Today's Games: The Nashville Sounds and Louisville Bats play games five and six of the series this afternoon at First Horizon Park. The two teams will resume Saturday's game that was suspended in the bottom of the third with Nashville leading 7-0. Sunday's originally scheduled game will follow 30 minutes after the completion of game one.

Alec Bettinger: 26-year-old Alec Bettinger picks up for Josh Lindblom in game one. The right-hander is making his third appearance of the season. He pitched as the opener on May 8 and 15, tossing 3.0 innings on the 8th and 2.0 innings on the 15th at Jacksonville. He is 0-0 with a 7.20 ERA (5.0 IP/4 ER). Bettinger spent the majority of his 2021 season with Nashville and went 3-7 with a 4.75 ERA (96.2 IP/51 ER) in 21 games (18 starts). He also made four appearances (one start) with Milwaukee. He began his 2021 season with Milwaukee and was optioned on May 9 for the first time. Bettinger enters the 2022 season as the No. 24 prospect in the Brewers organization according to Baseball America and the No. 23 prospect according to MLB Pipeline. Milwaukee drafted Bettinger in the 10th round of the 2017 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Virginia.

Robert Dugger: 26-year-old Robert Dugger starts for the Bats in game two today. The right-hander just joined Louisville on May 16 after he was designated for assignment by Cincinnati and outrighted to Louisville. Dugger began his 2022 season with the Tampa Bay organization and pitched in five games with Triple-A Durham and one game with Tampa Bay before being designated for assignment on May 2. He was claimed off waivers by the Reds on May 4. Dugger spent his 2021 season in the Seattle organization and pitched in 12 games (4 starts) with the Mariners and 15 games (14 starts) with Triple-A Tacoma. He has a career big league mark of 0-6 with a 7.29 ERA (79.0 IP/64 ER) in 25 games (12 starts). He was drafted by Seattle in the 18th round of the 2016 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Texas Tech.

Superlatives...Friday night the Sounds improved to 24-0 when leading after 8 innings...16-6 at First Horizon Park...11-1 when recording 10+ hits...22-1 when scoring first...8-3 against left-handed starters.

Chasing Larry Gilbert: Manager Rick Sweet has 2,128 career wins as a minor league manager. His win Friday pulled him into a tie with Larry Gilbert for 7th-most all-time. Gilbert amassed 821 wins as manager of the Nashville Vols from 1939-1948 and is the winningest manager in Nashville baseball history. Gilbert led the Vols to eight playoff berths and four Southern League championships during his 10-year tenure as manager of the Vols. Trent Jewett has the most managerial wins by a Sounds manager with 320.

Super Mario: Sounds catcher Mario Feliciano added a hit Friday night to extend his hitting streak to six games. He's hitting .550 (11-for-20) with 2 runs, 1 double, 1 RBI and 3 walks during the streak.

Knocks All Around: Five Nashville hitters turned in two-hit games Friday night. Brice Turang had his team-leading 11th multi-hit game of the year, Mark Mathias had two hits and has 10 multi-hit games this season and Tyler White, Pablo Reyes and Andruw Monasterio had two hits apiece.

There will be Math: Infielder Mark Mathias has hit safely in seven consecutive games, his longest hitting streak of the season. During the seven-game streak, Mathias is hitting .458 (11-for-24) with 3 runs, 1 home run, 4 RBI and 4 walks.

Six Shooter: The Sounds have won every series they have played this year. It's the first time since at least 1987 the team has won its first six series in a season (team records date back to 1988).

Earn It: Nashville's team ERA sits at 2.88 (344.0 IP/110 ER) after last night's sixth shutout of the season. The 2.98 ERA is the best mark across Triple-A Baseball, far ahead of Iowa with a 3.30 ERA. Nashville's six shutouts also leads Triple-A Baseball.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his third season overall and second consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. Sweet led the Sounds to a 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville opened the 2022 season with four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Infielder Brice Turang is the No. 4 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 7 prospect, catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 21 prospect and right-handed pitcher Dylan File is the No. 25 prospect.

LAST OUTING: Bettinger last pitched as the "opener" on May 15 at Jacksonville and tossed 2.0 innings in Nashville's 11-6 win. He allowed four runs on three hits and a walk. He struck out a pair of batters and threw 28 of 42 pitches for strikes.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Bettinger faced Louisville five times (four starts) during the 2021 season and went 0-3 with a 5.87 ERA (23.0 IP/15 ER). He yielded 27 hits and 5 walks to go along with 26 strikeouts in the five outings.
