YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Senators, 3-2, to open the series. **Reggie Crawford** made his Double-A debut as Richmond's opener and worked a scoreless first inning, striking out Stone Garrett, who is on a rehab assignment from the Nationals, to close out the frame with a 98 mph fastball. **Logan Wyatt** gave the Flying Squirrels a 1-0 lead in the second with a solo homer, his second straight game with a home run. In the third, **Jimmy Glownke** extended the lead to 2-0 with an RBI single. The Senators closed the score to 2-1 with a run-scoring groundout off the bat of Robert Hassell III in the fifth. Cortland Lawson tied the score in the sixth with an RBI single. After the Senators stranded two runners in the fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth, Hassell led off the bottom of the ninth with a triple and then scored on a walk-off single by Dylan Crews. **John Michael Bertrand** took over on the mound in the second and allowed two runs over five innings. **Tanner Kiest** stuck out two in a scoreless seventh.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the second of a six-game series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. This is the first of three series between the two teams this season. The Senators come to Richmond for a six-game series from July 9-14. The Flying Squirrels return to Harrisburg for a six-game set from August 13-18. In 2023, the Flying Squirrels went 13-8 against the Senators, including a 3-6 mark at FNB Field and a 10-2 record at The Diamond.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS reached the postseason for the second consecutive season in 2022 and the fourth time in franchise history, winning the Southwest Division Second-Half title. They were eliminated by the Erie SeaWolves in the Southwest Division Series. The team went 74-64 overall, the second-best record in the Southwest Division. In the first half, the Flying Squirrels jumped out of the gate in first place for most of the first month of the season, but slid down the stretch and finished 33-36, fourth in the Southwest. In the second half, the Flying Squirrels surged to a 41-28 record, finishing three games ahead of Erie in first place. The Flying Squirrels spent 57 percent (79 games) of the season in first place in the division. Richmond's 74 wins this year were the third-most in franchise history and their .536 winning percentage was the second-best, trailing only 2014 (79-63, .556). After starting this year 1-4, the Flying Squirrels are 3-2 in their last five games. The 4-6 start is the worst record for the Flying Squirrels through their first 10 games since 2017.

THE SENATORS went 59-77 last year and finished in last place in the Southwest Division for the third consecutive season. This year, they started the season 1-5 but have won their last two games. They went 2-3 in last week's road series at Altoona. Among the Eastern League leaders, Dylan Crews is tied for second in RBIs (9) and Brady House is tied for fourth in hits (11). The Harrisburg roster includes seven of MLB.com's top-30 Nationals prospects, including OF Dylan Crews (No. 1), 3B Brady House (No. 3), 3B Yohandy Morales (No. 4), OF Robert Hassell III (No. 8), OF Andrew Pinckney (No. 17), RHP Cole Henry (No. 24) and C Israel Pineda (No. 25). Baseball America's top-30 Nationals prospects list includes seven Harrisburg players, including Crews (No. 1), House (No. 3), Morales (No. 5), Hassell (No. 7), Pinckney (No. 19), Henry (No. 22) and LHP Andrew Alvarez (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Carson Ragsdale** makes his third Double-A start. He last pitched on Thursday in his home debut against the RubberDucks and allowed one run, an RBI double by Kahlil Watson in the third, over four innings with five strikeouts. In his Double-A debut on April 6 at Somerset, Ragsdale allowed two runs in four innings with seven strikeouts. Last season, he made seven starts for High-A Eugene, going 0-1 with a 2.93 ERA. His season ended in May with an oblique injury. At the time of the injury, he was leading the Northwest League in strikeouts (42) and ranked third in innings pitched (27.2). In 2022, he made five appearances in the Arizona Complex League but missed most of the year after having Thoracic Outlet Syndrome surgery in the spring. Ragsdale was selected by the Philadelphia Phillies in the fourth round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of the University of South Florida. Before making his professional debut, he was traded to the San Francisco Giants on January 9, 2021 for pitcher Sam Coonrod. **For more on Ragsdale, see page two.**

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Michael Cuevas makes his second start of the season. In his season debut last Wednesday at Altoona, he pitched 4.1 innings and allowed four runs in a no-decision. After surrendering a two-run double in the first to Aaron Shackelford, he threw three scoreless frames before an RBI groundout by Jase Bowen and a run-scoring single by Seth Beer in the fifth finalized his line for the night. Cuevas spent all of last season with Harrisburg and went 4-8 with a 5.53 ERA in 23 starts. He made his Double-A debut against the Flying Squirrels on April 12, 2023 and allowed five runs (four earned) over three innings. Cuevas made four starts against Richmond last season, going 0-2 with a 10.38 ERA (15 ER/13.0 IP), his highest ERA against any opponent he made multiple starts against. Cuevas posted a 4.78 ERA (45 ER/84.2 IP) against the rest of the Eastern League. He was selected by the Nationals in the 23rd round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of Brennan High School in Texas.

LONGBALL LOGAN: **Logan Wyatt** hit his first homer of the year on Saturday night, a three-run shot to give the Flying Squirrels a lead in the third inning. His next game in the lineup, the series opener at Harrisburg on Tuesday, he added a solo homer in the second inning. Last year, Wyatt combined to hit 17 homers between High-A Eugene and Double-A Richmond, which was tied for fifth in the Giants organization. He hit nine homers in his 64 games with Richmond last season. Since his Double-A debut on June 14, 2023, Wyatt leads the Flying Squirrels in batting average (.251), SLG (.450) and OPS (.783), ranks second in homers (11) and third in RBIs (39).

GRANTING WISHES: **Grant McCray** has worked eight walks this season, which is tied for second in the Eastern League. After hitting .050 (1-for-20) in his first six games to open the season, he is batting .429 (3-for-7) with a homer, a double and three RBIs in his last two games. He has also scored a run in four straight games played. On Sunday afternoon at The Diamond against Akron, McCray hit his first Double-A homer, a three-run shot in the sixth to extend Richmond's lead in a 5-1 win. Last season with High-A Eugene, McCray hit 14 homers led the Northwest League in hits (126), totals bases (206), runs (101) and stolen bases (52).

GLOW SHOW ON THE ROAD: **Jimmy Glownke** is batting .417 (5-for-12) in his three road games this season compared to .105 (2-for-19) at The Diamond. Last season with Richmond, Glownke hit .323 (42-for-130, 7 HR, 28 RBI, .963 OPS) in his Double-A road games compared to .171 (20-for-117, 0 HR, 2 RBI, .501 OPS) in his 37 home games at The Diamond.

GRAND LARCENY: The Flying Squirrels are the only team in the Eastern League perfect in its stolen base attempts this season, going 12-for-12. The 12 stolen bases are tied for seventh in the league overall. **Brett Auerbach** is 4-for-4 in steal attempts and his four steals are tied for fourth in the league. In 2023, the Flying Squirrels were 124-for-153 (81.1 percent) in stolen base attempts, the highest percentage in franchise history, surpassing the previous record of 77.6 percent in 2021.

STRONG ARMS: The Richmond pitching staff has combined for 98 strikeouts this season, which is third in the Eastern League. Flying Squirrels starters have combined for a 3.41 ERA (14 ER/37.0 IP) this year, which is third-best in the league behind Akron (1.64) and Erie (2.90).

CLOSE CALLS: This season, the Flying Squirrels have played five games decided by one run, going 2-3 in those games. Richmond is tied with Akron for the most one-run games in the Eastern League this season. The RubberDucks are also 2-3 in one-run contests. The Flying Squirrels began the season with a 5-4 loss at Somerset on April 5, lost 2-1 to Akron last Tuesday, won 2-1 on a walk-off error last Thursday against the RubberDucks, picked up a 3-2 win over Akron on Friday and lost 3-2 against Harrisburg to open this week's series.

FAMILIAR FACES: Sixteen players on the current active roster return from last year's Flying Squirrels team, including **Brett Auerbach**, **Victor Bericoto**, **John Michael Bertrand**, **Hayden Birdsong**, **Vaun Brown**, **Matt Frisbee**, **Evan Gates**, **Jimmy Glownke**, **José Cruz**, **Wil Jensen**, **Ryan Murphy**, **Tyler Myrick**, **Nick Swiney**, **Andy Thomas**, **Will Wilson** and **Logan Wyatt**. Of those players, five are in their third season with Richmond, including Auerbach, Brown, Gates, Jensen and Murphy. Two players, Frisbee and Wilson, are with the Flying Squirrels for a fourth season.

PROSPECT WATCH: Eight of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the roster, including **Hayden Birdsong** (No. 6), **Reggie Crawford** (No. 9), **Grant McCray** (No. 10), **Vaun Brown** (No. 11), **Eric Silva** (No. 22), **Adrián Sugastey** (No. 25), **Ryan Murphy** (No. 28) and **José Cruz** (No. 30). In Baseball America's Best Tool in the Giants Organization list, **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and McCray is rated as the best defensive outfielder and best outfield arm. Crawford is rated as having the best fastball and best slider. Six players landed on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Birdsong (No. 6), Crawford (No. 8), McCray (No. 13), Brown (No. 15), **Victor Bericoto** (No. 20) and Sugastey (No. 24).

THIS DATE IN SQUIRRELS HISTORY

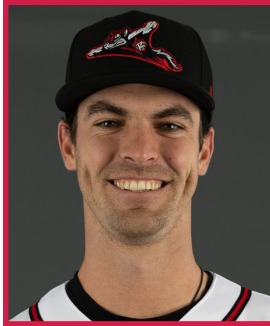

Shane Matheny worked a bases-loaded walk in the fifth and the tying run scored on an error in the eighth. Tristan Beck struck out six over five innings.
