TODAY'S GAME: The Curve continue a seven-game set at Harrisburg this week. Altoona won 3-of-5 games in their first series of the season at PNG Field.
LAST TIME OUT: Altoona was swept in a doubleheader at Harrisburg, falling 6-5 and 7-2. With the losses, Altoona's franchise record losing streak has hit 13 games.

CRAFT COMPLETE: Starter Braxton Ashcraft tossed his first career complete game, matching his career-high with 6.0 IP in a 6-5 loss in a 7-inning game against Harrisburg on May 2. Ashcraft finished 6.0 IP for the first time since July 30, 2019 while he was pitching for short-season West Virginia.
STREAKING: Another franchise record has fallen as OF Joe Perez now owns the longest on-base streak in Altoona's franchise history. After reaching base safely in all 25 games for Altoona in 2023, Perez reached in 10 straight games to begin his 2024 tenure with the Curve. Perez's 35-game stretch saw him bat . $317 / .447 / .525 / .972$ OPS with $42 \mathrm{~B}, 7 \mathrm{HR}, 21 \mathrm{RBI}, 26 \mathrm{BB}$ and 2-3 SB and bested Ronny Paulino (July 12-Sept. 5, 2004) and Steve Pearce (June 15-July 22, 2007).

NOTHING SULLEN: Righty Sean Sullivan has hit his stride early this season, delivering three straight outings of 5.0 IP and 1 R or fewer allowed. Since April 18, Sullivan has a 1.20 ERA (1 ER, 15.0 IP) and ranks 8th among Double-A pitchers in ERA (1.20) and 8th in the Eastern League in WHIP (0.93).
SOME HISTORY: Altoona's $5-19$ start is the worst record for the club through 24 games in franchise history, surpassing the 2009 Curve who started the season 6-18. The 5 wins in the month of April were the fewest for the team in a calendar month in which they played at least 15 games.

A STREAK TO FORGET: The Curve have dropped 13 straight games entering play on Friday, May 3, the longest losing streak in franchise history. It is the longest losing streak by an Eastern League team since Richmond lost 14 straight in 2016.
WELL THAT DOESN'T FEEL GOOD: The Curve dropped all six games in their series with Akron from April 23-28, the first time since the adoption of the 6 -game schedule that Altoona has been swept in their series.
FEELING PEACHY: Curve infielder Kervin Pichardo has been one of the league's hottest hitters from April 16-May 1, picking up a hit in 10 straight games. He batted .382/.462/.529/.991 OPS with 2 2B, 1 HR, 5 RBI, 5 BB, 1-1 SB during the streak which was the 3 rd-longest active streak in the Eastern League and the longest by a Curve batter this season when it ended on May 1 at Harrisburg Pichardo has maintained his on-base streak, which is up to 13 straight games (. 404 OBP).

POWER OUTAGE: Altoona's 14 home runs hit through 24 games ranks T-25th among 30 Double-A teams. Harrisburg has also hit only 15 homers this season, the second-lowest mark in the EL.
THE MAJOR LEAGUE CURVE: Altoona's group features several staff and players with previous major league experience. On the coaching staff Manager Robby Hammock played 182 games in the major leagues with the Arizona Diamondbacks, highlighted by catching Randy Johnson's Perfect Game. Pitching Coach Fernando Nieve made 99 major league appearances with the Astros and NY Mets in his playing career, Catching and Game Planning Coordinator Taylor Davis played 22 games with the Cubs and Pirates before joining the coaching ranks this off-season and Bench Coach Gary Green played 106 games in the majors with the Padres, Rangers and Reds. Among the players, RHP Isaac Mattson made five appearances for Baltimore in 2021 and INF Seth Beer played 43 games with Arizona across the 2021 and 2022 seasons.

THE MEN FROM THE UPPER CHAMBER: Delino DeShields is back for his second season managing the Washington Nationals Double-A affiliate. Harrisburg features the next wave of Nationals stars highlighted by outfielders Robert Hassell III, Brady House and Dylan Crews. Crews and Paul Skenes were the first collegiate teammates ever to be selected No. 1 and No. 2 in the draft when they went to start the 2023 draft.
THE FIRST TO FILIBUSTER: Brad Lord makes his second start of the season against Altoona. Lord tossed 4.2 innings in his Double-A debut at Altoona on April 14 where he picked up 7 strikeouts. Lord was Washington's 18th round pick in 2022 out of the University o South Florida. Lord hails from Tallahassee, Florida and went 4-6 with a 4.04 ERA between Fredericksburg and Wilmington last season in 27 games, 17 starts. Lord grew up an Atlanta Braves fan and listed Ronald Acuna as his favorite player while he was at USF. Lord models his game after Gerrit Cole and allegedly wore the same sliders and socks every time he pitched in college. Lord told USF Sports Information that he would want to work in Law Enforcement, like his father, after his career on the diamond wraps up.
