Tonight's Game: The Sounds take on St. Paul in game two of a six-game series this evening at CHS Field. Left-hander Thomas Pannone makes his first start of the campaign, going against Jordann Balazovic. Nashville will try and repeat their performance after an 11-5 win yesterday.

Thomas Pannone: 29-year-old Thomas Pannone makes his first start and third appearance of the season tonight. The left-hander is 0-0 with a 0.00 ERA (4.2 IP/0 ER) after a couple of outings in relief on April 23 at Jacksonville (1.2 IP) and April 28 vs. Omaha (3.0 IP). This is his first season in the Brewers organization after signing as a free agent on December 18, 2022. He began last season with Worcester in the Red Sox organization, going 5-3 with a 4.57 ERA in 14 games (12 starts) before being released on June 27. He then played for the Kia Tigers of the Korea Baseball Organization, going 3-4 with a 2.72 ERA in 14 starts. He was selected by Cleveland in the ninth round of the 2013 First-Year Player Draft out of the Community College of Southern Nevada.

Jordan Balazovic: 24-year-old Jordan Balazovic starts for the Saints tonight. The right-hander is 0-0 with a 2.35 ERA (7.2 IP/2 ER) in five appearances (no starts) in 2023. Balazovic pitched 2.0 innings in relief on April 25 at Rochester (2 H, 1 R, 1 ER, HR, 0 BB, 4 K). MLB Pipeline ranks the Mississauga, Ontario native as the No. 21 prospect in the Twins system. Last season, Balazovic went 0-7 with a 7.39 ERA (70.2 IP/58 ER) in 22 games (21 starts) with St. Paul. In his seventh season with the Twins, he was taken in the fifth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Saint Martin High School.

Hiura is Hot: Keston Hiura has hit safely in nine straight games and is batting .516 (16-for-31) with five runs, five doubles, three homers and 13 RBI during the streak. It is currently the longest active Sounds hitting streak and second-longest on the season. He leads the Brewers minor league system with 10 homers, 26 RBI, .724 slugging percentage, 1.118 OPS, 29 hits, 14 extra-base hits and 63 total bases. Hiura ranks among league leaders in homers (T-2nd), SLG (4th), RBI (T-4th), OPS (5th), extra-base hits (T-6th) and total bases (6th).

Best in Triple-A: The Sounds pitching staff holds the lowest ERA in Triple-A at 3.60, edging out Round Rock's mark of 3.65 and Memphis' of 3.72. Nashville also leads the circuit in shutouts (4), WHIP (1.31) and opponent batting average (.231). While Sounds starters have the eighth-best ERA in Triple-A and the fifth-best in the IL, the bullpen boasts the only sub-3.00 ERA at 2.82 (137.0 IP/43 ER).

He Gets On Base: Abraham Toro surpassed the 20-game on-base streak mark by reaching via walk multiple times yesterday. He and teammate Jon Singleton trail only Colton Cowser of Norfolk for the longest on-base streak in the league. Toro is batting .291 (23-for-79) with 11 RBI and 10 walks during the 21-game streak with began on April 4.

More Than Just Singles: Jon Singleton extended his on-base streak to 21 games with a run scoring double. Like his teammate Abraham Toro, Singleton holds the second-longest on-base streak in the IL. The infielder is batting .246 (17-for-69) with seven runs, 11 RBI and 21 walks since the streak began in game two of a doubleheader on April 6.

Brewers Getting Better: Milwaukee reliever Gus Varland made his first appearance on rehab assignment with Nashville, pitching a scoreless eighth inning. Including a couple of rehab appearances with High-A Wisconsin, Varland has pitched 3.0 innings, allowing four hits and three runs on a total of 63 pitches (39 strikes).

Welcome to Hit City: Reliever Ryan Middendorf and infielder Isaac Collins became the first two Shuckers to get the move up to Nashville with yesterday's transactions. Middendorf pitched the seventh in his Triple-A debut yesterday while Collins returns to his home state of Minnesota in the series at St. Paul.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville opens the 2023 season with five players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 9 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 13 prospect, and right-handed pitcher Janson Junk is the No. 15 prospect.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022, 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 615-530 record during an eight-season span.

LAST OUTING: Pannone's previous appearance came on April 28 vs. Omaha coming out of the bullpen to start the sixth inning. He struck out four over 3.0 scoreless innings, allowing one hit and walking one. Pannone's scoreless frames helped keep the Sounds in the game in a 4-3 walkoff win.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Pannone's first career appearance against St. Paul.

- Went 5-3 with a 4.57 ERA in 14 games (12 starts) with Triple-A Worcester...walked just 3.1% of hitters faced, the 2nd lowest in International League (min. 60 IP).
- After being released by Boston on June 27, made 14 starts for the Kia Tigers of the Korea Baseball Organization...went 3-4 with a 2.72 ERA and 73 strikeouts over 82.2 innings.

- Named International League Pitcher of the Week for June 30, 2019 after going 2-0 with a 1.63 ERA (11.0 IP/2 ER) and 14 strikeouts.
- Carried a no-hitter into the seventh inning of his first Major League start on August 22, 2018 vs. Baltimore...only hit was Trey Mancini's single to start seventh.
- In 2017, went 9-3 with a 2.36 ERA in 25 starts with Double-A Akron, Double-A New Hampshire and Advanced-A Lynchburg.
- Named an Eastern League Mid-Season All-Star in 2017...led the Eastern League in BAA (.227) and WHIP (1.09)...ranked among Eastern League leaders in ERA (2nd, 2.92), winning percentage (3rd, .700) and strikeouts (10th, 110).
- Did not allow an earned run (1 R) through first six starts of 2017 between Lynchburg (5 GS) and Akron (1 GS)...streak of 33.1 innings without an earned run was the second longest in the full season minor leagues by a starting pitcher.
- Traded to Toronto on July 31 alongside 2B Samad Taylor in exchange for RHP Joe Smith
- Named a Midwest League Mid-Season All-Star in 2016.
- Drafted by Cleveland in the ninth round of the 2013 First-Year Player Draft.

- Graduated from Bishop Hendricken High School (RI).
- Initially drafted by Chicago-NL in the 33rd round of the 2012 First-Year Player Draft, but did not sign.
