SPACE COWBOYS VS. ALBUQUERQUE (2026)

TODAY'S GAME: After opening their six-game series in Albuquerque with a 4-3 victory on Tuesday night, the Space Cowboys look to extend their seven-game winning streak in game two against the Isotopes on Wednesday night at Isotopes Park.

ABOUT TUESDAY NIGHT: Sugar Land started their two-week road trip by defeating the Albuquerque Isotopes 4-3 on Tuesday night at Isotopes Park... Sugar Land struck for two runs in the first three batters of the game before Trenton Brooks hit a solo homer in the fourth... A CJ Alexander RBI single in the sixth pushed Sugar Land to a 4-1 lead, backing up 5.2 innings of one-run ball by LHP Josh Hendrickson, who struck out five in his start... After Albuquerque got two in the eighth, RHP Roddey Muñoz tossed a perfect ninth to seal the win.

ROSTER MOVES: 8/4 - RHP Sam Carlson released by Houston... 8/3 - OF Lucas Spence optioned to Sugar Land... RHP Bryce Mayer promoted to Sugar Land from Corpus Christi... INF Braden Shewmake placed on the temporary inactive list... 7/31 - INF Braden Shewmake signed to a minor league contract, assigned to Sugar Land... INF Edwin Díaz released by Houston.

HOW THE TEAM WAS BUILT: The Space Cowboys roster is comprised of 8 players drafted by Houston, 8 players signed as free agents, 2 international free agents, 3 non-drafted free agents, 4 players acquired in trades, 1 player claimed off waivers, 1 player selected in the Major League Phase of the Rule 5 draft and 2 player selected in the Minor League Phase of the Rule 5 draft.

PROSPECTING: Per MLB Pipeline, the Space Cowboys roster features six of the Astros' Top 30 prospects, including RHP Bryce Mayer (#5), RHP Ethan Pecko (#6), OF Lucas Spence (#8), RHP Miguel Ullola (#11), RHP Jackson Nezu (#13) and RHP Alimber Santa (#14).

SHAY ALL DAY: Shay Whitcomb went 1-for-4 in Tuesday's series opener, extending his on-base streak to 16 games and his hitting streak to seven games... Whitcomb has driven in a run in five of his last seven games... During his current hitting streak, he is batting .387 (24-for-62) with three doubles, one triple, two home runs, 15 RBI, four stolen bases, nine runs scored and three walks while striking out just 10 times.

Since the All-Star break, Whitcomb has hit safely in 15 of 16 games, batting .387 (24-for-62) with three doubles, one triple, two home runs, 15 RBI, nine runs scored and four stolen bases.

During the second half, Whitcomb is slashing .355/.426/.540/.966 in 34 games with six doubles, one triple, five home runs, 29 RBI, 20 runs scored and a Pacific Coast League-leading 14 stolen bases... He also ranks second in the PCL in batting average, tied for second in hits (43), tied for fourth in RBI, tied for sixth in total bases (67), sixth in OBP, seventh in OPS and ninth in SLG.

Whitcomb also became the Sugar Land Space Cowboys' all-time franchise hits leader on Friday night with his 381st career hit, surpassing Pedro León (380).

SEVEN HEAVEN: Sugar Land has won seven consecutive games, the longest active winning streak in the Pacific Coast League and the club's longest streak of the season, surpassing its previous season-high of six games from March 28-April 3... It is also the Space Cowboys' longest winning streak since they won 12 straight from May 7-21, 2025.

MONTH FOR THE RECORD BOOKS: With their win on Friday night the Space Cowboys finished July 18-6, tied with Bowling Green for the most wins in the month of July in Minor League Baseball... Sugar Land also tied a franchise record for most wins in a single month in franchise history with 18 (18-8 in May, 2025 & June, 2024; 18-7 in April, 2024)... Six losses in July were also tied for the fewest losses in a month in franchise history after Sugar Land went 16-6 in May, 2021.

PITCHING CARRIES THE DAY: Sugar Land's pitching staff has helped carry the team to their 26-8 record in the second half (since 6/23)... In that span, the staff has a 3.21 ERA, the lowest ERA in Minor League Baseball (next, Tampa - 3.39)... They also have the lowest home ERA in Minor League Baseball in the second half (2.90, next, Harrisburg - 2.93) while being tied with Hillsboro for the most home games played in the second half (24)... Sugar Land has also given up just 102 walks in 297.0 innings in the second half, the third fewest walks in MiLB while owning the lowest WHIP (1.08) in MiLB and fourth-highest K/BB ratio (3.05).

RUN PRODUCERS: Raynel Delgado went 1-for-5 with a double, an RBI and a run scored on Tuesday night, extending his RBI streak to three games... Delgado has now hit safely in nine of his last 10 games and has multi-hit efforts in five of his last eight games.

CJ Alexander finished 1-for-3 with an RBI, extending his RBI streak to three games... Since returning from the injured list on July 30, Alexander is batting .364 (4-for-11) with a double, a home run and five RBI.

SECOND HALF SUCCESS: In the second half of the season, no Minor League Baseball team has won more home games than the Sugar Land Space Cowboys, who are 20-4 at Constellation Field... Sugar Land's 26-8 record in the second half is good for a .765 winning percentage, the best in Minor League Baseball, ahead of the Hickory Crawdads of the Carolina League (.750).

RUNNING WILD: The Space Cowboys have collected 47 stolen bases in the second half in 53 total attempts, tied for the second-most in the Pacific Coast League (Sacramento - 58).

NARROW MARGINS: Sugar Land has now won four-straight one-run games... It is the first time they have played four-straight one-run games since August 9 - 13, 2025 where they went 1-3.

BONUS BASEBALL: The Space Cowboys played their 14th extra-inning game of the season on Friday night and their fourth of the second half, improving to 8-6 overall and 3-1 in the second half... Sugar Land's 14 extra-inning games are the third-most in Triple A this season (Memphis - 19; Norfolk - 15).

WHY NOT A WALK OFF?: After Raynel Delgado's ninth-inning walk-off double on Saturday night gave Sugar Land their 11th walk-off victory of the year, the Space Cowboys added a third-consecutive walk-off and their fifth of the homestand with Matt Thaiss' two-RBI single on Sunday night... Their 12 walk offs are the most walk-off wins in Minor League Baseball in 2026 and the most in a single season in Space Cowboys history, surpassing the 10 Sugar Land collected in 2024... Sugar Land's streak of three-straight games ending in a walk off ties their franchise record set earlier this year from July 12 - 22.

STRIKKKKKKKKKKKE 'EM OUT: Space Cowboys hurlers struck out at least 13 batters in seven-consecutive games from 7/26 - 8/2, totaling 100 strikeouts in that stretch, the most in MiLB (next, Brooklyn - 86)... It is the first time in franchise history the Space Cowboys have struck out at least 13 batters in seven-straight contest (previous, 3G, 3X, last, 8/23 - 25/24) and the longest streak of consecutive games with at least 13 strikeouts in MiLB this season (previous, Inland Empire, 6G, 4/7 - 12).

EXTRA, EXTRA!: A night after they were held to seven singles, Sugar Land connected for 14 extra-base hits on 6/17 @ ABQ (6 2B, 2 3B, 6 HR)... Their 14 extra-base hits tied the most in a single game in franchise history, which came on 5/7/23 @ ABQ (6 2B, 8 HR) in a contest Sugar Land won 24-8... Each of the Space Cowboys first nine hits on Wednesday went for extra bases.

Sugar Land's six home runs were its most in a game since 5/14/24 at Albuquerque... The Space Cowboys also recorded two triples in a game for the first time this season and their first multi-triple game since 7/22/25 at El Paso. Additionally, Sugar Land's 24 hits on Wednesday set a season high and marked the club's first 20-hit game since May 17, 2024, at Albuquerque, in which they collected 21 hits.

All Space Cowboys games can also be seen on the Bally Sports Live App for free, MiLB.TV, MLB.TV and the MiLB App. Garrett Greene returns for his fourth season as the primary play-by-play broadcaster for Sugar Land and will be on the call for all 150 games. He'll be joined at home and on select road games by Gerald Sanchez, who continues in his sixth season calling games for Sugar Land.

NOW HERE'S A STOREY: Mickey Storey returns for his seventh season as the manager of the Astros' Triple-A affiliate and his sixth with Sugar Land, continuing as the only manager in Sugar Land's history since they became affiliated with the Astros. Storey earned his 500th professional win on June 4, 2025 over the Sacramento River Cats. He was named the Pacific Coast League Manager of the Year in 2024 after guiding Sugar Land to their first Pacific Coast League title. Storey joined the Astros organization as a coach in 2016 and has managed with Single-A Quad Cities (2018) and Triple-A Round Rock (2019), along with five seasons in Sugar Land. Storey appeared in nine seasons at the professional level as a right-handed pitcher, including stints at the Major League level with the Astros (2012) and Blue Jay (2013). He appeared in four collegiate seasons at Florida Atlantic and was selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 31st round of the 2008 MLB Draft.

REST OF THE CREW: Joining manager Mickey Storey on the Space Cowboys coaching staff are pitching coach Sean Buchanan, hitting coach Drew Saylor and development coach Wladimir Sutil. 2026 is Saylor's first in the Astros organization after he worked in the Royals organization from 2020 - 2025, mostly as a minor league hitting coordinator. He previously managed in the Pirates organization (West Virginia - 2019), Dodgers' organization (Rancho Cucamonga, 2016 - 2018) and Rockies (Tri-City, 2015). Buchanan enters his second year at the helm in Sugar Land after one season as the pitching coach with Double-A Corpus (2024) and one year with High-A Asheville (2023), along with a year in the Florida Complex League (2022). Buchanan previously coached in the collegiate ranks, working for eight seasons with stops that included Lehigh University, Albright College and DeSales University. Sutil enters his fifth season on the Space Cowboys' staff after serving as the manager for the Astros' Florida Complex League team in 2021. He's worked as a manager for Astros affiliates at the Short-Season and Gulf Coast League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014.

A LITTLE ABOUT US: Through its first nine seasons, Sugar Land played in the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. They won the Atlantic League Championship in '16 and '18 and appeared in the postseason in five of nine seasons. Sugar Land still holds the Atlantic League single-season records for wins (95) and winning percentage (.679) from its '13 season. Sugar Land was managed by former Major Leaguers Gary Gaetti (2012-17) and Pete Incaviglia (2018-20). As an independent team, Sugar Land went 601-502. Notable people to appear for Sugar Land include: LHP Scott Kazmir, RHP Roger Clemens, IF Rafael Palmeiro, Tracy McGrady, IF James Loney, C Derek Norris, OF Willy Taveras and RHP Felipe Paulino.

PROMOTED: Promoted to Sugar Land on 5/11, the first promotion to Triple A of his professional career.

Went 3-0, 5.23 ERA, 8 G, 7 GS, 32.2 IP, 40 H, 19 R, 19 ER, 14 BB, 24 K with the Mustangs... Returned to the Pioneer League in 2024 with the Yolo High Wheelers (Davis, CA) and made 16 starts, going 6-2, 5.22 ERA in 89.2 IP, 102 H, 55 R, 52 ER, 30 BB, 78 K... Started 2025 in the Pioneer League with the Yuba-Sutter High Wheelers (Marysville, CA), making two starts... Went 2-0, 2.38 ERA in 11.1 IP, scattering 11 hits to give up only three runs with two walks and 16 strikeouts.
