LAST GAME

The Baysox opened their six-game set against the Akron RubberDucks with a 7-2 victory on Tuesday afternoon. The Baysox were powered by three home runs on the day - two run shots by John Rhodes and Donta' Williams in the third and seventh innings respectively, in addition to a solo bomb by Heston Kjerstad in the sixth. Tim Susnara also picked up an RBI groundout and Billy Cook notched an RBI double as part of a two-run second inning to jumpstart the Baysox bats. On the mound, southpaw starter Cade Povich went five effective innings, striking out seven, to get the win and improve his record to 4-3 on the season. The lone blemish for Povich was a two-run home run by Johnathan Rodriguez in the third inning. Right-hander Connor Gillispie was dominant in his four shutout innings of relief, yielding just two hits to pick up his second save of the season.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Akron RubberDucks enter tonight with a record of 19-20. Akron sits fifth in the Eastern League Southwest division, but just a game-and-a-half out of first place. The RubberDucks split their six-game series in Richmond last week and took four of six from the Baysox in Bowie last month. Both sides enter the series struggling defensively. Akron's 40 errors on the season are the second-most in the Eastern League. Only the Baysox (44) have more. Akron's roster is highlighted by six of the Guardians' Top 30 prospects, via MLB Pipeline. Positioned prospects include INF Angel Martinez (No. 9), OF Petey Halpin (No. 15) and INF Jose Tena (No. 21). On the mound, the RubberDucks' staff is led by right-handers Tanner Burns (No. 20) and Jack Leftwich (No. 30), along with southpaw Doug Nikhazy (No. 28).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Akron will open with rehabbing arm Cody Morris. Coming back from a shoulder injury, Morris is only expected to pitch one inning. After Morris, Akron looks to send left-hander Doug Nikhazy to the mound tonight. The No. 28 prospect in the Guardians' system, per MLB Pipeline, Nikhazy has been efficient for Akron this season, albeit he hasn't pitched too deep into his outings. Nikhazy last pitched this past Thursday against Richmond where he started and picked up his first career Double-A win, tossing five innings and only allowing a single, unearned run. The southpaw did walk four batters, but matched a Double-A career-best with nine strikeouts. The five innings was the longest outing for Nikhazy this season, who has only accumulated 23.1 innings across his seven appearances. Nikhazy faced the Baysox in Bowie on 4/12, where he threw three shutout innings of relief, allowing only a single hit while walking two. A 2021 second round pick of Cleveland, out of Ole Miss, Nikhazy pairs a low-90s fastball with a big, mid-70s curveball, and a mid-80s slider/cutter hybrid.

GETTING BACK TO WINNING WAYS

Tuesday's victory marks the first time the Baysox have strung together consecutive victories since the opening two games of the season. Bowie is the only team at the Double-A level yet to have a winning streak of at least three games this season. The Baysox are also the only team in the Eastern League to not win consecutive games at least three times in 2023 (Bowie has only done so once). Overall, the Baysox are 2-10, averaging 3.3 runs per game, following a victory this season.

HAIL CESAR

INF Cesar Prieto continues to pace the Eastern League with 56 hits and a .376 average - 54 points above the next highest qualified average. Prieto has hits in seven-straight games for the third time this season, and has collected hits in 17 of his 18 games this month. He holds a .397 average and a 1.045 OPS in the month of May. The No. 17 O's prospect also ranks third in the league in on-base percentage and fourth in total bases (79).

HESTON IS BESTON

OF/1B Heston Kjerstad has shown out as one of the top bats in the Eastern League so far this season. The Orioles' No. 5 prospect has demonstrated plenty offensive consistency - sitting third in the Eastern League in average (.314), along with second in slugging percentage (.628) and in OPS (1.022) among qualifiers, while also ranking second in extra-base hits (20), fourth in hits (43) and third in total bases (86), while sitting tied for the league lead with three triples. Kjerstad is in the midst of a 25-game on-base streak - the longest streak in the Eastern League this season. His current ten-game hitting streak is the tied for second-longest by a Baysox player this season (Prieto - 10 games, 11 games) Kjerstad has reached base safely in 34 of his first 35 Double-A contests.

THE RHODE LESS TRAVELED

OF John Rhodes has continued to catch fire at the plate for Bowie in the month of May. Rhodes has reached in 12 consecutive games for the Baysox, with hits in 10 of his last 11 contests overall. The on-base stretch for Rhodes is the second-longest by a Baysox player this season. Since his return from the injured list, Rhodes is hitting .394 (13-for-33). Rhodes has also proved to be one of Bowie's most consistent run-producers, with his 20 RBI ranking tied for a team lead with Heston Kjerstad. While hitting .245 overall on the season, Rhodes is hitting .265 with runners in scoring position - the third-best average, with at least seven at-bats in such situations, on the team.

CAREER NOTES

- Pitched to a 0.96 ERA in the month of June, allowing just three runs across 28 innings, while striking out 32 compared to just 10 walks. Also held opponents to .188 average in the month of June.
- Went four or more scoreless innings seven times on the season.
- Started two postseason contests for the IronBirds, allowing a single run over nine innings, including going four scoreless frames in the South Atlantic League Championship Series.
- Pitched two seasons at UC Irvine, where he posted a 4.03 career ERA in 19 appearances (18 starts) across 96 innings.
- Transferred to UC Irvine in 2020 after spending two seasons at Ohlone College, pitching 26 games (22 starts) with an ERA of 2.19, striking out 133 batters and walking just 33 in 119 innings.
- Pitched sparingly at California High School in San Ramon and entered college with a mid-80s fastball before truly developing his game at Ohlone.
- Oldest of six siblings.

NOTES BY START*

- Double-A debut. Pitched in tandem to Cade Povich's start. Third pitch thrown went for a double, and an error that should have ended the inning allowed the runner to score. Across a 1-2-3 inning in the next frame, was struck by a line drive on the forearm before assisting on the out at first. Left the game.
- Second game of a doubleheader, only baserunner allowed was a double with two outs in the first. 22 pitches in the first, just 12 in the second.
- Walked two batters in the first, but a caught stealing kept inning scoreless. Allowed a solo home run to lead off the second.
- Relieved Garrett Stallings with Bowie up 2-0. Allowed double to first batter, and two-run home run to fourth. Walked first two batters in next inning and allowed go-ahead single.
- Thanks to a double play, faced the minimum in the first two innings, and struck out the side in the second. Allowed the first four batters to reach in the third inning, allowing five total hits and two walks in the frame before being pulled.
