**LAST TIME OUT:** The Cyclones shut out the Drive, 6-0, on Saturday night...RHP **Robert Colina** set a career-high with 6.0 innings pitched and tied a career-best with 10 strikeouts for Brooklyn...The 22-year-old scattered 5 hits and did not allow a walk...RHP **Joe Rodríguez** stranded the bases loaded in the 9th and tossed 3.0 innings of scoreless relief for his first High-A save...Cyclones clubbed 3 home runs...RF **Stanley Consuegra** blasted a 3-run shot in the 1st...C **Drake Osborn** and CF **Alex Ramírez** added solo blasts in the 2nd and 7th...Ramírez, 3B **William Lugo**, and 2B **D'Andre Smith** all accumulated multi-hit nights...CF **Allan Castro** and SS **Eddinson Paulino** posted multi-knock efforts for Greenville.

**ON THE FINAL FEW CORKSCREWS:** Brooklyn is looking to secure a second-straight playoff appearance and is 7-2-2 in their last 11 series...Brooklyn is 34-25 in the second half and is a game ahead of Jersey Shore (33-26) atop the North Division of the SAL with 7 games left to play...The BlueClaws hold the tiebreaker over Brooklyn because of winning the season series (15-11).

**HOPE AT BAT:** Today is the final day of Minor League Baseball's "Hope At Bat" campaign to benefit the American Cancer Society...\$15 will be donated to the ACS for every run scored today...A total of \$34,060 has been raised during the 2023 season in the fight against Childhood Cancer.

**THE DONUT SHOPPE:** Brooklyn collected its 11th shutout win of the season with a 6-0 blanking at Greenville on Saturday...RHP **Robert Colina** (6.0 IP) and RHP **Joe Rodríguez** (3.0) combined on the blanking...With Saturday's performance, the Cyclones have set a new franchise record for single-season shutouts...Before 2023, Brooklyn had accrued 10 shutouts in a season happened on 4 separate occasions...It previously happened over 76 games in the New York-Penn League in 2014...The 11 shutouts are tied for 4th-most in all of Minor League Baseball and tied for first among South Atlantic League squads with Hudson Valley and Bowling Green.

**GRAB A SEAT:** RHP **Robert Colina** became the 6th different Cyclone pitcher to strike out 10 or more batters in a game in 2023 when he whiffed 10 Drive batters on Saturday night...He joins RHP **Joander Suárez** who whiffed 11 vs. Aberdeen on August 11...RHP **Jordany Ventura** punched out 10 vs. Aberdeen on August 9, RHP **Cameron Foster** K'd 12 vs. Wilmington on July 29, RHP **Tyler Stuart** struck out 11 vs. Hudson Valley on June 22, and RHP **Blade Tidwell** accomplished the feat on 4 separate occasions...Only Greenville has as many pitchers (6) strike out 10-plus hitters in a game this year...Since 2005, only one other Brooklyn squad had 5 different arms punch out 10 or more in a single game during a season...In 2013, LHP **Dario Álvarez** (12; 7/24 @ LOW), RHP **Miller Díaz** (11; 8/23 @ VER), RHP **Robert Gsellman** (13; 8/24 @ VER), RHP **Dawrin Frías** (11; 8/27 vs. TRI), and RHP **John Gant** (7/26 @ ABD).

**THE ROCO SHOW:** RHP **Robert Colina** registered one of the best performances of his career on Saturday at Greenville...The Venezuela native set a career-high in innings pitched (6.0) and tied a career-best in strikeouts (10) in a 6-0 shutout...Since his 7-strikeout performance vs. Hudson Valley on June 21, Colina holds a 4-3 record with a 3.30 ERA (16 ER in 43.2 IP)...The 22-year-old has surrendered just 41 hits and walked 7 with 55 strikeouts over his last 12 appearances (7 starts)...Colina's strikeout rate is up 6.7 percent (31.1 K%) and the walk rate is down 7.0 percent (4.0 BB%) from his first 7 appearances (1 start).

**KING STANLEY:** OF **Stanley Consuegra** broke a tie with C **Francisco Álvarez** for the franchise record in career home runs by blasting his 23rd with Brooklyn in the top of the 5th on August 23 at Asheville...He added another blast on Saturday and is 2 home runs (19) behind Álvarez (22) for the single-season home run mark...He and Álvarez are the only two players in franchise history to record a 20-plus home run season...Entering Sunday, Consuegra is 3rd in the SAL slugging percentage (.484), tied for 3rd in home runs (20), and tied for 7th in extra-base hits (39)...Over his last 15 games since August 17, the 22-year-old is slashing .271/.339/.678 with a 1.017 OPS, adding 15 runs scored, 2 doubles, 2 triples, 6 home runs, and 19 RBI...Since that date, Stanley has led the SAL in homers (6), RBI (19), extra-base hits (10), total bases (40), and slugging percentage (.678) in addition to being tied for the lead in runs scored (15) and triples (2).

**JETT THE MET:** INF **Jett Williams** has been stellar since he made his Cyclones debut on August 1 and all summer long...Since returning from the All-Star break on July 14, the 19-year-old is slashing .308/.471/.566 with a 1.037 OPS, 31 runs scored, 12 doubles, 2 triples, 7 home runs, 19 RBI, 43 walks, and 16 stolen bases in 42 games between Brooklyn and Single-A St. Lucie...Since that date, no player in Minor League Baseball (min. 185 PA) has a higher on-base percentage (.471)...He is also tied for 1st in walks (43) and 2nd in OPS (1.037)...On the season, Williams is 3rd in Minor League Baseball in walks (97)...Among teenagers, Williams leads MiLB...Since making his SAL debut, the Rockwall, Texas, native has led the circuit (min. 110 PA) in on-base percentage (.450), OPS (.970), and walks (28)...He is also tied for 1st in stolen bases (10), 3rd in slugging percentage (.520), tied for 3rd in extra-base hits (13) and doubles (8), 5th in batting average (.290), and tied for 5th in hits (29)...Among SAL players with at least 120 plate appearances in 2023, Williams is leading

**vs. GREENVILLE:** Brooklyn closes out a 2-week road trip with 6 games against the Red Sox' High-A affiliate...The Drive possess 7 of Boston's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: OF **Roman Anthony** (2), C **Kyle Teel** (4), RHP **Luis Perales** (7), SS **Eddinson Paulino** (16), 2B **Mikey Romero** (19), OF **Allan Castro** (27), and RHP **Yordanny Monegro** (29)...Romero is currently on the 7-day IL...Brooklyn and Greenville are meeting for the second time in this season...The Drive took 4-of-6 from the Cyclones from June 6-11 at Maimonides Park...Brooklyn and Greenville have met once at Fluor Field from May 11-16, 2021...The Drive won 4-of-6 contests in that series.

the circuit in walk rate (21.7%), 3rd in OBP (.450), and 5th in wRC+ (168), wOBA (.441), and 10th in OPS (.970).

**CLIFF NOTES:** OF **Ryan Clifford** has been an on-base machine since joining the Cyclones on August 3...The 20-year-old has reached base safely in all 11 games of Brooklyn's two-week road trip...Since making his debut with the 'Clones, Clifford is tied for 5th in the South Atlantic League in walks (18)...The North Carolina native already has nearly as many walks (21) as he did in 32 fewer games (26 to 58) and 135 fewer plate appearances (115 to 250) than he had with Asheville before the trade...The 2022 11th-round pick enters Sunday tied for 3rd in the SAL in home runs (20), 4th in slugging percentage (.479), and 6th in OPS (.819)...Clifford is also 2nd in isolated power (.239) to teammate OF **Stanley Consuegra** (.248), and 9th in wOBA (.365) and wRC+ (121).

**LUGO LAND:** INF **William Lugo** has been red hot over the last several weeks for Brooklyn...Lugo reached safely in 9 consecutive games and has a knock in 12 of his last 14...Over his 9-game on-base streak, the 21-year-old is 13-for-35 at the plate (.371) with 4 runs scored, 2 doubles, 7 RBI, and 3 walks...Since August 15, Lugo is slashing .350/.394/.450 with a .844 OPS...Lugo has also scored 6 runs, picked up 4 doubles, a triple, and 13 RBI in 16 games...The Dominican native is tied for the league lead in hits (21) and 5th in RBI (13) in that span.

**THE AMAZING ALEX:** OF **Alex Ramírez** is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Sunday, the Dominican native is 2nd in franchise history in hits (161) and is just 1 behind INF **José Peroza** (162) for the all-time mark...He surpassed Peroza for 1st in doubles (37), is 2nd in total bases (232), and walks (69), and 3rd in runs scored (85) and RBI (86).

**BEST IN SHOW:** Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17, the Cyclones' pitching staff has, statistically, been one of the most dominant in Minor League Baseball...Entering Sunday, Brooklyn has posted a 3.43 ERA (308 ER in 809.1 IP) over their last 93 games, holding a 51-42 record, which is the lowest in the minors...The Cyclones have hurled 10 shutouts in that span which is tied for 2nd most in MiLB...Additionally, Brooklyn pitching holds the 4th lowest opposing OPS (.648), hits-per-9 innings (7.31) and batting average against (.219).

**AMAZIN' STARTS HERE:** *Baseball America* released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects...11 members of the 2023 squad are featured...OF **Ryan Clifford** (No. 4), SS **Jett Williams** (4), C **Kevin Parada** (7), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (9), RHP **Christian Scott** (10), OF **Alex Ramírez** (12), 3B **Jacob Reimer** (14), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (22), RHP **Raimon Gómez** (24), RHP **Layonel Ovalles** (28), and RHP **Jordany Ventura** (29)...Williams (No. 98) and Clifford (99) also appear on the publication's list of Top 100 prospects...Former Cyclones listed include INF **Ronny Mauricio** (No. 6), RHP **Mike Vasil** (8), RHP **Dominic Hamel** (19), OF **Matt Rudick** (20), and RHP **Junior Santos** (27)...In all, 16-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island...MLB Pipeline released their updated list, as well...8 members of the 2023 team are recognized...SS **Jett Williams** (No. 3), C **Kevin Parada** (5), OF **Ryan Clifford** (6), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (10), OF **Alex Ramírez** (11), RHP **Christian Scott** (12), IF **Jacob Reimer** (13), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (17), and RHP **Raimon Gómez** (25)...Former Brooklyn stars featured are: **IF Ronny Mauricio** (No. 4), RHP **Mike Vasil** (9), RHP **Dominic Hamel** (16), and OF **Matt Rudick** (27)...Williams (No. 84), Mauricio (93), and Parada (96) are recognized in the Top 100.

**DE RECORD SETTER:** OF **Omar De Los Santos** entered as a pinch-runner and caught Hudson Valley napping to steal second base on July 21, giving him 33 stolen bases in 2023...The current 36 swipes breaks INF **Walter Rasquin**'s franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017 when Brooklyn played in the short-season New York-Penn League...He is also 4th in the SAL in stolen bases for 2023...De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 105 stolen bases in that span, which is tied for 7th most in MiLB...Only Red Sox prospect INF **David Hamilton** (121), Mariners farmhand OF **Jonatan Clasé** (118), D'Backs prospect OF **Wilderd Patiño** (118), Cardinals prospect OF **Mike Antico** (116), Aberdeen OF **Luis Valdez** (114), and Marlins farmhand INF **Nasim Núñez** (113) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 57 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow 2023 Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 49.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor into the decision out of the bullpen in his Cyclones debut on Tuesday night... Entered in relief of RHP **Jordany Ventura** (4.1 IP) and RHP **Dylan Hall** (0.2) — following a 74-minute rain delay — to start the bottom of the 6th with Brooklyn trailing 5-0...Allowed 1 run on 3 hits over 3.0 innings...Walked 2 and struck out 2...Tossed a wild pitch and induced a double play...Tossed 48 pitches and 27 strikes (56.3%)... Cyclones broke up the shutout in the 8th, but fell to the Drive, 6-1.

**BETTER CALL SAÚL:** García joined Brooklyn from Single-A St. Lucie on Tuesday...The 20-year-old made 22 appearances (8 starts) with the Mets prior to joining the South Atlantic League...García tallied a 5-9 record with a 5.35 ERA (40 ER in 67.1 IP) and 2 saves...The right-hander walked 48 (15.9 BB%) and struck out 96 (31.9 K%)...García best outing of the season came in his penultimate appearance with St. Lucie...In Game 1 of a doubleheader on August 18 vs. Jupiter, the Venezuela native earned the win by striking out a career-high-tying 9 in a career-long 6.0 shutout innings of 1-run ball.

**2022:** Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on June 5...Pitched predominantly as a reliever, making 14 appearances, but just 2 starts...Composed a 2-2 record with a 4.94 ERA (17 ER in 31.0 IP) and 1 save...Walked 23 (15.6 BB%) and punched out 46 (31.3 K%).

**STARTING ON THE RIGHT FOOT:** García is slated to make his 9th start of the year and his 1st at the High-A level...In his first 8 starts with St. Lucie, the 20-year-old registered a 2-5 mark with a 4.82 ERA (15 ER in 28.0 IP) and 24 walks (18.6 BB%) to 41 strikeouts (31.8 K%)...His numbers were not quite as good in relief...García held a 3-4 clip with a 5.72 ERA (25 ER in 39.1 IP) and 2 saves...The right-hander walked 24 (14.0 BB%) and struck out 55 (32.0 K%).
