LUG•NOTES

Talent Rich: The Nuts boast the No. 1 prospect in the Athletics' organization in **Tyler Soderstrom**, a 20-year-old catcher drafted 26th overall in 2020 who is considered MLB Pipeline's No. 56 prospect in all of baseball. Soderstrom is one of six Top 25 A's prospects on the roster, joining teenager **Brayan Buelvas** (No. 10) and **Euribiel Ángeles** (No. 11), starting pitcher **Joey Estes** (No. 19), first baseman/outfielder **Lawrence Butler** (No. 21) and pitcher **Jeff Criswell** (No. 22).

Recent Acquisitions: Three Lugnuts – pitcher **Joey Estes**, infielder **Euribiel Ángeles** and outfielder **Gabriel Maciel** – join the Athletics organization for the 2022 season from outside the system. Estes was picked up from Atlanta in a four-player package for first baseman Matt Olson on March 14, 2022; Ángeles was acquired from San Diego with a fellow prospect for pitcher Sean Manaea on April 3, 2022; and Maciel was selected in the Rule 5 Draft Triple-A portion from the Minnesota Twins on December 3, 2021.

In Memoriam: 2007-2012 Lansing Lugnuts general manager **Patrick Day** passed away suddenly of a heart attack last Friday at age 47. His Celebration of Life was held today at the Peoria Sports Complex in Peoria, Arizona. A moment of silence will be held for Pat in the middle of the 2nd inning.

Heating Up in the Cold: Infielder **Euribiel Ángeles** went 3-for-5 yesterday, the sixth time in his last eight games that he has collected at least two hits. The 19-year-old shortstop – who was going to play for Fort Wayne before the Padres traded him shortly before Opening Day – is 15-for-33 (.455) after opening the year 1-for-11.

No. 164: Infielder **Christian Lopes** went 0-for-2 last night for the Oakland Athletics. In the process, the 2013 Nut became the 164th all-time Nut to reach the Majors and the second this year, joining A's relievers and **Zach Logue** and **Zach Jackson**. There are currently 15 Major League teams with at least one Lugnut representing, including four (Jackson), **Dany Jiménez**, **Christian Lopes** and the injured **Kevin Smith** on the A's.

Record-Breaking: On April 10, reliever **Jordan Romano**, a member of the 2016 Lugnuts starting rotation, broke Tom Henke's Toronto Blue Jays franchise record with his 26th consecutive save, closing out the Yankees in a 3-0 Blue Jays win.

Welcome Back: The Nuts return one coach (hitting coach **Javier Godard**) and 12 players from 2021, pitchers **Osvaldo Berrios**, **Jeff Criswell**, **Stevie Emanuels** and **David Leal**; catcher **Jared McDonald**; infielders **Brett Harris**, **Patrick McColl** and **Drew Swift**; and outfielders **Lazaro Armenteros**, **Austin Beck**, **Jonny Butler** and **Lawrence Butler**.

International Appeal: In addition to 15 states plus Puerto Rico represented by Lugnuts players and coaching staff, the 2022 Nuts hail from Brazil, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Panama and Venezuela.

26 PHIL POHL MANAGER

Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Phil Pohl's family moved to Cooperstown when he was nine years old. He starred at Cooperstown Central High School, where he was honored as the 2008 Gatorade New York High School Baseball Player of the Year.

Pohl was drafted by Tampa Bay in the 44th round, becoming Cooperstown Central's first ever draft pick, but decided to attend Clemson University. He served as a two-time team captain for the Tigers, was honored three times as a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll, and was selected Second Team All-ACC.

Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012 and played four seasons of Minor League Baseball, rising as high as Triple-A Sacramento. Upon retiring from playing, he rejoined the organization as the A's MLB bullpen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his first season managing.

In a Nutshell: Received 2022 Opening game start... listed as a "Sleeper Arm We're Watching" in the A's system by Eric Longenhagen and Kevin Goldstein for Fangraphs ("Holman, a two-way guy at Cal, [is an] arm strength flier right now. The hope is Holman can add movement to his fastball")

Little League Hero: One of the all-time great Little League World Series performers... coached by father Doug... 6'4, 166 lbs. at age 13, throwing 70s mph heat... opened up 2013 LLWS with an extra-inning no-hitter, crushing a game-winning grand slam to clinch the second game, and then delivering an extra-inning walk-off three-run homer in the third game... led Eastlake Little League to the LLWS championship game, where they fell 6-4 to Japan... Padres prospect Robert Hassell III also competed in the tournament as a member of the Southeast champ from Nashville.

High School: Recorded a 3.95 GPA at Eastlake H.S. ... career high school stats: 29-1, 1.10 ERA | .390 avg., 20 HR, 80 RBI... 2017 MaxPreps National Junior of the Year, 2017 California Mr. Baseball Runner Up... 2018 CIF SDS Pitcher of the Year... played one year on Eastlake H.S. varsity basketball team.

Bear Down: Starred as a two-way player at Cal... as a freshman, hit .272/.362/.456 as the DH while making 11 appearances, nine starts (37 1/3 IP, 4.82 ERA)... on May 4, 2019 at Utah, hit game-tying double, then pitched the 9th to notch the save... as a sophomore in Covid-shortened 2020, was Cal's starting first baseman and No. 2 pitcher, leading the Bears with 24 2/3 IP (3.28 ERA) while hitting .250/.333/.324... on March 10, 2020, after hitting his first home run earlier in the game, hit by a pitch in the face against San Jose State in the bottom of the 7th inning... that was his last ever at-bat in college baseball... named 2021 Baseball America Preseason All-America First Team, utility... as a full-time pitcher in injury-hampered junior year, 2021, delivered 10 weekend starts, 47 IP, 3.83 ERA, 20 BB, 46 K.

Evaluation: Rated by MLB.com as the No. 138 best prospect entering the 2021 draft... the MLB scouting report: "Holman has the chance to have a legitimate four-pitch mix, all coming from a strong, durable build that points to a potential starting-pitching profile. He touched 97 miles per hour as a reliever in the San Diego Collegiate League over the summer, and was regularly hitting 96 in bullpens this fall for Cal, throwing his fastball for heavy riding life. He already had a live slider and a splitter he uses as his off-speed offering and added a slower 12-to-6 curve that looks like it could be a usable offering as well. All of Holman pitches have a lot of action, and he has a feel to find the strike zone with all of them. But not a lot of track record yet given his split focus, but he is a college arm with some serious upside, one who could climb boards in a hurry."

Draft Day: Selected 188th overall in the 6th round by Oakland, 2021, the first Golden Bear to be drafted... signed for \$375,000, higher than the recommended slot of \$255,000... second pitcher drafted by the A's, following third-rounder Mason Miller (Gardner-Webb)... one of five 2021 draftees on the Lugnugs, joining Brett Harris (7th round), Drew Swift (8th round), Jack Winkler (10th round) and Jonny Butler (14th round).

2021 - Professional Debut: Appeared in six games, four starts, for Low-A Stockton in 2021... made pro debut vs. Inland Empire, August 25... struck out five Modesto Nuts in 2 1/3 innings, September 14... finished with his best outing, tossing four scoreless two-hit innings vs. Modesto, whiffing four, on September 19.

2022 - Midwest League: Earned honor of Lugnugs' Opening Day start, though it was pushed back one day by terrible Michigan weather... started Game 1 of doubleheader, April 9 vs. Lake County, tossing four innings, six hits, two runs, no walks, two strikeouts... both runs were scored in the fourth inning... outdueled by Gavin Williams (4 IP, 0 H, 6 K) in Lugnugs 3-0 loss.
