#### Abstract

On the Road Again The Fightin Phils continue a six-game series on the road at the Hartford Yard Goats on Friday night. It is the 10th-of-18 matchups between the teams this season, and the fourth-of-six in Hartford. Reading holds the season-series edge over the Yard Goats 5-4, after taking five-of-six from Hartford in early May. Reading won the season-series over Hartford 14-10 in 2023, which included a 9-3 record at Dunkin' Park.


## All Goats on Thursday

The Yard Goats rode a seven-run fifth inning to an 8-1 win over the Fightin Phils on Thursday night. Hartford had seven hits in the inning, which was the most hits Reading allowed in an inning this season. Bladimir Restituyo had three hits, while Ronaiker Palma, AJ Lewis and Braiden Ward had two. Eight-of nine Yard Goats had hits, seven-of-nine socred runs, and six-of-nine had RBI. Connor Van Scoyoc got the win for Hartford with seven-shutout innings on the mound. Marcus Lee Sang had two hits for Reading and Kendall Simmons had a triple and scored the lone run. Lachlan Wells allowed a season-high nine hits and seven runs over 4.2 innings pitched. Andrew Schultz and Tommy McCollum each tossed scoreless innings of relief.

## The First Fightin

Kolby Allard, who is a member of the Phillies 40-man roster, will make his third start for Reading tonight. Allard signed with the Phillies on Jan. 23 and was optioned to Triple-A Lehigh Valley on March 19. Following a rough start with the IronPigs, Allard was assigned to the FCL-Phillies on May 9. He joined Reading on May 22 and made two starts last week against Binghamton. After allowing three runs over 1.2 innings on May 22, Allard bounced back with just one-run surrendered in three innings on May 26.

## Who's Hot

Multiple Fighitn Phils have been red-hot during the month of May. Jose Rodriguez had another hit last night and is now riding a personal and team-best ninegame hitting streak, dating back to May 16. Over his streak, Rodriguez is hitting .444, with five extra-bse hits and nine runs scored. He's struck out just once over his hitting streak in 37 plate appearances. With two more hits last night, Marcus Lee Sang is now hitting . 317 in May, after hitting just . 197 in April. Jose Rodriguez (2nd) and Marcus Lee Sang (9th) both rank amongst the Eastern League leaders in May batting average. Kendall Simmons is currently riding a fivegame hitting streak, dating back to May 21. Over the streak, Simmons is hitting . 353, with three homers and six RBI. Simmons ishitting . 300 in May, after a .182 April. Caleb Ricketts is hitting 298 in May and is up to .289 on the season, and the Phillies No. 20 Prospect is establishing himself as Reading's everyday catcher. Casey Martin is on a four-game hitting streak, dating back to May 26. Over the hitting streak, Martin is 5-14 (.357), with a 400 OBP and . 757 OPS.

A couple of members of High-A Jersey Shore and Single-A Clearwater have been on a role lately. Phillies No. 4 Propsect Justin Crawford had three hits, two runs, four RBI, a triple and grand-slam home run in Jersey Shore's game last night. Crawford is currently riding a seven-game hitting streak, where he is hitting .400, dating back to May 22. Phillies No. 2 Propsect Aidan Miller launched a grand slam for the Threshers two nights ago and is hitting .314 on the season, with five home runs and 25 RBI. 20-year old Jordan Viars of Clearwater had a career-night on Thursday night. Viars had four hits, four runs, three home runs and nine RBI, including a grand slam. The combined records of Jersey Shore and Clearwater this season is 59-37 (.615 winning percentage).
