10	INF Alex Mooney has hit 10 doubles this season, which are tied for the second-most in the Midwest League, in just 23 games. He is the fastest Captain to hit 10 doubles since current Guardians OF Will Brennan also slugged 10 doubles in 23 games in 2021.
+21	The Captains have outscored opponents by 21 runs during their 4-game win streak. Lake County's +33 run differential ranks second to only Great Lakes in the Midwest League.
-	RHP Carter Spivey has recorded two straight quality starts for the first time in his Minor I eague career. It is the first time he has

first time in his Minor League career. It is the first time he has thrown 6+ innings and has allowed 3-or-fewer earned runs in backto-back starts for the first time since 4/6/2023 vs. UCF and 4/15/2023 vs. Cincinnati while at East Carolina University.

CAPTAINS LOG

LAST TIME OUT: The Captains extended their win streak to 4 games with a 9-5 victory in the series-opener versus Dayton on Tuesday at Classic Auto Group Park. After Dayton CF Jay Allen II homered on the first pitch of the game, Lake County scored a run in each of the next eight innings. With the game tied 1-1 in the bottom of the third, 1B **C.J. Kayfus** hit a solo home run to right field, his fourth of the season.

After Dayton tied the game 3-3 in the top of the fourth, C **Cooper** Ingle delivered a two-run single to start a stretch of six consecutive runs.

LHP **Parker Messick** (No. 21 CLE prospect) earned the win, throwing 5 innings while allowing three runs (one earned) on four hits, fanning four and walking four.

RHP Juan Zapata and RHP Jay Driver combined to pitch scoreless 6th and 7th innings. RHP Josh Wolf closed the game with 2 innings of work in a non-save situation. He allowed two runs in the ninth ending the bullpen's streak of 20.1 scoreless innings.

TWO-OUT HITTING: 4 of Lake County's 9 runs were driven in with two outs. A two-run single by C Cooper Ingle and a pair of RBI base knocks by CF Jonah Advincula and 2B Alex Mooney all came with two away. The Captains lead the Midwest League with an .874 OPS when there runners in scoring position and two outs.

CONGRATS, CCI: 19-year MLB vet and 2007 AL Cy Young Award winner CC Sabathia was named the 48th member of the Cleveland Guardians Hall of Fame on Thursday. While he did not pitch for Lake County, Sabathia went 2-0 with a 1.08 ERA in three starts for its predecessor, the Columbus RedStixx (Columbus, Georgia).

21st SEASON OF CAPTAINS BASEBALL: 2024 marks the 21st season of Captains Baseball. After the Columbus RedStixx were purchased in 2003, they were moved to Eastlake and became the Lake County Captains. In 2,762 regular-season games, Lake County has an all-time record of 1,390-1,372 (.503).

WINNING WAVES: The Captains have had a winning record in 13 of their first 20 seasons, including in each of their last four campaigns. Lake County has made 7 playoff appearances in franchise history (5 Midwest League, 2 South Atlantic League), with its 2010 Midwest League Championship being its sole title in franchise history.

TRENDS & NOTABLES

THAT'S A WINNING STREAK: The Captains have won 4-straight, holding the second longest active win streak in the Midwest League behind Cedar Rapids' 6-game surge. Lake County has won 8 of its last 10 games, tied for the MWL's best record during that stretch.

THAT'S OUR GUY: In 6 games since April 30 vs. Fort Wayne, OF Guy Lipscomb is batting .478 (11-for-23), tied with South Bend's Brett Bateman for the Midwest League-lead in that span. Lipscomb's 4 knocks Saturday vs. Fort Wayne marked a new Minor League-high, and were the most in his baseball career since 4/3/2022 versus Purdue in his junior season at Belmont.

TOP QUALITY: Through 28 games, Lake County starting pitchers have recorded a Midwest League-best 8 quality starts (6+ IP, 3-or-fewer earned runs).

BASH BROS 2.0: Captains INF/OF C.J. Kayfus and INF Alex Mooney, MLB Pipeline's No. 20 Cleveland prospect, have been the MWL's premier slugging tandem. The duo has accounted for 30.7% of Lake County's run production, while hitting 8 of the team's 20 home runs.

STRONG STARTING PITCHING: Lake County's starting pitching staff has been one of the premier units in the Midwest League so far this season. The group ranks top-5 in the Midwest League in fewest walks (30, 1st), wins (10, 1st), strikeouts (136, 2nd), WHIP (1.16, 2nd) innings pitched (129.0, 2nd).

SATURDAY NIGHT'S ALRIGHT: Saturday night's 10-1 win versus Fort Wayne marked the first time since at least 2005 that the Captains scored 10+ runs in the first 2 innings of a single game. Lake County had scored 9 through 2 innings 3 previous times (9/6/2023 vs. Lansing, 4/24/2016 at Lansing, and 4/23/2011 vs. Bowling Green). The Captains' 10 runs scored were their 2nd-most in a game this year (12, 4/20 vs. Lansing), while their +9 run differential was its largest in a single game this season.

PLENTY OF '23 IN LC: Six players on the Captains' current active roster were selected by the Cleveland Guardians in the 2023 MLB Draft. INF/OF C.J. Kayfus was drafted in Round 3, C Cooper Ingle in Round 4, INF Alex Mooney in Round 7, OF Jonah Advincula in Round 8, RHP Jay Driver in Round 9, and RHP Zane Morehouse in Round 14.
