AFC Richmond: The Patriots and Flying Squirrels conclude their six-game series tonight at The Diamond. The two teams split the first four games of this series thus far before Richmond took a series lead with a 7-3 win in Saturday's rain-shortened game. Three games have been decided by one run, with a pair of games going into extra innings.

Bronx Zoo: Prior to Friday night's game, the New York Yankees annouced that four Patriots had been transferred to Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre: C Donny Sands, OF Thomas Milone, INF Cristian Perez, and UT Matt Pita. Additionally, INF Jesus Bastidas was transferred to Somerset from Low-A Tampa. The 22 year-old hit .218 over 38 games with four home runs, 18 RBI, 20 runs scored and five stolen bases this season for Tampa.

#SCTop10: RHP Hayden Wesneski used his right foot to kick a fourth-inning groundball to third baseman Max Burt to induce a 1-5-3 putout. The play was named the No. 2 play on SportsCenter's Top 10 list. It marks the second time this year the Patriots have been featured on Sportscenter's Top 10. Outfielder Matt Pita was featured as the No. 10 play of the night on May 19th in Hartford after he made a diving catch into foul netting.

Ozzy Ozzy Ozzy!: Infielder Oswald Peraza went 2-for-5 with a run scored, one RBI, two doubles and two stolen bases Saturday night. He is 8-for-19 (.421) with a home run, three RBI, three doubles, five runs and three stolen bases in the current series at Richmond, including at least one run scored in each of the first four games. The top Yankees prospect has thrived in July, batting .350 (21-for-60) with two home runs, six RBI, 13 runs, five stolen bases and a .391 OBP. He has nine multi-hit games over his 15 games in July, including two-hit performances in each of his last five games.

Gill-I-Am: Outfielder Isiah Gilliam was hit by a pitch last night and has now reached base safely in 21 of his last 23 games dating back to June 15th. Over that stretch, the switch-hitter is batting .323 (20-for-62) with two home runs, seven runs, 11 RBI, eight doubles, 16 walks and a .463 OBP. He's 3-for-12 this week with three doubles & three runs.

Back-2-Back Jacks: Brandon Lockridge and Michael Beltre went hit back-to-back two-out home runs in the fourth inning Friday night. It marked the seventh time this season Somerset has launched back-to-back home runs and their 14th multi-homer inning. It was the second time that Beltre has been a part of back-to-back homers (5/27 G1 vs. NH).

Hits and Misses: The Patriots pitching staff has the lowest ERA (3.05) among all of Minor League Baseball (full season). The staff also owns the lowest BAA (.205) and third-lowest WHIP (1.13) in all of Minor League Baseball. Additionally, Somerset has the most strikeouts (721) among all Double-A clubs.
