Inland Empire 66ers (22-25) AT RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (32-18)



RHP Michael Darrell-Hicks (2-0, 5.11 ERA) vs. RHP Chris Campos (5-2, 5.67 ERA)

TODAY'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field, as your Quakes finish up their 12-game, 13-day home stand, with the last game of a six-game set against the Inland Empire 66ers (Angels). Earlier today, kids were treated to the U.S. Bank Little League Fan Fest, where they got baseball instruction down on the field and autographs from Quakes' players and coaches. Kids will also "Run the Bases" after today's game, thanks to San Antonio Regional Hospital.

VS THE 66ERS: Today is game 15 of 27 between the two clubs, with 15 of those coming here at LoanMart Field. The Quakes swept a six-game set in San Bernardino the last time these two teams matched up, but they've dropped three of five in this series and are now 10-4 against the 66ers. Last year, the Quakes went 14-16 against the 66ers, 9-9 at home.

LAST GAME: The Rancho offense mustered only one run, while the 66ers took advantage of 14 walks handed out by Quakes' pitching, in a 6-1 Inland Empire win over the Quakes on Saturday night at LoanMart Field. Thayron Liranzo's 14th homer of the year was the only highlight for Rancho, as 66ers' starter Mason Albright (4-3) allowed just one run over six innings in the win. Rancho loaded the bases and moved the tying run to the on-deck circle in the eighth, but Dylan Phillips got the final four outs to record his third save of the year, giving Inland Empire three of five in the series.

STANDINGS UPDATE: The Quakes currently have a 4.5 game lead over Lake Elsinore with 16 to play in the first half. That lead of 4.5 games is just one game off of the high-water mark, as the Rancho lead over Lake Elsinore has fluctuated between 5.5 and 2.5 over the last two weeks. Remaining games for the Quakes include today's game at home vs Inland Empire, six at Modesto, six at North-leading San Jose, then home for three games against the Storm to finish the first half. Lake Elsinore's remaining games include today's finale against Visalia, six at Fresno, then back home to host Stockton for six. They finish the half at Rancho.

SERIES STUFF: The Quakes have not lost a series at any point here in 2023, but today that streak is in jeopardy. With a loss to Inland Empire today, the 66ers will have won four of six and dealt the Quakes their first series loss in nine series this year. They were faced with this same dilemma last week against the Storm after dropping the first three, only to recover and win the final three to salvage a split. Rancho is 6-0-2 in series overall, splitting at Visalia and vs LE.

MORE ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes have made six roster moves over the last 72 hours, all involving pitchers. On Saturday, RHP Waylin Santana was added to the Rancho roster from the Arizona Complex League. He takes the roster spot of RHP Carlos Martinez, who goes on the Injured List. Prior to Thursday's game, LHP Luis Valdez was traded to the Texas Rangers for Double-A RHP Ricky Vanasco. In addition, RHP Payton Martin was placed on the Developmental List, retroactive to Tuesday. Taking their respective spots on the roster are RHP Jorge Gonzalez and RHP Liam Doolan, who both joined the Quakes from the Arizona Complex League.

CHRIS CAMPOS: Right-hander Chris Campos makes his fourth start of the year for Rancho and his 11th overall appearance, his fourth against Inland Empire. Campos has dropped consecutive decisions, both on this home stand. In his last start on Tuesday against Inland Empire, he allowed six runs (five earned) on seven hits over just 2.1 innings in the loss. Campos was drafted by the Dodgers in the seventh round of the 2022 draft out of St. Mary's University.

MICHAEL DARRELL-HICKS: Right-hander Michael Darrell-Hicks makes his fourth start of the year, his tenth overall appearance and third appearance against the Quakes. In two outings against Rancho this year, he's 1-0, allowing one run on three hits over five innings, with ten strikeouts and three walks. In his last outing overall, he allowed just one hit over six scoreless innings in a win over Visalia on May 28. Darrell-Hicks was signed by the Angels in 2022 as a free agent after playing collegiately at Jacksonville University in Florida.
