SECOND HALF FREDDIES DO IT AGAIN: After punching their playoff ticket with an electric walk-off grand slam from Jorgelys Mota last night, the FredNats can enjoy the last weekend of the regular season against the Carolina Mudcats. Fredericksburg clinched the second half title for the second year in a row and the third time in the last four seasons last night, and will play the Lynchburg Hillcats in the first round of the Carolina League playoffs as they aim to defend last year's title.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Carolina scored an unearned run off FredNat starter Bryan Polanco in the top of the 1st inning, and did not score again as Jorgelys Mota walloped a walk-off grand slam to break a 1-1 tie with two outs in the bottom of the 9th inning. Brenner Cox hit a solo home run in the 7th inning to tie the game, and the FredNats rallied for their professional baseball-leading 13th walk-off victory of the season to clinch the second half and punch the playoff ticket. Polanco pitched six innings of one-run ball, and Ben Moore pitched two scoreless innings in his pro debut. Owen Puk got the win with a scoreless 9th inning.

FREDNAT MAINSTAYS: Jorgelys Mota and Randal Diaz have been with the FredNats since opening day, and both have had a major impact in this series. On Wednesday, Diaz had the first four-hit game of the year for a FredNat and also hit his first pro home run. He had three of the four RBIs in the game. Mota hit the walk-off grand slam last night to punch the playoff ticket, and has home runs of 418 and 424 feet in the last two games.

GOOD JOB BAZ: Fredericksburg's MiLB-leading caught stealing total is up to 93, eight ahead of Fayetteville, who is in second place. Heading into play today, Kevin Bazzell leads MiLB with 59 caught stealings and owns the best CS% of all MiLB catchers who have played at least 400 innings this year, throwing out 38% of would-be base stealers. In addition to the phenomenal defense Bazzell has played all season, he's now enjoying his best stretch of the year with the bat too, finishing up a month of August in which he hit .333. In his last 10 games, Bazzell is hitting .375 with an .862 OPS.

WOWED BY WILLITS: 17-year-old Eli Willits - the number one overall pick in the 2025 MLB Draft - made his professional debut last home stand and has hits in 10 of the first 13 professional games he's played. Overall, Willits is 14-for-47 (.298) with seven walks, five RBI and two stolen bases. Willits, Washington's No. 1 prospect and the 18th best in all of baseball, won't turn 18 until December. He became the youngest FredNat ever, the youngest player in the Carolina League this season, and is currently the second youngest active player in full-season Minor League Baseball. Andrew Salas of the Jupiter Hammerheads is four months younger than Willits. Eli comes from a baseball family, his father Reggie played six seasons in the Major Leagues and is currently the Associate Head Coach at the University of Oklahoma, where his older brother Jaxon is the starting shortstop.

INSTANT IMPACT: The other members of Washington's draft class that are also with Fredericksburg have had exceptional starts to their professional careers. Second-rounder Ethan Petry (South Carolina) has played 23 games with Fredericksburg, and is hitting .291 with an .828 OPS. He hit his second pro home run in last night's game, and he's drawn 13 walks in 22 games as well. Nick Hollifield (UAB) has been a clutch force with the bat for the FredNats. On the last home stand alone, Hollifield had five game-tying RBIs in the 6th inning or later, plus a walk-off single on Sunday against Salem.

START EARLY, HOLD ON LATE: The FredNats are 64-63 overall this season, but are 16 games over .500 (36-20) when scoring first in 2025. In the first two innings this season, Fredericksburg has been outscored 97-128 (-31). The FredNats have also been exceptional at holding on to late-game leads this year. The team is 45-2 when leading after seven innings, and 37-2 when leading after eight.

THE STAFF: After Jake Lowery's third season as Manager of the FredNats ended in a Carolina League championship in 2024, the FredNats welcome Billy McMillon as the third Manager in Fredericksburg franchise history. McMillon, 53, has spent the last three seasons in the Nationals organization as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. He also played parts of six seasons in the Major Leagues with Oakland, Detroit, Philadelphia and Florida. He's joined on the staff by returning Pitching Coach Justin Lord, returning Hitting Coach Mike Habas, Development Coach Luis Ordaz, returning Athletic Trainer Jacob Meyer, Strength & Conditioning Coach Mike Reiskind, and Performance Analyst Samantha Unger.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014. The franchise won its first league title as the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2024, defeating the Knapolls Cannon Ballers two games to one to win the title at Virginia Credit Union Stadium.

SALES AGREEMENT: R.J. Sales (Pronounced "Sails") joins the FredNats after being acquired by Washington in a trade with the Detroit Tigers at the MLB trade deadline. Sales was part of the return from Detroit for longtime Washington closer Kyle Finnegan. He was originally drafted in the 10th round ('24) by the Tigers out of UNC Wilmington.

SALESFORCE: Sales made his first scoreless start as a member of the FredNats last week in Lynchburg, stymieing the Hillcats across five innings. The righty allowed five hits and struck out three to no walks.

SALES PITCH: Before becoming a part of the Washington organization, Sales was dominant in the Detroit system with Single-A Lakeland. In his professional debut season, Sales started this year by throwing 66.1 innings with the Flying Tigers, posting a 2.71 ERA across 15 total starts. The righty struck out 63 hitters in the Florida State League and walked just 17. Among all pitchers in the FSL with 65 or more innings pitched, Sales had the 5th-best ERA and the 4th-best WHIP (1.12).

(IN THE) YARD SALES: In his 66.1 innings to begin the year with Lakeland, Sales allowed just two home runs. He's surrendered two already in five starts with Fredericksburg, though.

GROSS SALES: Sales' fastball topped out at 97.2 mph during his time with Lakeland and owns one of the better breaking balls that the FredNats' pitching staff has seen this year. The 22-year-old's curveball had just a .152 batting average against with Lakeland. He allowed seven hits on the pitch in 15 starts and got 26 strikeouts with it.

BILLY MCMILLON - MANAGER

#51

1st Season | Previously: Development Coach, Triple-A Rochester

McMillon, 53, joined Washington in 2022 and has spent the last three seasons as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. McMillon played parts of six Major League seasons with four different organizations, including the Oakland Athletics (2001-04), Detroit Tigers (2000-01), Philadelphia Phillies (1997), and Florida Marlins (1996-97). The former Clemson Tiger was a three-time International League All-Star and the 1996 IL Rookie of the Year with Charlotte, earning him induction into the IL Hall of Fame in 2019 and Charlotte's Round Table of Honor in 2022. McMillon was initially selected in the eighth round of the 1993 MLB Draft by Florida. He replaces Jake Lowery, who managed the FredNats the last three seasons, culminating in a championship last year. Lowery will manage High-A Wilmington in 2025.

Prior to joining Washington, McMillon coached in the Boston Red Sox organization for over a decade. He managed the Worcester Red Sox (Triple-A) in their inaugural season in 2021 after managing Boston's former Triple-A affiliate Pawtucket in 2019. He was set to lead the PawSox again in 2020 before the cancellation of the MiLB season. Prior to managing at the Triple-A level, McMillon was the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for Boston from 2016-18 after managing for six seasons in the organization with Double-A Portland (2014-15), High-A Salem (2012-13), and Single-A Greenville (2010-11). His coaching career began in 2008 when he was Greenville's Hitting Coach.



JUSTIN LORD - PITCHING COACH

3rd Season | Previously: Pitching Coach, Double-A Harrisburg

Lord, 45, returns to Fredericksburg for a third season in 2025 after leading the FredNats' championship pitching staff last season, including the 2024 Carolina League Pitcher of the Year Travis Sykora.

This is Lord's fifth total season coaching in the Washington organization after a six-year professional playing career and several seasons coaching in the Baltimore system. The Alabama native and Florida State alum was scheduled to be the Fredericksburg Pitching Coach in the canceled 2020 season, and was the Pitching Coach for one season in Double-A Harrisburg prior to joining the FredNats in 2023.



MIKE HABAS - HITTING COACH

2nd Season | Previously: Hitting Coach, ACL Brewers

Habas, 34, returns to Fredericksburg from the 2024 championship staff for his second season with Washington after leading the FredNat offense to a highly successful season, finishing in the top third of the league in virtually every meaningful offensive category.

Prior to joining the Nationals, he spent spending the previous four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization, most recently as the Hitting Coach for the ACL Brewers in 2022 and 2023. Prior to joining Milwaukee, he was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats. While coaching with Gary, he was also the Head Coach at Prairie State College, a Junior College in the Chicago area.



LUIS ORDAZ - DEVELOPMENT COACH

1st Season | Previously: Manager, FCL Nationals

Ordez, 49, joins the FredNat coaching staff in the Development Coach role after managing the Florida Complex League Nationals in 2024.

He played parts of seven seasons in the Major Leagues, appearing in 206 career games with the St. Louis Cardinals, Kansas City Royals and Tampa Bay Devil Rays. Ordez has coached in the Washington organization for over a decade, and was the Hitting Coach for the Potomac Nationals for four seasons from 2016-19. He replaces Carmelo Jaime, who will manage the FCL Nationals in 2025 after three seasons in Fredericksburg.
