LAST OUTING: Ashby tied a season-high with seven earned runs allowed in a loss at Norfolk on July 21. He went 3.1 innings and walked five batters.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Ashby has faced Charlotte four times in his career. Three took place in June of 2021 where he had a start on June 4 and relief outings on June 23 and 26. He got the loss on June 4 despite ony allowing one run which wasn't earned with 11 strikeouts in 7.0 innings. He allowed four earned runs in an inning on June 23 and pitched a scoreless 1.2 innings on June 26. In his most recent outing on May 25, he allowed two earned runs in a 5.1-inning no-decision.
