SUNDAY SERIES VICTORY?: After dropping last night's game in close fashion, the FredNats still have a chance for a series victory today over Salem in the final meeting of the year between the two Carolina League North Divisonal rivals. Today's game is the fourth and final FredNat home game this year that will be broadcast on MASN, the television home of the Washington Nationals. Today's game will be broadcast on MASN2 and MASN+. RHP Luke Johnson makes another start on the mound for FBG. He faced Salem in his first Single-A start back in June, throwing four scoreless innings against the Sox on the road. He faces Salem righty Jose Bello, who sees FBG for the first time. This is the 119th meeting between Fredericksburg and Salem since 2021, and the series is dead even at 59 wins apiece.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** Salem hit two solo home runs in the first four pitches of the game by Justin Gonzales and Yoeilin Cespedes, and the Sox ended up holding on for a 7-5 victory for their second win of the week. Ethan Petry and Wyatt Henseler both hit their first professional home runs, and Elijah Green had three hits in the game, and Merritt Beeker threw two more perfect innings out of the FredNat bullpen. Cristhian Vaquero also had two hits for FBG.

**STANDINGS WATCH:** The FredNats are now just 1.0 game out of first place in the 2nd half in the North Division behind the Carolina Mudcats. Fayetteville, Carolina's opponent this week, is also now just 1.0 game behind the Mudcats, tied with the FredNats for second place in the division. Fredericksburg and Fayetteville square off next week at VACU Stadium in what will be a very big series for the 2nd half standings, and then Carolina will visit VACU Stadium the last week of the regular season in a series that could decide the title.

INSTANT IMPACT: Fredericksburg currently has four members of Washington's 2025 draft class on the roster, and each player has made an instant impact since arriving to the team. Last night, 2nd round pick Ethan Petry hit his first professional home run, and also slugged two doubles for the first three extra-base hits and RBIs of his pro career. Then, 9th rounder Wyatt Henseler also slugged his first pro home run in the 8th inning. In 10 FredNat games, Henseler is hitting .364 with a .990 OPS. 14th round pick Nick Hollifield also has five hits and five RBI in six games with FBG thus far.

**START EARLY:** The FredNats are 53-54 overall this season, but are 18 games over .500 (32-14) when scoring first in 2025. In the first two innings this season, Fredericksburg has been outscored 79-117 (-38).

WHY TRY IT?: Fredericksburg's MiLB-leading caught stealing total is up to 82. Heading into play today, Kevin Bazzell leads MiLB by six with 53 caught stealings and owns the best CS% of all MiLB catchers who have played at least 400 innings this year, throwing out 43% of would-be base stealers. Fredericksburg has excelled the most at throwing out base runners against Salem, nabbing 12 out of 26 potential base stealers this season.

**HE'S INEVITABLE**: FredNat outfield prospect Cristhian Vaquero picked up his MiLB-leading fourth walk-off hit of the season last home stand, and overall, he's enjoyed a very strong second half of the season offensively, pairing his hot bat with his exceptional outfield defense. In 29 second half games, Vaquero is fifth in the league in batting average (.313), fourh in OPS (.866), and he's second among active players in slugging (.493). He's also fifth in hits (42) and sixth in total bases (66). He also picked up his 11th outfield assist of the season last week.

**THE STAFF:** After Jake Lowery's third season as Manager of the FredNats ended in a Carolina League championship in 2024, the FredNats welcome Billy McMillon as the third Manager in Fredericksburg franchise history. McMillon, 53, has spent the last three seasons in the Nationals organization as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. He also played parts of six seasons in the Major Leagues with Oakland, Detroit, Philadelphia and Florida. He's joined on the staff by returning Pitching Coach Justin Lord, returning Hitting Coach Mike Habas, Development Coach Luis Ordaz, returning Athletic Trainer Jacob Meyer, Strength & Conditioning Coach Mike Reiskind, and Performance Analyst Samantha Unger.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014. The franchise won its first league title as the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2024, defeating the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers two games to one to win the title at Virginia Credit Union Stadium.

**LUKE WARM:** Lucas Emanuel Johnson...promoted to Fredericksburg for the second time this season on 7/23. The Nationals selected Johnson in the 10th round of the 2024 MLB Draft out of the University of Maryland, Baltimore County (UMBC).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Last week in Myrtle Beach, Johnson flew a bit too close to the sun trying to finish the fifth inning. In search of his first win, the righty fired four great innings, but allowed traffic in the fifth and two extra runs were added to his tally after he was lifted following 4.2 IP. In total, he allowed five hits and four earned runs for a no decision.

**PALM BALL:** In two long stints, Johnson excelled in the Florida Complex League to begin his professional career this year. The righty made 14 appearances and two starts, posting a 1.23 ERA across 36.2 IP. He allowed only five earned runs, tallying 36 strikeouts to just 14 walks. He won the FCL's Pitcher of the Week award at the end of May.

**GOLDEN RETRIEVER:** Johnson pitched four seasons for the UMBC Retrievers, completing his career as UMBC's all-time program leader in strikeouts. He won the America East Pitcher of the Year award twice, becoming the only player in the award's 34-year history to win it outright twice. He posted a career 4.61 ERA in 288.2 IP with 279 K's. As a Junior in 2023, he had an ERA of 2.96 in just under 80 innings. His selection marked the first time a Retriever was selected in the MLB Draft since 2016.

### **BILLY MCMILLON - MANAGER**

1st Season | Previously: Development Coach, Triple-A Rochester

McMillon, 53, joined Washington in 2022 and has spent the last three seasons as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. McMillon played parts of six Major League seasons with four different organizations, including the Oakland Athletics (2001-04), Detroit Tigers (2000-01), Philadelphia Phillies (1997), and Florida Marlins (1996-97). The former Clemson Tiger was a three-time International League All-Star and the 1996 IL Rookie of the Year with Charlotte, earning him induction into the IL Hall of Fame in 2019 and Charlotte's Round Table of Honor in 2022. McMillon was initially selected in the eighth round of the 1993 MLB Draft by Florida. He replaces Jake Lowery, who managed the FredNats the last three seasons, culminating in a championship last year. Lowery will manage High-A Wilmington in 2025.

Prior to joining Washington, McMillon coached in the Boston Red Sox organization for over a decade. He managed the Worcester Red Sox (Triple-A) in their inaugural season in 2021 after managing Boston's former Triple-A affiliate Pawtucket in 2019. He was set to lead the PawSox again in 2020 before the cancellation of the MiLB season. Prior to managing at the Triple-A level, McMillon was the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for Boston from 2016-18 after managing for six seasons in the organization with Double-A Portland (2014-15), High-A Salem (2012-13), and Single-A Greenville (2010-11). His coaching career began in 2008 when he was Greenville's Hitting Coach.

Lord, 45, returns to Fredericksburg for a third season in 2025 after leading the FredNats' championship pitching staff last season, including the 2024 Carolina League Pitcher of the Year Travis Sykora.

This is Lord's fifth total season coaching in the Washington organization after a six-year professional playing career and several seasons coaching in the Baltimore system. The Alabama native and Florida State alum was scheduled to be the Fredericksburg Pitching Coach in the canceled 2020 season, and was the Pitching Coach for one season in Double-A Harrisburg prior to joining the FredNats in 2023.



#### MIKE HABAS - HITTING COACH

2nd Season | Previously: Hitting Coach, ACL Brewers

Habas, 34, returns to Fredericksburg from the 2024 championship staff for his second season with Washington after leading the FredNat offense to a highly successful season, finishing in the top third of the league in virtually every meaningful offensive category.

Prior to joining the Nationals, he spent spending the previous four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization, most recently as the Hitting Coach for the ACL Brewers in 2022 and 2023. Prior to joining Milwaukee, he was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats. While coaching with Gary, he was also the Head Coach at Prairie State College, a Junior College in the Chicago area.



#### LUIS ORDAZ - DEVELOPMENT COACH

1st Season | Previously: Manager, FCL Nationals

Ordaz, 49, joins the FredNat coaching staff in the Development Coach role after managing the Florida Complex League Nationals in 2024.

He played parts of seven seasons in the Major Leagues, appearing in 206 career games with the St. Louis Cardinals, Kansas City Royals and Tampa Bay Devil Rays. Ordaz has coached in the Washington organization for over a decade, and was the Hitting Coach for the Potomac Nationals for four seasons from 2016-19. He replaces Carmelo Jaime, who will manage the FCL Nationals in 2025 after three seasons in Fredericksburg.
