#### FRES-NOTES

EXTRA-BASE EXTRAVAGANZA WiN: The Fresno Grizzlies (16-20, 54-47) overpowered the Lake Elsinore Storm (19-17, 51-49) 6-3 Sunday evening from Chukchansi Park. The Grizzlies took five out of the six games in the set and won the regular season-series over the Storm 7-5. The Grizzlies improved to 10-2 in their last 12 games at home against the Storm dating boack to last season (both 5-1 series). For the first time in the series, the Storm grabbeed the initial advantage, scoring it the first three runs of the game. The Grizzlies did not bow out of the contest, plating six unanswered runs over four innings (4-7), in the bottom of the fourth, Luis Mendez ripped a triple to right, nothing Braglen Winnere. Then, Jason Hinchman cut the deficit to one after tatlosing a double to left, Jedeling Andy Perez (triple). Hobson would go on to swipe third and waltz home with the go-chead run on a throwing error. Fresno mustered additional runs in the sixth and seventh innings, placing the contest out of reach. Juan Castillo sizzled a single up the middle, knocking in Hinchman. Robert Calaz relished a triple to center, driving in Perez Overall, the Grizzlies offense supplied a team-high eight extra-base hits (five doubles and three triples) among their II hits overall. Perez, Calaz and Castillo all secured multi-hit games with the latter two picking up their first since joining the squad. The Grizzlies also ran wild on the basepaths, stealing five bags successfully. Grizzlies' starter Bryan Mena did not factor in his second start with the club. Ismael Luciano (1-0) was awarded the trumph in his second relief outing with Fresno. Luciano did not permit a hit or run over two frames of work. He walked one batter and struck out five. The Grizzlies bullpen combined for six shutout innings, giving up two hits and five walks while punching out six. Former Grizzlies' rightly Joe Musgrove made his return to Chukchansi Park on MLB Rehaba assignment for the Padres. Musgrove went three and one-third frames for the Storm, allowing a pair of runs

TIME TO SHAKE THE QUAKES: The Fresno Grizzlies and Rancho Cucamonga Quakes (Los Angeles Dodgers Single-A affiliate) start a six-game series tonight at LoanMart Field. This is the second of two 2024 regular season series between the clubs and the only meeting in Rancho Cucamonga. The Quakes started playing in Rancho Cucamonga in 1993 after relocating from San Bernardino. The team moved into the "Epicenter" on April 1, 1993. The Quakes played their first game at the stadium on April 8th against the High Desert Maverticks, winning 7-3. The Quakes continued to play their home games at the stadium, now renamed LoanMart Field. After being an affiliate of the San Diego Padres for the first eight years in Rancho Cucamonga, the team swapped affiliations with the Lake Elsinore Storm, beginning in the 2001 season. For the next 10 seasons, the Quakes were affiliated with the Los Angeles Angeles. After that season, the Quakes once again changed affiliations, joining the Dodgers' system. They have been associated with the Dodgers since 2011, where many Dodgers stars go for rehab assignments. Speaking of rehabbers, Dodgers shortstop Miguel Rojas will make a rehab assignment tonight. Rojas has been on the shelf with right forearm

COUPET WINS CALIFORNIA LEAGUE PITCHER OF THE WEEK: Grizzlies' LHP Isaiah Coupet was selected by Minor League Baseball as the California League Pitcher of the Week for July 29 - August 4. Coupet's sensational outing on Saturday, August 3 versus Lake Elsinore guided Fresno to a huge series win against the Storm. Coupet picked up his sixth win of the season after an unbelievable performance. The lefty twirled five hitless and scoreless innings, striking out eight. The Ohio State product retired the final 14 batters he faced and 15 of 16 hitters overall (one out walk in the first). Coupet mimicked a similar line in relief on June 15 versus Rancho Cucamonga, also facing one over the minimum. The 21-year-old enjoyed his second Colifornia League award this season (June 10-16), giving the Grizzlies their eighth weekly and monthly honors in 2024 (Welinton Herrera, Jace Kaminska, Braylen Winmer and Jack Mohoney, three times). Fresno won 10 California League honors (Weekly and Monthly) in 2023 and 14 California League honors (Weekly and Monthly) in 2022, a franchise record.

PACHECO PITCHES: Tonight, the Grizzlies give the rock to LHP Albert Pacheco. Last year, Pacheco was assigned to Fresno from the ACL Rockies on June 7 and spent his entire season with the Grizzlies. Pacheco made 14 starts, going 7-4 with a 5.45 ERA. Over 72.2 innings, he struck out 69 batters. The 21-year-old signed as an international free agent by the Rockies in 2019.

CALAZ JOINS THE GRIZZLIES: Rockies #11 overall prospect Robert Calaz has been assigned to the Grizzlies as of August 2. The Dominican outfielder has dominated in his two years since signing as an International Free Agent on January 15, 2023 for \$17, million (17) years old at the time). Calaz, who is now 18, is coming off on MVP season down with the ACL Rockies, where he led the league in Triple Crown categories (HR, AVG, RBI), Before joining Fresno, Calaz led the ACL in seven different statistical categories over 49 games, batting average (349), homers (10), RBI (45), OBP (462), slugging percentage (651), OPS (1.13) and total bases (112), Calaz has been compared to former Grizzlies' OP Yanquiel Fernandez. Welcome Robert Calazz

HERE COME THE 2024 DRAFT PICKS: The Grizzlies have added three 2024 Rockies' Draft Picks to their roster. 2nd-rounder Jared Thomas (Texas), 7th-rounder Fidel Ulloa (LSU) and 13th-rounder Justin Loer (LSU).

ANDY IS DANDY: Grizzlies' INF Andy Perez ranks among the Top 10 in eight different California League categories. Perez ranks first in hits (114), first in total bases (177), first in extra-base hits (38), tied for first in triples (7), third in RBI (61), fourth in doubles (22), tied for fifth in batting average (288) and tied for ninth (Brayler Wimmer) in slugging percentage (447).

ANDY PEREZ CLIMBS THE GRIZZLIES CAREER RECORD BOOKS: Grizzlies' INF Andy Perez logged his 14th career triple August 4 vs. Lake Elsinore. He is now tied with Jason Ellison and Clay Timpner for seventh all-time in Grizzlies Career Triples. Up next for Perez is Jalal Leach, who is sixth all-time with 15 triples.

MORE RECORDS FOR ANDY PEREZ: Andy Perez's triple on August 4 vs. Lake Elsinore was his seventh triple of 2024, putting him into the Grizzlies Top 10 Single-Season Record Books AGAIN. Perez tied himself (2023), Preston Tucker (2017), Nate Schierholtz (2007), Jason Ellison (2004) and Calvin Murray (1999), who each recorded seven triples in their respective seasons. The Cuban native became the second Grizzlies player (Nate Schierholtz, 2007-88) to join the Grizzlies Top 10 Single-Season Triples list twice. Up next for Perez are Ben Copeland (2010) and Andrew Stevenson (2019), who are tied for eighth all-time with eight triples.

NEW MAN AT THE TOP OF THE LINEUP: Grizzlies' OF Caleb Hobson has relished his role as the team's leadoff hitter. When Hobson has been plugged into the leadoff spot, he has reached base 68 times in 179 plate appearances (38 games; 38% he is reaching base in the leadoff spot). In 11 of those 38 games, Hobson has made it on base three or more times, combining to score 33 runs. Part of Hobson's success is in his first plate appearance of the game, where he is 9-for-30 (300) with a double, seven walks and one hit-by-pitch (17-for-38, 45% of the time he reaches base in first plate appearance). Eight of his nine hits have been singles with three of them landing as but singles. Hobson has also swiped 18 total bags as a leadoff hitter, picking up two stolen bases in five of those leadoff games (31/35 in stolen bases on the season).

RUNNING CLOSER TO THE RECORD BOOKS: Grizzlies' OF Caleb Hobson has swiped 31 bases this season. Hobson is currently four stolen bases shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Single-Season Records in that category. Tyler Graham (2010), Darren Ford (2014), Jonathan Villar (2015) and Myles Straw (2018) are tied for ninth all-time with 35 stolen bases.
