HIGHLIGHTS

STRIKEOUT SUPERSTARS: Tonight's pitching matchup between Richard Fitts and Dom Hamel features the two pitchers who finished 1-2 in the Eastern League in strikeouts (Fitts, 163 and Hamel, 160). Entering Friday of last week, Fitts and Hamel were tied atop the league in strikeouts. when Fitts separated himself with a career-high 11 strikeouts in New Hampshire, compared to Hamel's eight. FAMILIAR FOES: Richard Fitts has faced the Binghamton Rumble Ponies four times this season, going 2-2 with a 5.16 ERA and 29 K over 22.2 IP. Dom Hamel has faced the Patriots more times than any Eastern League pitcher, starting five games and going 2-3 with a 4.50 ERA and 25 K over 22.0 IP. The last time Fitts faced the Rumble Ponies on 8/10, he started a three-hit shutout of Binghamton, where Somerset won 14-0. The last time Hamel faced the Patriots on 8/13. he was the losing pitcher in an 8-0 shutout (2 ER over 3.2 IP) SUBWAY SERIES OF SHUTOUTS: When the Patriots last hosted the Rumble Ponies from August 8-13, the final four games of their series split ended in shutouts. Binghamton leads the Eastern League with 14 shutouts this season (2nd in MiLB), while Somerset ranks second in the league with 12 shutouts (T-4th in MiLB). Of the Patriots' 12 shutouts this season, half (6) have been of the Rumble Ponies. **ONE-UP:** Ending the regular season with four straight wins,

the Somerset Patriots finished the year with a record of 84-53, exactly one win more than their 2022 record (83-53). Having clinched the top record in all of Double-A, Somerset ended the season as one of five MiLB teams with 84+ wins (the other four teams are all Triple-A clubs who played 142+ games compared to Somerset's 137).

TWO HALVES MAKE A WHOLE: Somerset's win on Saturday in New Hampshire clinched the Eastern League's top record in both halves of the season, finishing with 42 wins in each half.

BUILT DIFFERENT: Somerset's +211 run differential this year ended the Double-A regular season 57 runs higher than any other MiLB team above rookie-ball (Norfolk-BAL Triple-A, Round Rock-TEX, Triple-A). **PATRIOTS PITCHING:** The Patriots' pitching staff ended

PATRIOTS PITCHING: The Patriots' pitching staff ended the regular season leading all Double-A clubs with a 3.56 ERA, 1.24 WHIP and .214 BAA--all of which rank top-3 in Minor League Baseball. Their 1,397 strikeouts set a new Somerset Double-A franchise record, led the Eastern League and ranked 6th in MiLB. Somerset's bullpen boasted the lowest ERA in MiLB (3.27).

SOMERSET SLUGGING: Offensively, Somerset ended the regular season leading all Double-A teams with 197 HR and 255 SB (3rd in MiLB), while leading the Eastern League with 749 R and 650 BB, their .346 OBP, .430 SLG and .776 OPS.

2023: Spending his entire 2023 season with Double-A Somerset, Fitts set or matched his career-high in strikeouts four times this season, culminating with a career-high 11 K in his final start of the season on 9/15 @NH. The performance, which was Fitts' career-high 27th start of the season, solidified his spot atop the Eastern League in strikeouts (163), innings pitched (152.2) and wins (11, T-1st). Fitts also ended the Eastern League season ranking 2nd in MiLB in IP and 7th in K. This season, Fitts' set Somerset Patriots, single-season Double-A records in W (11), GS (27), QS (15), IP (152.2) and longest win streak (5, 7/16-8/10). From 5/18 through the end of the regular season, Fitts made 21 starts (14 quality starts), going 10-2 with a 2.85 ERA, 129 K and 35 BB in 123 IP. **2022:** After not pitching following the 2021 MLB Draft, Fitts split his pro debut season between Single-A Tampa and High-A Hudson Valley, winning Pitcher of the Week honors three times en route to being named an MiLB. com Yankees Organization All-Star in 2022. Began the season with 17 GS in Tampa, going 3-8 with a 5.01 ERA (79.0 IP, 73 H, 93 K, 17 BB). Won his first Florida State League Pitcher of the Week award on 6/27/22, after going 6.0 IP with 6 K, BB and allowing just one hit on 6/25/22 vs. CLR. During his final week with Single-A Tampa, won FSL Pitcher of the Week for a second time on 8/8/22, following another 6 IP, 0 R, 1 H, 7 K performance on 8/5/22 vs. CLR. Promoted to Hudson Valley on 8/9/22. Earned South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week honors after he took a perfect game into the eighth inning on 8/27/22 vs. HIC (8.0 IP, ER, 2 H, 0 BB, 7 K). Across 5 GS to end the season in Hudson Valley, Fits went 4-0 with a 0.55 ERA (2 ER in 33.0 IP) with a 0.61 WHIP and .152 BAA. Cumulatively on the year, he went 7-8 with a 3.70 ERA and his 0.98 WHIP was the lowest of any qualifying Yankees minor leaguer in 2022.

College: In three seasons at Auburn (2019-21), went 6-6 with a 5.23 ERA in 40 appearances (14 starts). Heading into his junior season at Auburn, he was named Second Team Preseason All-America by D1 Baseball, Third Team Preseason All-America by Baseball America and was named to the Golden Spikes Award Preseason Watch List.

Personal Notes: Attended Helena High School (AL) and was named a 2018 Rawlings-Perfect Game Honorable Mention All-American, after posting 102 K with a 1.68 ERA as a senior. Named a 2017 Perfect Game Underclass High Honorable Mention All-American, after he missed most of the season with an injury, but Helena won the AHSAA 6A State Championship and finished No. 1 in a national poll. Named All-Shelby County Honorable Mention as a sophomore. Brother, Trevor, played baseball at Mississippi State, before becoming an assistant coach at Austin Peay and now the Director of Player Development for University of Kentucky Baseball. Fitts grew up supporting the Washington Nationals from the point that Stephen Strasburg debuted with the team. **Career Notes:** Selected by the Yankees in the 6th round of the 2021 MLB Draft.

An outfielder during his playing days, Dominguez signed with the Yankees as an undrafted free agent in 2001 and spread four minor league seasons for New York between the DSL and the GCL.
