BULLPEN SHINES IN 5-1 LOSS

The Jumbo Shrimp bullpen pitched five innings of one-hit ball on Saturday, but Jacksonville was felled by the Worcester Red Sox 5-1 at 121 Financial Ballpark. Worcester earned a wire-to-wire win, plating two in the first and three more in the third on a **Johan Mieses** home run. Jacksonville scratched out its lone run on **Erik González's** RBI single in the fourth. In relief of Jumbo Shrimp starter **Matthew Kent, Bryan Mitchell** walked only one in 2.1 innings out of the bullpen. **Jake Fishman** ceded just one hit in the final 2.2 frames of relief for Jacksonville.

LEWIN AND CLARK BURDICK (AND GONZÁLEZ)

Jacksonville has received sizable contributions offensively from first baseman Lewin Díaz, outfielder Peyton Burdick and designated hitter Norel González to star the season. In fact, of the 24 runs the Jumbo Shrimp have scored this season - a figure that ranks in the top half of the International League - the trio have either driven in or scored 17 of those tallies (not double-counting home runs by Burdick or Díaz), a ratio of 70.8 percent.

DON'T CRY... SMILE BECAUSE IT HAPPENED

Jacksonville finished the 2021 season, which marked the club's return to Triple-A for the first time since 1962-68, with a 75-55 (.577) record - the club's best mark since an 81-59 (.579) tally in 2014. The 2021 campaign represented Jacksonville's first winning record since that 2014 season, and the Jumbo Shrimp won with plenty of dramatics; Twenty-one of Jacksonville's 75 victories came in the club's last at-bat. Those close victories have helped the Jumbo Shrimp go a whopping 49-28 (.636) in games decided by three runs or fewer, the second-best record in the league in contests determined by those slim margins.

The Jumbo Shrimp finished 2021 with a 75-55 (.577) record, something the club accomplished despite a whopping 287 roster moves. Jacksonville used a remarkable 77 different players in 2021, shattering the previous club record of 65 that was set in 2018. Of those 77 players, 38 were pitchers, which tied a club record. The Jumbo Shrimp had 21 different pitchers start a game in 2021, again marking a franchise record.

BATMEN

Through five games on the season, the Jumbo Shrimp have compiled 24 runs, a total of 4.8 per game, which ranks tied for seventh in the International League. Jacksonville has done this mainly by scoring in bunches thus far this season. The Jumbo Shrimp have plated multiple runs in an inning in eight of the 14 frames the club has scored in thus far. Additionally, the club's longest drought without scoring was a six-inning scoreless from the third through eighth innings on Friday against Worcester.

POWER LIP?

Though Jacksonville is 1-4 to start the season, the Jumbo Shrimp have popped six home runs thus far, tied for sixth in the International League. The home run power the Jumbo Shrimp have shown has been a rarity for teams on the First Coast of late; no Jacksonville team has finished outside the bottom 10 in either Triple-A (2021) or Double-A (2014-19) in home runs since 2013, when the Jacksonville Suns bashed 104 bombs to place 14th in Double-A. The last time a Jacksonville club ranked in the top 10 of its league in long balls was 2009, when the Suns cracked 110 homers.

'PEN PALS

Despite logging 24.1 innings compared to Jacksonville starters' 20.2 frames through the season's first five games, the Jumbo Shrimp bullpen has started to put together some fine performances of late. On Thursday, Jacksonville relievers pitched 4.1 shutout frames of one-hit ball, striking out nine without walking a batter. After a rough patch on Friday, the club's bullpen put together 5.0 scoreless innings on Saturday, ceding only one hit with five punchouts.

ABOUT PAUL

-Campbell was originally selected by the Tampa Bay Rays in the 21st round of the 2017 draft out of Clemson University. A three-year member of the Tigers' staff as mainly a long reliever and spot starter, Campbell made just 30 appearances, including three starts, over those three seasons. He went 0-2 with a 7.85 ERA, but did strike out 46 batters against 20 walks in 39.0 career collegiate innings.

-A native of Malden, Massachusetts, Campbell is the first Malden resident to be drafted professionally since Malden High alumnus Keith Forbes was picked out of Wallace (Ala.) Community College in the 37th round of the 1997 draft by San Diego.

-After pitching to a 13-8 record and 3.67 ERA in 144.2 innings (112 K, 37 BB, 126 H) over 27 games, including 20 starts, between Double-A Montgomery and High-A Port Charlotte in 2019, Campbell was selected by the Marlins with the 13th pick of the 2020 Rule 5 draft. Thus, he had to be retained on Marlins' 26-man roster in 2021 or be offered back to their original team. The cost to acquire a Rule 5 Draft pick in the MLB phase is \$100,000. If the player is returned, teams receive \$50,000 back

2022 SEASON

2021 SEASON

-Campbell made his major league debut for the Marlins on April 3, 2021 against his former organization, Tampa Bay, at Marlins Park. He yielded three runs on four hits in 2.0 innings of relief, striking out one and walking one

-Campbell's first start came on May 1, 2021 in Washington, D.C., at Nationals Park. The Nats tagged him for five runs, four earned, on nine hits in 3.2 innings

-The Malden, Mass., native surrendered at least one run in each of his five outings with the Marlins

-On May 3, 2021, Campbell was suspended 80 games after testing positive for an anabolic steroid in violation of Major League Baseball's drug program.

-Campbell was assigned to Jacksonville on July 20 on a rehab assignment.

2019 SEASON

-In the second half of the season, Campbell finished strong, going 7-4 with a 3.22 ERA in $14\,$ games, including nine starts. Over 72.2 innings, he ceded just 60 hits and 18 walks against 55 strikeouts. Opponents batted .229 against him.

-In seven games with both Port Charlotte and Montgomery as a reliever, Campbell posted a 4-0 record and 0.96 ERA. Over 37.2 innings, he surrendered only five runs, four earned, on 22 hits with 35 strikeouts and only five walks.

-Left-handed batters posted an .866 OPS in 138 plate appearances against Campbell while with Montgomery. However, he held right-handed hitters to a .527 OPS in 204 plate appearances as a Biscuit.

2018 SEASON

-Campbell's lone appearance out of the bullpen came on August 25, 2018, when Low-A Bowling Green hosted Lake County. The right-hander worked 4.0 hitless innings, fanning three against one free pass
