RHP Hyun-Seok Jang (0-1, 4.82 ERA) vs. LHP Ryan Magdic (1-1, 3.86 ERA)

TODAY'S GAME: Tonight is the second game of the longest road trip of the year for the Quakes, as they take on the Stockton Ports (ATH) in game two of a six-game set and the two game of a 12-game, 13-day road trip. The Quakes will return to LoanMart Field on Tuesday, June 3rd to face the San Jose Giants. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE PORTS: Today's game is the 14th of 18 games (all in the first half) against the Ports and the eighth of 12 at Banner Island Ballpark. The Quakes have dropped five of seven in Stockton in 2025, but after winning five of six at home, are now 7-6 against Stockton in 2025. In 2024, Rancho went 8-2 against the Ports, 5-1 in Stockton.

LAST GAME: The Ports got four in the seventh to take the lead for good, downing the Quakes on Tuesday night at Banner Island Ballpark by a final of 10-7. Jared Sprague-Lott had four RBIs, including a three-run single that broke it open in the seventh. Rancho reliever Connor Godwin (0-2) struggled with his command in the seventh and took the loss. Stockton reliever Tucker Novotny (1-0) earned the win. Joendry Vargas led the Quakes with three hits and two RBIs. Rancho has now dropped two of their last three, but has won 19 of their last 24 overall.

ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes have made several roster moves over the last two days, sending RHP Jhonny Jimenez back to the ACL and placing C Gio Cueto on the Injured List. Joining the Quakes is INF Raynerd Ortega from the ACL and Marco Corcho from the Injured List.

POW TREND KEEPS GOING: The Quakes have snapped up five of the 12 weekly awards that have been handed out this year, with Samuel Munoz keeping the trend going, as he was named the league's Player of the Week on Monday. Munoz hit .417 (10-for-24) against Inland Empire with two homers, five RBIs, 11 runs scored and five walks. Other winners this year include P Sean Paul Linan, P Sterling Patick, OF Mike Sirota and OF Eduard Quintero.

ALL GOOD THINGS....: Saturday night's loss snapped Rancho's six-game win streak overall and a separate six-game win streak at home. The Quakes still have the best record in the Cal League at 28-12, a home record of 17-4 and have won 19 of their last 24 games overall. Rancho's best record in a single half was in the second half of the 2018 season, when they went 52-18 and finished a whopping 15 games ahead of second-place Lancaster. That 2018 season also marked their last Cal League Championship, their third in franchise history.

OFFENSIVE OUTBURST: The offense slowed down on Saturday with just three runs on six hits, but scored eight on Sunday and put up some remarkable numbers over the course of the six-game series. They set a franchise record with 25 runs in Tuesday's series-opener and scored a total of 66 runs on 76 hits over 50 offensive innings last week. Rancho's offense is first in the league at .274 with a league-best 33 homers in 40 games.

HYUN-SEOK JANG: 21-year-old right-hander Hyun-Seok Jang makes his ninth start of the year, his third against Stockton. In two prior games against the Ports, he's 0-1, allowing four runs on just two hits over 6.2 innings. In his last start, he allowed five runs on three hits with four walks over just 3.2 innings in a no-decision against Inland Empire on May 15th. Jang, who signed with the Dodgers in August of 2023 out of South Korea, was regarded as the top pitching prospect coming out of Korea in 2023 and is rated by MLB Pipeline as the Dodgers' 17th best prospect.

RYAN MAGDIC: 24-year-old lefty Ryan Magdic makes his ninth appearance of the year and his fourth start, his third appearance and first start against the Quakes. In two relief outings against Rancho, he's 0-0, allowing three runs (two earned on four hits over four innings, with six strikeouts and four walks. In his last outing overall, he allowed one run on three hits over three relief innings in a win vs San Jose on May 15th. Magdic was drafted by the Athletics in the 14th round of the 2024 draft out of Missouri.
