### TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and El Paso Chihuahuas (San Diego Padres affiliate) are set for game three of their six-game series at Dell Diamond on Thursday night. The Express were held to two hits in their 14-1 loss to the Chihuahuas on Wednesday. El Paso plated five runs in the top of the second, highlighted by a C Rodolfo Durán three-run homer. CF Carlos Rodríguez drove in two runs in the third, extending their lead to 7-0. The Chihuahuas tallied three more in the fourth on a DH Pablo Reyes home run, a 1B Jose Miranda triple and Miranda later scored on a wild pitch. El Paso scored three runs in the eighth and LF Samad Taylor capped it off with a home run in the ninth. Round Rock avoided a shutout as C Jose Herrera came home on a bases-loaded double play in the ninth, bringing the final to 14-1.

### WELCOME TO THE SHOW, GAVIN

RHP Gavin Collyer had his contract selected from Round Rock prior to the Rangers Wednesday night matchup against the Athletics. The 24-year old made his debut, replacing RHP Cole Winn with two outs in the seventh inning at Sutter Health Park. Collyer struck out the only batter he faced, RF Lawrence Butler, on three pitches. He is just the second Ranger in club history with one batter faced and one strikeout in their MLB debut.

### NEW FACES

Round Rock OF Dairon Blanco made his E-Train debut on Wednesday after beginning the season at the Arizona Complex League. Blanco recorded one of Round Rock's two hits with a single in the ninth inning. The 33-year old outfielder has appeared in 171 Major League games from 2022-25 (all with Kansas City). He has swiped at least 30 bases in each of his last six seasons between the Double-A, Triple-A and Major League levels. In just 77 games with Triple-A Omaha in 2025, he stole 32 bases which ranked 11th among International League base-stealers last season.

### GETTING BACK ON THE TRACKS

The Express are 5-12 through their first 17 games for the first time since 2018. It's the third time they have opened 5-12 in the Triple-A era (2009, 2018). It is not the worst start through 17 games as the 2003 Express opened with a 4-13 record. The worst 20-game start was in 2003 when the club opened 5-15.

### PICK YOUR POISON: GO TO GRAY OR DIAZ DOMINATES

RHP Peyton Gray has not allowed an earned run in his first six appearances and 9.2 innings to begin 2026 while RHP Alexis Díaz has not allowed an earned run in his first seven appearances and 6.0 innings of work. Gray's scoreless-inning streak is the longest in the PCL and tied for second longest without an earned run in Triple-A. He has allowed only seven hits with two walks and 12 strikeouts. Gray picked up his first victory of the season yesterday with 2.0 innings of scoreless baseball.

### ON THIS DAY IN NOLAN RYAN HISTORY - WEDNESDAY, APRIL 16, 1986

Nolan Ryan was not the original scheduled starter as Jim Deshaies was the probable. Astros manager Hal Lanier decided to have Ryan take the ball to keep him in his early season routine of throwing on four days rest. On a cold Bay Area evening, Ryan tossed 7.2 innings in a win, but it was his bat that was key.

He lined a two-out, two-run single with the bases loaded in the second, scoring Kevin Bass and Denny Walling. A Bass RBI single in the third and a bases loaded walk from Alan Ashby in the ninth gave the Astros plenty of insurance in a 4-1 win. It was his first game-winning RBI since the stat began being recorded in 1980. Ryan postgame said, "I didn't realize that was it." Ryan said of his game-winning RBI.

"A big RBI man like me, that is pretty surprising," Mason said he left a "way too fat" fastball over the plate and Ryan singled to left on it. It was an inexperienced battery for San Francisco as both Mason and catcher Bob Melvin were in just their second season. The win avenged an Opening Day loss to the Giants in Houston for Ryan. Giants third baseman Bob Brenly finished 2-for-4 with an RBI. But he also struck out twice against Ryan. As did rookie, Will Clark.
