Today: In their 27th season in the Midwest League, the Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the finale of a six-game series at the Dayton Dragons, High-A affiliate of the Cincinnati Reds. The Dragons are 6-5 against the Nuts this season, winning four of six in Lansing in May and winning the first two games of the current series before the Lugnuts struck back with three straight 3-2 victories. Following today, Lansing has one road trip remaining in 2023: a six-game series at Lake County to close the year.

Last Night: Lugnuts 3, Dragons 2. In his High-A debut, Gunnar Hoglund was a third-inning HBP away from five perfect innings, striking out seven Dragons, and Yehizon Sanchez followed 2 1/3 perfect innings before a Jack Rogers single ended the no-hit bid with one out in the bottom of the eighth. Dayton scored two runs on four straight hits against Sanchez in the eighth inning, but Hector Rodriguez was thrown out at the plate attempting to score on a Trey Faltine double. Rodriguez then popped out to short with two on and two out in the ninth to end a last-ditch Dayton rally. A Brennan Milone RBI double in the 4th and a Junior Perez two-run homer in the 7th supplied the Lugnuts' offense.

On Deck: The Lugnuts return to Jackson Field to host the West Michigan Whitecaps from August 29 through September 3.

Lug•Notes

Déjà Vu: The Lugnuts have defeated Dayton by identical 3-2 scores each of the last three night, which has precedent in the all-time series between the two ballclubs. From August 6-8, 2018, the Nuts beat the Dragons by identical 5-4 scores in three straight games. The streak ended on August 9, 2018... thanks to a 4-3 Lugnuts win.

Dragon Slayers: The Lugnuts' five starters who have worked this series, Jose Dicochea (5 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 2 K), Jacob Watters (4 IP, 2 H, 4 R, 8 K), James González (5 IP, 3 H, 1 R, 7 K), Jake Garland (6 IP, 5 H, 2 R, 4 K) and Gunnar Hoglund (5 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 7 K) have combined to allow 11 hits while striking out 28 batters in 25 innings. For the year, Lugnuts pitchers have whiffed 122 Dragons in 95 2/3 innings.

First Blood: Thanks to those fine starts, Lansing has scored first in each game of the series. On Tuesday, the Nuts led 4-0. On Wednesday, they led 2-0. On Thursday, they led 2-0. On Friday, they led 2-0. And last night they led 3-0.

Turnaround: CF Junior Pérez opened the year batting .082 (5-for-60) in his first 20 games, including a streak of 32 consecutive hitless at-bats. Since then, he is hitting .276 (88-for-319). His slash line by month: April - .089/.192/.089, .281 OPS; May - .238/.295/.438, .733 OPS; June - .256/.326/.372, .698 OPS; July - .262/.361/.393, .754 OPS; August - .304/.402/.565 .967 OPS. Junior has reached base 54 times in the last 27 games, thanks to 35 hits and 19 walks.

Jerome Holtzman, Represent: The Lugnuts have been playing closer and closer games as the season has gone on. By month: seven saves in 20 games in April (35%), nine in 27 games in May (33%), 15 in 24 in June (63%), 20 in 24 games in July (83%), and 19 in 23 games played in August (83%)

Historic on the 4th: A crowd of 11,521 packed in to Jackson Field on July 4, the largest home attendance in Lansing since July 4, 2013. It was also the largest single game crowd in all of High-A, let alone the Midwest League, and an attendance larger than any crowd drawn by every Minor League Baseball team save for six Triple-A teams (Buffalo, Albuquerque, Salt Lake, Indianapolis, Norfolk and Round Rock) and one Double-A team (Frisco).

The Cycle: On June 21 at Wisconsin, Jack Winkler went 4-for-4 with a single, double, triple, home run and four RBIs, becoming the eighth player in team history to hit for the cycle. The other cycles: Corey Patterson (7/5/99 at South Bend); Donnie Hood (4/21/03 vs. Dayton); Chip Cannon (6/2/05 vs. Clinton); Travis Snider (7/7/07 at Fort Wayne); Brad Glenn (7/26/10 vs. Clinton); Edward Olivares (4/24/17 vs. South Bend); and Ryan Gold (4/18/19 vs. Dayton)

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has four players acquired via trade by the Oakland Athletics on its roster: Christian Fernandez (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); Euribiel Ángeles (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea, and a 2021 member of the Fort Wayne TinCaps): Gunnar Hoglund (Toronto Blue Jays, 3/16/22, for Matt Chapman); and Junior Pérez (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo).

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster has three current first-rounders: the A's last two first-round selections in catcher Daniel Susac, taken 19th overall out of Arizona last year, and shortstop Jacob Wilson, the sixth overall pick this year from Grand Canyon University, plus the Blue Jays' 2021 first-round selection, Gunnar Hoglund, acquired via trade for Matt Chapman. The A's 2021 firstround selection, shortstop **Max Muncy**, opened the year on the Lugnuts' roster and is now with Double-A Midland.

Big League Nuts: Eight Lugnuts have made their MLB debuts in 2023, totaling 181 all-time. Those eight: Ryan Noda on March 30; Hogan Harris on April 14; Mason Miller on April 19; Garrett Acton on May 14; Samad Taylor on June 18; Tyler Soderstrom on July 14; and Lawrence Butler and Hagen Danner on August 11. Davis Schneider, who debuted with Toronto on August 4, played for the Nuts in the 2017 Crosstown Showdown but did not play in any regular season Lansing games.

History vs. Dayton

The Lugnuts are 212-171 all-time vs. the Dayton Dragons, their best winning percentage against any team in the Midwest League. They are 109-87 all-time at home against Dayton and 103-84 in the Gem City.

Last year, the Nuts went 5-6 vs. Dayton in Michigan's state capital, but took five of six games at Day Air Ballpark for a 10-7 record.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2012: The Lugnuts set a new franchise record for wins in a season, topping the Fort Wayne TinCaps 5-1 for their 79th victory. The Nuts will finish the year with 82 wins.

2014: The second and third Dragons batters, Alex Blandino and Robert Ramirez, set off the Fifth Third Field foghorn off with back-to-back home runs off Starlyn Suriel. That was the end of Dayton's hits and runs for the night. Tied 2-2 entering the ninth, Jason Leblebijian homered to left for a 3-2 victory, sparking a three-game Lugnuts sweep.

2018: Ryan Noda and Andres Sotillo supplied RBI knocks to break a 1-1 tie in the 9th, lifting the Nuts to a 3-1 victory and completing an 18-4 season series against Dayton.

2019: The Lugnuts drew 12 walks and the Great Lakes Loons had their manager, John Shoemaker, and three players ejected, but the Loons beat the Lugnuts, 12-9. Griffin Conine drew four walks by himself, tying the franchise record. He had the chance to break the record with a fifth walk but instead lashed an RBI double on a 3-1 pitch in the eighth inning.

In a Nutshell: The last Pitt Panther to appear in a game for the Nuts before Myers this year was also the only other Panther to play for the Nuts: T.J. Zeuch (pronounced "Zoyk"), the 21st pick in 2016, who made two starts in the Midwest League for Lansing in 2016, spent last season with the Cincinnati Reds, and is currently in Lehigh Valley (Triple-A - Philadelphia)... @mitch_myers9.

International Respect: Mitch is ranked No. 3 in the world in the video game *Super Monkey Ball...* he is also considered the top chess player in the Lugnuts' clubhouse.

Hometown Hero: Hometown of Lanett's motto is "The Gateway to Alabama," since it sits directly on the Eastern border to Georgia, directly bordering West Point, Georgia... pitched for Valley High School as a freshman and sophomore and Opelika High School as a junior and senior, posting a career 1.22 ERA with a fastball/curveball mix, playing third base, and batting third... father Barry starred in baseball at Jacksonville State.

The Buc Starts Here: Initially committed to University of Alabama, but coach instability led to Mitch joining juco Florida Southwestern State instead, making 15 appearances, 14 starts, in both 2017-18 and 2018-19... as a freshman: 5-6, 4.28, 2 CG, 73 2/3, 35 BB, 62 K, 1 HR... as a sophomore: 7-2, 3.29, 3 CG, 79 1/3, 23 BB, 88 K, 3 HR... became one of 10 Bucs to sign on with a D-I program (not including Ryan Gusto, who was drafted in the 11th round by the Astros).

Onward to Pitt: Upon transferring to Pittsburgh, made four starts in 2020 (2-2, 3.52, 23 IP, 4 BB, 30 K, 0 HR) before the season was shut down, with 10 strikeouts in six shutout innings vs. Lehigh... followed in 2021 as Pitt's Friday starter: 13 GS, 5-5, 3.21, 1 CG, 81 1/3, 23 BB, team-leading 83 K, 6 HR... tossed 9-IP CG at Virginia, 3/20/21, allowing three hits, one run, and whiffing five.

2022 Professional Debut: After signing for \$125,000 as the Athletics' 12th-round selection in 2021, did not appear in a Minor League game until 2022, spent entirely with Stockton... led Ports in starts (22, six more than the closest teammate), innings (124 1/3, 28 1/3 more innings than the closest teammate), and double plays (10)... worked seven innings five times, 6 2/3 innings once, 6 1/3 innings twice, and six innings four times: 12 starts of 22 starts lasting at least six innings... struggled in 12 games, 11 starts, at home (7.11 ERA, .304 avg, 16 HR, in 57 innings) compared to 11 starts on the road (4.14 ERA, .269, 10 HR in 67 1/3 innings)... lefties and righties hit nearly identically: .286/.355/.536 for lefties, .285/.339/.525 for righties, though righties hit 17 of the 26 home runs allowed... struggled mightily in first innings, allowing .353/.402/.627 slash line and six home runs... opposing base stealers swiped 10 bases in 16 attempts.

2023 with the Lugnuts: Opened season as the Nuts' Wednesday starter... tossed first quality start of the year on April 27, allowing two runs (both in the 5th) in six innings vs. Quad Cities April 27... followed up with a second quality start on May 4 vs. Dayton, though he once again received a no-decision... struck on the back of the head by a line drive against Peoria on June 13 and spent two weeks on the Injured List, missing his scheduled start at Wisconsin before returning to action at Great Lakes on July 3... tossed another quality start (6 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 0 BB, 6 K) against Quad Cities on July 27.
