ROCKIN AND ROLLIN: After getting back in the win column last night on Thirsty Thursday, the FredNats will go for their third win of the week against the Down East Wood Ducks, Single-A affiliate of the Texas Rangers, on Firework Friday night at Virginia Credit Union Stadium. Pitching prospect Jarlin Susana gets the start for Fredericksburg trying to build on a solid start his last time out against Delmarva, where he pitched four innings and allowed just two runs. He faces Down East righty Jose Gonzalez, who's been very solid for the Wood Ducks.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Freddies had five extra base hits including two homers for Gavin Dugas and Cristhian Vaquero, and got back in the win column with an 8-5 victory over Down East on Thirsty Thursday. Jose Atencio battled and threw 94 pitches in five innings to earn his second win of the year, and the FredNat bullpen allowed just one run in the final four innings to hold on to the win. Fredericksburg scored five runs in the 2nd inning and hit for the cycle in the inning to make things comfortable early in the game.

HARDWARE: Today, Brandon Pimentel became the first FredNat position player in franchise history to win a Player of the Month honor when Major League Baseball announced him as the Carolina League Player of the Month for April. His 33 RBIs in April was more than anyone in Minor League or Major League Baseball, and he's top five in the Carolina League in OPS, slugging, total bases, extra-base hits and obviously RBI. The 23-year-old undrafted free agent from El Paso, TX is making his full-season debut in professional baseball this season, and has made a huge splash in his first month of the season.

FORMULA FOR SUCCESS: The FredNats are a perfect 11-0 this season when scoring first, including all five wins in last week's series against Delmarva and Tuesday's game against the Wood Ducks. 13 of Fredericksburg's 16 wins have come against the North Division of the Carolina League as well.

BULLPEN WORK: So far in 2024, the FredNat bullpen has been one of the best units in the Carolina League. In 121 IP so far for the FredNat relievers, the unit has allowed 35 earned runs for a group ERA of 2.60. The Freddies are also 8/9 in save opportunities (five by Thomas Schultz, one by Kevin Rodriguez, one by Samuel Vasquez and one by Mason Denaburg), and the team is 12-0 when holding a lead after seven, and 14-0 when leading after eight innings this year.

APRIL RECAP: The FredNats ripped off 15 wins in the month of April to start the year, second most in the league and more than any other month in the entire 2023 season. Fredericksburg led the Carolina League with 139 runs scored, and also led the league in run differential with +50. Fredericksburg's three shutouts on the mound is also the most in the Carolina League, and have won two extra inning games in a row heading into the month of May.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Iriple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 157-128 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Alabama native and Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prarie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past two seasons, roles he will continue in 2024. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

TONIGHT'S START: Jarlin Susana is set to make his fifth start of 2024, after getting the nod on Opening Night. The big righty features a heater that routinely exceeds triple digits, to go along with a fading changeup and a sharp slider that will touch the low 90's.

EARLY-SEASON HIGHS: After an up-and-down April, Susana really hit his stride going into May. From his start on 5/3 vs Down East, Jarlin was flat out dominant. Over his next eight starts, Susana worked to a 2.35 ERA across 30.2 IP, with opponents hitting a measly .167 against him.

LATE-SEASON LULL: Unfortunately, Susana faltered as the season went on. After the aforementioned eight-start stretch, Jarlin made just four more starts the rest of the season. He struggled with his command, walking 15 batters in 22.2 IP, with an ERA north of 9.00. Susana made his final start of the year on 8/5 against Salem before being placed on the Development List to end his season.

AGAINST THE WOOD DUCKS: Exactly one year ago today, Jarlin Susana struggled against Down East. He was tagged for four runs in just two innings, as he walked four batters and hit another.

LAST TIME OUT: Susana authored four strong frames against the Shorebirds last week. He struck out a season-best seven hitters, walked just one, while giving up just two earned runs.
