### FRISCO TAKES SATURDAY GAME BEHIND THREE RUNS IN THE NINTH:

The Frisco RoughRiders scored three runs in the ninth inning after entering down by one to beat the Midland RockHounds 7-5 on Saturday night at Momentum Bank Ballpark. Midland (22-16) scored in the first inning against Frisco (19-18) starter **Leandro Lopez** in the first inning when Shane McGuire drew a bases-loaded walk to make it 1-0. The next half inning, though, **Julian Brock** smashed a home run over the left-center field wall to drive in **Marcus Lee Sang** and provide the RoughRiders a 2-1 lead. Frisco extended its advantage to 3-1 in the third inning on a **Keith Jones II** RBI single that plated **John Taylor**. The RockHounds tied the game in the bottom half with a two-run homer off the bat of Brennan Milone and took a 4-3 lead when Cole Conn scored on a fielder's choice. Down 5-3 in the seventh, Frisco brought home another run when Jones II drove in Taylor for a second time to draw the deficit to 5-4. That score would hold until the ninth thanks to two scoreless innings for **Ryan Lobus** (3-2). Against Shohei Tomioka (2-2), Taylor drew a walk, Jones II doubled and **Arturo Disla** looped a triple into right field to drive both in for a 6-5 lead. Disla would later score on a **Keyber Rodriguez** sacrifice fly. **Janser Lara** struck out two in the ninth for his second save of the season.

### THE BUFFALO HAS ARRIVED:

**Arturo Disla**, nicknamed "The Buffalo", has been amazing since joining the RoughRiders this week. In 4 games, he is hitting .471 (8-for-17)/.550/.824/1.374 with 1 double, 1 triple, 1 home run and 9 RBIs. His 2-run, go-ahead triple in the 9th on Saturday was the first triple of his career. In his first 30 games of the season with High-A Hub City, Disla hit .314/.434/.559/.993 with 6 homers and 21 RBIs.

### WHAT A GAME, BATS:

The Riders exploded for 15 runs on 18 hits on Friday night after being held under 5 runs in back-to-back games for the first time this season the previous two games. On top of **Arturo Disla** and **John Taylor** both homering, the Riders tied a franchise record with 8 doubles on the night, marking the first 8-double game in the Texas League this year as well. It was the 3rd time in RoughRiders history that Frisco had hit 8 doubles in a game, tying July 10th, 2013 at Corpus Christi and April 19th, 2008 at Corpus as well. Frisco and Wichita are the only two teams in the Texas League with 2 games of 15 or more runs this season.

### COREY'S IN THE HOUSE:

Riders infielder **Corey Joyce** continues to impress on the offensive side this year for the Riders. After being signed as a MiLB free agent on April 8th, he joined the Riders on April 14th. In 23 total games, he is hitting .313 (26-for-83)/.383/.627/1.010 with 5 doubles, 7 home runs and 22 RBIs. Since making his Riders debut on April 14th, he is 8th in the Texas League with a .313 batting average, T-5th in home runs (7), 3rd in SLG (.627) and 5th in OPS (1.010). On Tuesday in Midland, he hit his first-career grand slam. With Double-A Knoxville in the Cubs organization last year, he hit just 2 home runs in 92 games with a .272/.393/.347/.740 slashline.

### KEYBRRRRR, IT'S COLD IN HERE:

Frisco infielder **Keyber Rodriguez** has been one of the best hitters in the Texas League this season. He is now hitting .317/.344/.510/.854 this year and is batting .348 (23-for-66)/.384/.545/.929 in his last 13 games. His 7 3-hit games this year lead Double-A. He is T-2nd in the league in batting average (.317), 1st in hits (46), 1st in doubles (12), T-3rd in extra-base hits (18) and 3rd in total bases (74). While he is slugging .510 this year, his previous state-side career high was .385 in 2021 with Low-A Down East.

### GET RICH OR DIE DREILING:

RoughRiders outfielder **Dylan Dreiling** was named Texas League Player of the Week last week. The No. 10 prospect hit .368 (7-for-19)/.520/1.000/1.520 with 4 home runs, 8 RBIs, 6 walks and 7 runs scored. Over his last 9 games, he is hitting .333 (11-for-33)/.500/.727/1.227 with 1 double, 4 home runs, 8 RBIs, 11 walks and 4 strikeouts.

### GIMME THAT OFFENSE EARLY AND OFTEN:

The RoughRiders have been swinging the bat well in their last 19 games, going 11-8. During the stretch, they have scored 129 runs to lead the league (7.2 R/G), slashing .271/.378/.452/.830 with 26 home runs. Frisco's 36 runs in the first inning this year are tied for 6th in the minors, hitting .304 (45-for-148) in the first with 8 home runs. They have scored in the first inning in 15 games and have scored multiple runs in the first inning in 10 games this season. When scoring 7 or fewer runs, the Riders are 7-17 (including an 1-3 record when scoring 7 runs) and 12-1 when scoring 8 or more. Frisco is also 8-12 in 1 or 2-run games.

### LEE SANG IT AND BANG IT:

**Marcus Lee Sang** has helped to carry the Frisco offense in the last three weeks. In his last 25 games, he has slashed .323 (30-for-93)/.406/.581/.987 with 6 doubles, 6 home runs and 22 RBIs.

### YOU WANT THE HITS, WE GOT UM:

Through 37 games the RoughRiders are 1st in the Texas League with 348 hits. They are first in the league in batting average (.274) and 1st in runs (243, 6.6 runs per game). The RoughRiders have not led the Texas League in batting average since 2014. Frisco has scored 8 or more runs in 36 percent of their games (13-of-36). The Riders are T-2nd in the Texas League in homers (51) while they are 1st in SLG (.454) and 1st in OPS (.822). For perspective, the Wind Surge led the league last year with a .780 team OPS.

### ABOUT DYLAN

-Drafted in 2020 out of Central Catholic High School in Portland, Oregon.

-Named 2019 Oregon Gatorade Player of the Year in junior year, leading all Oregon pitchers in wins (10), ERA (0.51), strikeouts (128) and WHIP (0.71). Led Rams to 6-A State Championship game against Jesuit (nicknamed the "Holy War") and faced now-Phillies pitcher Mick Abel. Jesuit won 2-1 in 13 innings.

-Was named as the No. 2 pitcher in Oregon's 2020 class behind Abel.

-At 13 years old, he pitched for Oregon in the opening round of the 2015 Little League World Series. In 1-0 loss to Texas, he threw 5.2 innings, striking out 12 batters.

-Before signing with the Rangers, MacLean was committed to the University of Washington.

-Opening the season as the Saturday starter for the RoughRiders

### 2025 SEASON

-Returned from injury to High-A Hub City, dominating at home (2.45 ERA as opposed to a 4.08 ERA on the road)

-After allowing five runs in his second appearance, he dominated in his last 19G (10GS), to the tune of a 3-1 record and 2.70 ERA.

-Started two games in the playoffs, allowing three runs in 8.0 innings, striking out 7 to 1 walk

-Missed the entire season with "Tommy John" surgery.

## CHAD COMER

Years with Rangers: 10

Years with RoughRiders: 2 (1st as manager)

Comer returns to Double-A Frisco in 2026 after managing at the High-A level over the last three seasons. The native of Mansfield, Texas will enter his 10th season with the Rangers and his second in Frisco.

In 2022, Comer helped pilot the Riders to their second Texas League Championship in franchise history, serving as a development coach. Over the last three seasons, Comer managed High-A Hickory (2023-2024) and High-A Hub City (2025), going 197-191 (.508).

Prior to Frisco, Comer was the hitting coach for the High-A Hickory Crawdads in 2021, after serving as a coach at various levels of the Rangers system from 2016-2019.

The former University of Texas at Arlington catcher played two seasons in the Atlanta Braves organization, reaching High-A Lynchburg in 2012. He was drafted by Atlanta in the 29th round of the 2011 draft after four seasons at UTA.

## THOMAS ST. CLAIR

Years with Rangers: 5

Years with RoughRiders: 1

St. Clair joins the Riders as the pitching coach after leading a Hub City staff that finished third in the SAL with a 3.50 ERA in 2025. St. Clair also will serve as the assistant pitching coordinator in the Rangers farm system in 2026.

Initially, St. Clair came to the Rangers as a coach in the Dominican Summer League in 2022 before serving as a pitching coach for the ACL Rangers from 2022-23. Before professional baseball, he spent two and a half years as pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College.

The right-hander pitched three professional seasons in the St. Louis Cardinals system from 2017-19 after he was picked in the 24th round of the 2017 June draft, making 88 outings for the organization's Rookie and Single-A affiliates.

The Winston-Salem, North Carolina native played four years (2014-17) at Division II Lenior-Rhyne University in Hickory, N.C.

## JASON HART

Years with Rangers: 13

Years with RoughRiders: 9

Hart returns as the hitting coach in Frisco for the first time since he served as the RoughRiders hitting coach from 2012-2019. Before that, most recently, he was the Major League hitting assistant for the Miami Marlins under current Rangers manager Skip Schumaker.

In 2015, Hart was named the Mike Coolbaugh Texas League Coach of the Year for his work with the Riders hitters. Prior to joining Frisco, Hart spent two seasons as the hitting coach with Low-A Hickory. His tenure with the Rangers began after he assisted the Single-A Clinton staff with coaching responsibilities for a portion of the 2008 season and continued when he accepted the role of hitting coach for the Arizona Rangers before the 2009 campaign.

Hart played professionally for parts of eight seasons from 1998-2006, with stints in the Oakland, Texas and Minnesota organizations. He made his Major League debut with the Rangers in 2002, when he batted .267 (4-for-15) with three doubles over a span of 10 games. He missed the 2004 campaign following the removal of a benign brain tumor, but returned to the field in 2005 and hit 21 home runs in 128 games with Frisco.

Originally drafted by Oakland in the fifth round of the 1998 draft, Hart was acquired by Texas in a January 2002 trade with the Athletics. He attended Southwest Missouri State University, where he paced the conference in homers in 1997 and was named a Missouri Valley Conference All-Star in 1998.

Hernandez joins the RoughRiders for his first season with the Rangers organization.

During 2020, Hernandez managed the Texas Collegiate League Frisco RoughRiders after the MiLB season had been canceled. In 2025, he served as a bench coach for Triple-A Jacksonville and spent 19 seasons with the Marlins as a coach and coordinator. As part of that stint, he served eight seasons as a manager, most recently in 2022 with High-A Beloit.

Hernandez started his coaching career at the University of Mobile in 1993 as a hitting coach and stayed there through 2001. From 2005-2006, Hernandez served as the hitting coach for the Independent Pensacola Pelicans.
