lynch** allowed a season-high nine hits, but held Louisville to three runs (two earned) in 4.0 innings while **RHP Grant Gavin** tossed 3.0 innings, allowing one unearned run and **LHP Richard Lovelady** and **RHP Tyler Zuber** each threw scoreless innings to close out the Sunday night win.

RED HOT RIVERA: INF Emmanuel Rivera finished the week against Louisville going 12-for-23 (.522) with five home runs and nine RBIs in six games. He's hit safely in a season-high eight straight games, batting .484 (15-for-31) in that span with six home runs, 14 runs scored, 11 RBIs, and a .529 on-base percentage. Rivera now leads the league with 37 RBIs while also leading the team with 47 hits, 30 runs scored, and 10 doubles. His 13 home runs are second on the team, second in the league, and already a career high for a season (previous was 12 in 2017). After batting .253 with five homers in 22 games in May, Rivera is batting .368 with eight homers in 16 games in June.

McBOOM GOES THE DYNAMITE: INF/OF Ryan McBroom hit his 14th home run of the season on Sunday, a mark that leads the league and is tied for third in all of Minor League Baseball. He hit two home runs in the series against Louisville after smashing four home runs—including a three-homer game on 6/13 @ STP—the week before in St. Paul.

MEIBRYS MAGIC: C Meibry Vilorio leads the team and is fifth in Triple-A East with a .405 on-base percentage. Vilorio is currently in the midst of a 16-game on-base streak (5/29-pres.) after beginning the season with a 14-game on-base streak from 5/4-5/27. Overall, Vilorio has reached base in 30 of the 31 games he's played this season, extending his current streak with an intentional walk in his final plate appearance on Sunday. The only time he was kept off base this season was on 5/27 vs. IND, when he went 0-for-4. Vilorio also leads the team with 19 walks.

OLIVARES ON TOP: OF Edward Olivares has been recalled by Kansas City and optioned to Triple-A Omaha three times in the last three weeks. He was initially recalled on 5/30, then optioned on 6/3, recalled again on 6/6, optioned again on 6/9, recalled once more on 6/14, and optioned back to Omaha on 6/17. Despite playing only six games with the Chasers in June, Olivares still qualifies for the Triple-A East league leaderboards and ranks first in average (.370), second in on-base percentage (.447), and eighth in slugging (.593). In seven total games with Kansas City, Olivares has gone 6-for-23 (.292) with three runs scored and a stolen base.

BEST OF THE BEST: At 29-12 (.707), the Omaha Storm Chasers have the second-best record in Minor League Baseball, trailing Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (28-11, .718), but lead all of MiLB in wins (29). Omaha leads the Triple-A East Midwest Division by 6.0 games, which is tied for the largest divisional lead in all of baseball.

HOME RUN HEROES: The Storm Chasers lead Triple-A East and all of Minor League Baseball with 83 home runs (41 games), an average of more than two home runs per game. The Chasers' 83 home runs are also more than 12 Major League teams and tied with the Milwaukee Brewers. Omaha has recorded at least one home run in 27 of its last 29 games—including a 13-game homer streak from 5/16-6/1—and has recorded 19 multi-homer games, including three-four homer games, five five-homer games, and one seven-homer game. **INF Ryan McBroom** currently leads the league with 14 home runs, **INF Emmanuel Rivera** is second with 13, and **INF Gabriel Cancel** is tied for sixth in the league with 10. Omaha is the only team in the league with three players with 10+ home runs.

FOR OMAHA: RHP Jakob Junis makes his third start with Omaha this season. He last pitched on 6/17 vs. LOU, tossing 3.0 scoreless innings with five strikeouts and zero walks, allowing just two hits on 43 pitches (31 strikes). Prior to his two starts in 2021, Junis last pitched for Omaha in 2017, when he was named Omaha Pitcher of the Year after posting a 2.92 ERA in 71.0 innings. The right-hander began the year with Kansas City, posting a 5.19 ERA in 15 appearances (five starts) with 35 strikeouts and 11 walks in 34.2 innings. He recorded a 4.37 ERA in 22.2 innings as a starter and a 6.75 ERA in 12.0 innings as a reliever. Junis made four consecutive starts from Apr. 7-27 before moving to the bullpen and pitching in relief of LHP Daniel Lynch in his Major League debut on May 3.

FOR IOWA: RHP Matt Swarmer makes his fourth start with Iowa after turning in his best start of the year in his last outing. On 6/16 @ STP, Swarmer went a season-best 6.0 innings (after previously pitching no more than 2.2), allowing one run on four hits with three strikeouts and no walks. Swarmer made his first I-Cubs start of the season against Omaha on 6/4 at Werner Park, allowing seven runs on nine hits—including three home runs—in 2.2 innings before the Chasers knocked him out of the game with six runs on seven consecutive hits in the third inning.

DOPPLER RADAR: INF Ryan O'Hearn was recalled by Kansas City on Monday after 19 games with Omaha, where he hit .375/.451/.931 with four doubles, 12 home runs, and 25 RBIs... Since a three-game losing streak at Principal Park from 5/19-5/21, Omaha has won 21 of its last 26 games and has not lost back-to-back games.

JUNIS CAREER NOTES

- Began season with Kansas City, posting a 5.19 ERA in 15 appearances (five starts) with 35 strikeouts and 11 walks in 34.2 innings
- Recorded a 4.37 ERA in 22.2 innings as a starters (five starts) and a 6.75 ERA in 12.0 innings (12 appearances) as a reliever
- Began the 2020 season on the Injured List and made his season debut in the team's 10th game, ultimately making eight appearances (six starts) between two stints on the Injured List
- His final two appearances of 2020 were relief appearances, throwing a pair of scoreless innings on 9/23 vs. STL and 9/25 vs. DET
- Made a career-high 31 starts in 2019 and matched a career best with 164 strikeouts (also 2018), a mark that led the Royals
- Of his 164 strikeouts, over 70% came on his slider (115), the fourth-most strikeouts on sliders in the Major Leagues, trailing Patrick Corbin (161), Justin Verlander (127), and Matthew Boyd (118)
- Allowed 31 home runs in 31 starts, tied for sixth-most in the American League and one shy of his career high (2018)
- Had a career-high 10 strikeouts on 7/15 vs. CWS, all on his slider, to become the fourth pitcher in the Statcast era (2015-pres.) to strike out at least 10 batters with a slider in a single game (Jon Gray, Francisco Liriano, Chris Archer)
- Made his first Opening Day roster in 2018, eventually leading the Royals in starts (30), innings (177.0), and strikeouts (164)
- Named Royals Pitcher of the Month for August of 2017, his rookie year, by posting a 2.96 ERA in 27.1 innings that was tops among American League rookies (min. four starts)
- Posted a 2.92 ERA in 71.0 innings with Triple-A Omaha in 2017, earning Omaha Pitcher of the Year honors
- Named Northwest Arkansas Pitcher of the Year in 2016, ranking third in the Texas League with a 3.25 ERA in 119.0 innings
- Led the Carolina League in innings (155.2) and was second in strikeouts (123) with High-A Wilmington in 2015
- Bypassed a scholarship to NC State to sign with the Royals after being drafted out of Rock Falls High School (Ill.)
- Earned all-state honors in baseball and basketball as a senior in high school
