The Fightin Phils continue a six-game series on the road at the Hartford Yard Goats on Friday night. It is the 10th-of-18 matchups between the teams this season, and the fourth-of-six in Hartford. Reading holds the season-series edge over the Yard Goats 5-4, after taking five-of-six from Hartford in early May. Reading won the season-series over Hartford 14-10 in 2023, which included a 9-3 record at Dunkin' Park.

The Yard Goats rode a seven-run fifth inning to an 8-1 win over the Fightin Phils on Thursday night. Hartford had seven hits in the inning, which was the most hits Reading allowed in an inning this season. Bladimir Restituyo had three hits, while Ronaiker Palma, AJ Lewis and Braiden Ward had two. Eight-of nine Yard Goats had hits, seven-of-nine socred runs, and six-of-nine had RBI. Connor Van Scoyoc got the win for Hartford with seven-shutout innings on the mound. Marcus Lee Sang had two hits for Reading and Kendall Simmons had a triple and scored the lone run. Lachlan Wells allowed a season-high nine hits and seven runs over 4.2 innings pitched. Andrew Schultz and Tommy McCollum each tossed scoreless innings of relief.

The First Fightin

Kolby Allard, who is a member of the Phillies 40-man roster, will make his third start for Reading tonight. Allard signed with the Phillies on Jan. 23 and was optioned to Triple-A Lehigh Valley on March 19. Following a rough start with the IronPigs, Allard was assigned to the FCL-Phillies on May 9. He joined Reading on May 22 and made two starts last week against Binghamton. After allowing three runs over 1.2 innings on May 22, Allard bounced back with just one-run surrendered in three innings on May 26.

Multiple Fighitn Phils have been red-hot during the month of May. Jose Rodriguez had another hit last night and is now riding a personal and team-best ninegame hitting streak, dating back to May 16. Over his streak, Rodriguez is hitting .444, with five extra-bse hits and nine runs scored. He's struck out just once over his hitting streak in 37 plate appearances. With two more hits last night, Marcus Lee Sang is now hitting .317 in May, after hitting just .197 in April. Jose Rodriguez (2nd) and Marcus Lee Sang (9th) both rank amongst the Eastern League leaders in May batting average. Kendall Simmons is currently riding a fivegame hitting streak, dating back to May 21. Over the streak, Simmons is hitting .353, with three homers and six RBI. Simmons ishitting .300 in May, after a .182 April. Caleb Ricketts is hitting .298 in May and is up to .289 on the season, and the Phillies No. 20 Prospect is establishing himself as Reading's everyday catcher. Casey Martin is on a four-game hitting streak, dating back to May 26. Over the hitting streak, Martin is 5-14 (.357), with a .400 OBP and .757 OPS.

A couple of members of High-A Jersey Shore and Single-A Clearwater have been on a role lately. Phillies No. 4 Propsect Justin Crawford had three hits, two runs, four RBI, a triple and grand-slam home run in Jersey Shore's game last night. Crawford is currently riding a seven-game hitting streak, where he is hitting .400, dating back to May 22. Phillies No. 2 Propsect Aidan Miller launched a grand slam for the Threshers two nights ago and is hitting .314 on the season, with five home runs and 25 RBI. 20-year old Jordan Viars of Clearwater had a career-night on Thursday night. Viars had four hits, four runs, three home runs and nine RBI, including a grand slam. The combined records of Jersey Shore and Clearwater this season is 59-37 (.615 winning percentage).

This Day in Baseballtown History

May 31, 2000: At Reading, the Phillies score 10 in the 3rd and swamp Binghamton, 11-0. Nick Punto, David Francia and Jason Michaels each have two hits in the huge inning. Geoff Geary fans 12 in 6.0 shutout innings for the win and Joe Cotton tosses the final 3 innings for the save.

Hartford enters today with a 25-22 record, which is second in the Eastern League's Northeast Division. The Yard Goats were at Portland and split an eight-game series, which featured two doubleheaders, after the teams had two games snowed-out in April. After this week, Hartford hits the road and heads to Somerset for a six-game series. Hartofrd's roster features 13 of the Rockies' top-30 prospects: Adael Amador (1), Yanquiel Fernandez (3), Sterlin Thompson (5), Zac Veen (6), Benny Montgomery (10), Ryan Ritter (12), Carson Palmquist (14), Gabriel Hughes (15), Warming Bernabel (16), Mason Albright (21), Angel Chivilli (24), Jaden Hill (26) and Connor Van Scoyoc (28).

Lefty Evan Shawver makes the start tonight for Hartford. Carson Palmquist was originally scheduled to start, but went on the IL earlier this week. This season, Shawver is 1-2, with a 3.15 ERA over 14 games and two starts (20 IP, 14 H, 9 BB, 16 SO). Shawver last pitched on Tuesday against Reading, going 0.2 innings, with one strikeouts. He also pitched against the Fightin Phils on May 9, allowing a home run in one inning of work. Shawver's two starts came on May 21 and 24 at Portland, both in back ends of doubleheaders. He went two and one-inning repsectively in those starts. Shawver spent all of 2023 with High-A Spokane, going 2-4, with a 5.94 ERA over 24 appearances and four starts. He split 2022 between Single-A Fresno and Spokane, and began his professional career with the ACL-Rockies in 2021. The Rockies drafted Shawver in the seventh round of the 2021 draft out of Cincinatti, where he pitched from 2019-21 as a starter.

Assigned to FCL-Phillies following tough start to season. Assigned to Double-A Reading May 22. First start with Reading May 22 vs BNG, lasted just 1.2 IP. Bounced back with one run allowed on May 26 vs BNG.

CAREER TRANSACTIONS: Selected by the Atlanta Braves with the 14th overall pick (1st Round) of the 2015 MLB Draft. Traded to Rexas Rangers for Chris Martin on July 30, 2019. Trade to Atlanta Braves for Jake Oforizzi and cash considerations on November 9, 2022. Signed by the Philadelphia Phillies as free agent on January 23, 2024.

2023: Began the season on the IL with Atlanta with a right oblique strain. Made two rehab appearances with Triple-A Gwinnett before being activated on June 28. Appeared in four games (three starts) for Atlanta before being placed back on IL on July 17, and missed the remained of the season with a left shoulder injury.
