vs. the Norfolk Tides (Baltimore Orioles) at Harbor Park. It's the 10th of 18 meetings between the two clubs this season, and the fourth of 12 games in Virginia. The Stripers are riding a two-game road winning streak after dropping their previous five road games (4 at DUR, 1 at NOR).

VS. NORFOLK: The Stripers are 7-2 (.778) in nine games vs. Norfolk (5-1 home, 2-1 road), their best record against an opponent so far this year. Gwinnett is 9-2-1 in 12 season series all-time vs. Norfolk (since 2009), and hasn't lost a season series since 2013 (went 7-14)

BEST FOR LAST: Chadwick Tromp belted a solo home run (off LHP Kevin Smith) in the top of the seventh inning in Game 2 yesterday, sending the Stripers to their seventh last-at-bat win of the season. Gwinnett is 7-3 (.700) in games decided in the last at-bat this year. Tromp has tallied the GWRBI twice in those seven wins, including on 5/5 vs. Charlotte (2-out RBI double in 8th for 3-2 win).

ON THE OFFENSIVE: Gwinnett leads the International League in team batting since 4/23, hitting .274 (261-for-952, 53 2B, 3 3B, 31 HR, 139 RBI, 16 SB) over 29 games in that span. That's one point higher than Nashville (2nd, .273 in 28G). The Stripers rank fourth in Triple-A in batting since 4/23, trailing Albuquerque (.284 in 29G), Reno (.278 in 29G), and Round Rock (.275 in 29G) of the PCL.

KINGS OF THE "K": Gwinnett pitchers lead Triple-A in strikeouts with 473 in 45 games (10.51 SO per game). That's nine more than Sacramento of the PCL (2nd with 464 SO in 45G). Gwinnett last led Triple-A in strikeouts for a full season in 2011 (team-record 1,223 SO). Kyle Muller (T-5th, 49) and Touki Toussaint (T-7th, 46) both rank among the IL top five in strikeouts through 5/26.

THE GOOSE IS LOOSE: Phil Gosselin went 3-for-6 with a double and two RBI in yesterday's twin-bill, giving him an RBI in four straight games (.429, 6-for-14, 1 2B, 2 HR, 3 R, 4 RBI, 1.396 OPS in that stretch). Gosselin has notched hits in 15 of 17 games in May, batting .349 (22-for-63, 5 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR, 10 R, 9 RBI, 2 SB, 1.030 OPS).

• GWN Career: Over parts of four seasons with the club (2013-14, 2018, 2022), Gosselin is batting .297 (297-for-1000, 59 2B, 10 3B, 17 HR, 134 R, 99 RBI, 10 SB, .773 OPS) with 82 multi-hit efforts in 272 games

RISING WATERS: Since being reinstated from the 7-day IL on 5/3, Drew Waters is batting .304 (17-for-56, 4 2B, 2 HR, 9 R, 5 RBI, .810 OPS) in 14 games.

- Start It With a Bang: Both of his homers have come on the first pitch of the game (5/3 vs. CLT off LHP Wes Benjamin and 5/11 at DUR off RHP Tommy Romero), the third and fourth leadoff homers of his Triple-A career.
- GWN Career: Since 2019, he's batting .252 (143-for-567, 31 2B, 1 3B, 15 HR, 96 R, 53 RBI, 31 SB in 143G).

<u>TONIGHT:</u> The Stripers play game four of a six-game series **<u>POWER UP:</u>** Greyson Jenista and Chadwick Tromp each ended homer droughts in Game 2 yesterday.

- Jenista: His solo shot (off LHP Zac Lowther) was his first long-ball since a two-homer game in the Stripers' Home Opener on 4/12 vs. Nashville. The blast, Jenista's fifth of the year, snapped a 28-game homer drought.
- Tromp: His game-winning solo clout (off LHP Kevin Smith) was his first round-tripper since 5/12 at Durham, the final game of his 13-game hitting streak (.385 from 4/24-5/12), 11-game RBI streak (23 RBI from 4/28-5/12), and nine-game extra-base hit streak (11 XBH from 5/1-5/12). Tromp's team-leading ninth blast of the year snapped a seven-game homer drought.

SHEW-MAKING IT HAPPEN: Braden Shewmake is batting .400 (6-for-15, 1 2B, 1 3B, 3 R, 1 RBI, 1.038 OPS) in his last four games, including the second four-hit game of his career on 5/21 vs. Memphis (4-for-4, 2B, R, RBI). Through the first 35 games of his Triple-A debut, he is batting .294 (37-for-126, 8 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR, 18 R, 7 RBI, 4 SB, .778 OPS) with 11 multi-hit efforts (tied for team lead).

FIRST SAVE FOR VODNIK: Victor Vodnik recorded the first save of his Triple-A career in Game 2 yesterday (1.0 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 2 SO in 3-2 win). He has made three scoreless appearances since joining Gwinnett on 5/17 (4.0 IP, 0 H. 3 BB, 3 SO). Vodnik has yet to allow a run over 11.0 IP (4 H, 6 BB, 17 SO) spanning 10 outings between Gwinnett and Double-A Mississippi this season. He is the sixth player to make his Triple-A debut with the Stripers in 2022 (Dean, Jenista, Shewmake, Winans, Woods).

DESHIELDS KEEPS REACHING: Delino DeShields Jr. has reached base safely in 28 of 32 games with Gwinnett, posting team-highs in walks (21) and on-base percentage (.417). Overall he's batting .277 (26-for-94, 4 2B, 0 3B, 0 HR, 12 R, 10 RBI) with a team-high eight stolen bases (8for-13, 61.5%). For his career (MiLB and MLB), DeShields has 413 stolen bases in 1,299 games.

PROSPECTING: Gwinnett's active roster features five on the MLB.com Braves Top 30 Prospects list: OF Drew Waters (2), LHP Kyle Muller (3), RHP Bryce Elder (4), SS Braden Shewmake (5), and RHP Victor Vodnik (12).

CHAMPIONSHIP EXPERIENCE: The Stripers' roster includes three players who saw time with the World Series champion Atlanta Braves last year: Kyle Muller, Touki Toussaint, and Huascar Ynoa. Of that group, only Ynoa pitched in the Postseason, appearing once in the NLDS (0-0, 18.00 ERA, 2 ER in 1.0 IP). Additionally, Greyson Jenista, Nolan Kingham, Braden Shewmake, Victor Vodnik, and coach Devon Travis were all part of the Double-A South champion Mississippi Braves in 2021.

MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

Matt Tuiasosopo is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) ... In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... From 7/8/21-9/21/21, his Stripers owned the best record in Triple-A Baseball (45-19, .703) ... Began his managerial career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for Minor League Manager of the Year ... Coached at the Braves' Alternate Training Site in 2020.

PROSPECTING: Muller is currently ranked as the Atlanta Braves' No. 3 prospect by MLB.com ... He is the top-ranked pitcher on Gwinnett's active roster.

2022 WITH GWINNETT: 4/5 at MEM: Was the Stripers' Opening Night starter (ND, 4.2 IP, 4 H, 1 ER, 1 BB, 7 SO in 2-1 loss), making him the first player in Gwinnett history to start consecutive season openers (also on 5/4/21 at Charlotte) ... 4/5-4/23: Went 1-1 with a 3.66 ERA in four starts before being recalled by Atlanta on 5/1 ... 5/14 at DUR: Tied his career high with 12 strikeouts, but took the loss (6.0 IP, 6 H, 4 ER, 2 HR), pitched opposite his older brother Chris (1.0 IP, 2 BB, 2 SO with DUR in 6th) for the first time in his professional career.

2022 WITH ATLANTA: Recalled by the Braves on 5/1 ... Dallas native started that night against the Texas Rangers in Arlington (loss, 2.2 IP, 4 H, career-high 7 ER, 6 BB, 3 SO in Braves' 7-3 loss) ... Optioned back to Gwinnett after the game.

2021 SEASON: Muller made both his Triple-A debut with Gwinnett (5-4, 3.39 ERA, .223 BAA in 17 starts) and Major League debut with Atlanta (2-4, 4.17 ERA, .202 BAA in 9G, 8 starts) ... Posted a 4.60 ERA in his first stint with the Stripers (7 starts) before being recalled for his MLB debut on 6/16 vs. Boston (1.0 IP in relief, 4 H, 2 ER, 1 SO) ... Made his first MLB start on 6/21 at the New York Mets (loss, 4.0 IP, 0 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 3 SO in 4-2 loss) ... Earned his first MLB win on 6/27 at Cincinnati (5.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 9 SO in 4-0 win) ... Optioned back to Gwinnett on 7/4 and for good on 8/13 ... 
