FIGUERO'S FIREY MAY: Third baseman Gleider Figuereo finished May tied for the second-most home runs in the month. Over 31 days, Figuereo crushed eight home runs, even with GBO's Keiner Delgado and ASH's Joseph Sullivan and one behind GBO's Esmerlyn Valdez.

PUSH FOR THE PLAYOFFS: With 15 games remaining in the first half of the SAL season, the Spartanburgers are a half-game behind Bowling Green in the South Division. The Hot Rods have back-to-back series against cellar dwellers (JS, then WS) and Hub City hosts Aberdeen after a week in Greensboro.

THE JOSE WAY: Jose Gonzalez delivered his best start of the season Sunday in a 3-1 win over Winston-Salem, tossing six innings of shutout ball with nine strikeouts. Gonzalez spanned six innings for the first time since July of 2024.

SHUT DOWN STARTS: Spartanburgers starters have now gone 12 straight games without surrendering more than two earned runs. Dating back to the start of last week's Rome series, the Hub City starters have allowed just 6 earned runs across almost 61 innings (0.89 ERA). Last week, David Davalillo tied a career high with 10 strikeouts. Leandro Lopez, Josh Trentadue, D.J. McCarty and Jose Gonzalez all set new season highs with innings pitched.

BUGS IN A BANDBOX: Greensboro leads the South Atlantic League in HR (78). The Grasshoppers have smashed 49 at First National Bank Field and 29 on the road. GBO pitching has given up 39, the most home homers allowed of any team in High-A baseball.

HOMERS IN THE UPSTATE: Hub City has managed to hit every home run of its season at either Fifth Third Park in Spartanburg or Fluor Field in Greenville. Hub City has hit 27 homers in 30 games at home. In the first three road trips, the Spartanburgers did not hit a single home run. In just six games at the Drive, the Spartanburgers left the park eight times.

ROUND ONE: The Grasshoppers took the final four games of the two teams' first series, starting a seven-game slide for the 'Burgers. Hub City lost each game in a unique bizarre way, with three errors coming

The Hub City Spartanburgers, High-A affiliate of the Texas Rangers, were first announced in 2023. Diamond Baseball Holdings purchased the Down East

Wood Ducks, the Single-A Rangers affiliate at the time, and announced they would move the team to a new ballpark in Spartanburg, SC for the 2025 season. In May 2024, the team was announced with the name of "Hub City Spartanburgers". Two months later, MiLB decided that the Spartanburgers would be a member of the High-A South Atlantic League and the Hickory Crawdads would move down to Single-A. Tyson Jeffers was announced in October 2023 as the team's first general manager, and Chad Comer serves as the first manager in Spartanburger's history.

Fifth Third Park is the crown jewel of downtown Spartanburg. With Fifth Third Bank serving as the naming rights sponsor, the brand-new ballpark seats over 5,000 people. The Johnson



Group provided oversight on the project while Overland Partners served as the architect and Robins & Morton as the general contractor. The ballpark is a part of a \$425 million development in downtown Spartanburg, S.C. Groundbreaking took place with a ceremony on November 1, 2023. The ballpark officially opened for baseball on April 1, 2025 when Wofford College defeated USC Upstate 5-2 in the ballpark's first game. The next night, the Spartanburgers hosted the Hickory Crawdads for a preseason exhibition. The first official Spartanburgers game is the home opener in 2025 against Bowling Green.



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Chad Comer - Manager

Chad Comer is the first ever manager of the Hub City Spartanburgers. He enters his tenth year as a coach in the minor leagues and joins Hub City after two seasons as the manager of the then-High-A Hickory Crawdads. Comer played collegiately for the University of Texas-Arlington. A four-year starter, he was named to the Buster Posey Watch List prior to his senior season. He was drafted in the 29th round of the 2011 MLB Draft by the Atlanta Braves, and he played two seasons of minor league baseball.



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Drew Sannes - Hitting Coach

Drew Sannes joins the Hub City Spartanburgers as the hitting coach for the 2025 season after spending the past two years as the hitting coach for the Hickory Crawdads. In 2022, Sannes served as a development coach for the ACL Rangers. His coaching career began in 2020 when he served as the head coach at North Iowa Community College. As a player, Sannes started his collegiate career at the University of North Dakota. He finished it hitting .275 in two seasons with Concordia University-St. Paul.



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Thomas St. Clair - Pitching Coach

Thomas St. Clair begins his fourth season as a coach in the Texas Rangers organization and first as the pitching coach for the Hub City Spartanburgers. St. Clair previously served as the pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College. The Winston-Salem, NC native played his college ball at Lenoir-Rhyne. He was drafted in the 24th round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the St. Louis Cardinals. St. Clair played two seasons in the minor leagues.



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Jay Sullenger - Development Coach

Jay Sullenger has served as a player development coach in the Rangers organization since 2019. Previously, Sullenger spent five years as the head coach at Biola University and over a decade as the associate head coach at James Madison University.

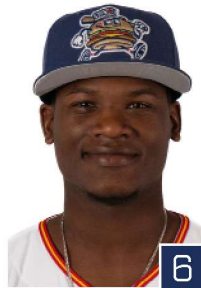
