Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send LHP **Ryan Webb** to the mound tonight, looking to avoid the team's first 3G losing streak since a 4G slump from 8/29-9/2/25. Worcester will counter with LHP **Jake Bennett**. Columbus is 1-2 (.333) versus left handers this year. Bennett has never pitched against the Clippers in his career, as tonight will be just his third start in Triple-A (37th career game).

vs. the Red Sox

Against the WooSox, Columbus is 12-8 all-time and, dating to August of 2014, Columbus has pounded Boston's Triple-A affiliate 37-21. This week marks the fourth trip to Massachusetts in as many seasons, as the Red Sox have still not been to Columbus since moving from Pawtucket. **Kody Huff** has gone 10x29 (.345) with 9RBI against Worcester in his career (8G).

Interesting Strategy

Columbus enters tonight's contest as the only undefeated team in the IL when surrendering a homer (6-0), while being one of six teams with a losing record when keeping opponents in the yard (1-5). The Clippers lead the IL in wins when trailing (7) and allowing the first run of the game (6), ranking 2nd when allowing 4+ runs (4). When scoring first, the Clippers are one of four teams with a losing mark (1-2).

That's Rare

Last night's shutout was just the 20th scoreless game suffered by Columbus since the start of the 2022 season (tied with Buffalo for fewest in the IL). On the flip side, the Clippers have blanked their opponents 34 times (4th most; best winning percentage, .630). On average, the first shutout came in the ninth game of the season from 2022-25 (12th game this year; second shutout comes in game #32).

Walk Before You Run

This week's matchup features the top two in the IL in walks, with Worcester (84) outpacing Columbus by a pair (no other IL team has more than 67BB; Columbus +7 this week). Both offenses rank among the top four in the IL in scoring with the Sox plating the most (81) and Clippers checking in at 4th (69). Worcester (.415) and Columbus (.387) are also 1-2 in OBP (4th and 7th, respectively in SLG).

George Town

George Valera was the King of Worcester on Tuesday night, tying a career high with 6RBI (6/25/19 with Mahoning Valley) on four singles and a couple sac flies (11 of 22SF in career have come with Columbus). He has an even 200 hits during his 238G in a Columbus uniform (missed 148G while on the DL from 2023-2025), including 40HR (became 30th Clipper to reach 40 in career on 4/3 vs. Indy).

Tiny Slumps

Stuart Fairchild is only 4x18 (.222) in 5G since going 4x4 on 4/3 vs. Indianapolis, while **Travis Bazzana** is 2x18 (.111) in his last 4G since back to back multi-his outings on 4/2 and 4/3 vs. Indianapolis. **Milan Tolentino** is just 3x18 (.167) in his last 5G since doubling twice on 4/2 vs. Indy. Tolentino is 2x5 vs. LHP this season, but has yet to homer off a lefty in the IL (85AB; 22HR in 345AB vs. RHP).

It's Over

Kahliil Watson failed to reach base last night for the first time since mid August (career best 33G on base streak from 8/19/25-4/8/26, .407OBP), while also snapping a 7G streak with at least one walk (12BB on the year, tied for 3rd most in the IL). As a result, Watson still carries a .352OBP despite hitting just .167 (7x42; hitless in last 16AB). Unfortunately, Watson's 17K are tied for 6th most (31.5% of PA).

Delayed Start

Kody Huff was 1x8 with 5K in March (2G), but has rebounded to hit in each of 7G during April (.360, 9x25), drawing 8BB to 4K. He has 9RBI this month, including an RBI streak of 4G from 4/3-4/8 (8RBI total, multi-RBI in 3G). Huff has gone 5x12 (.417) with runners in scoring position, following a 2025 in which he batted .299 (hit .193 in all other situations). Tonight will mark his 10th career start at 1B.

Boom and Bust

The Clipper bullpen imploded in multi-run innings Wednesday, accumulating 5ER (fifth game with at least 5ER in the last 7G, gave up 1ER in rain-shortened game on Saturday, 1ER last night). In the first 5G of the season, the bullpen had 0ER in 3G, while giving up 4ER in 2G (relievers have not had a 2ER or 3ER game all season). Clipper relievers have accumulated a 6.29ERA this year (19th in the IL).

This Date in Clipper History

4/10/2011

The Clippers completed a season opening, four game sweep of Indianapolis by taking the final game 7-5 at Victory Field. **Cord Phelps** homered twice (4RBI) and **Zach McAllister** got the first of his 12 wins in 2011. Of the 12 players to appear in the game, only **Chad Huffman**, **Luke Carlin** and **Joe Martinez** would travel with the Clippers to Albuquerque to win a second straight Triple-A National Championship.

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,409 to 1,355).

Challenging Times

The Clippers were 132-174 (.431, 2nd worst in the IL) in pitch reviews last season, with batters going 79-117 (.403) and pitchers/catchers going 53-57 (.482). They ran out of challenges in 57G and did not challenge in 13G.

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus was 5-5 in extra innings last season, following a 9-loss campaign in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 50-33 when playing past regulation (.602, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-16 at home (.619, but 4-6 in last 10G). Of the 83G to require extra play, 66 have needed only one frame (including seven DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

Didn't Add Up

The first half of the 2025 season saw the Clippers finish 12th with a 34-38 record (.472), despite ranking 10th in run differential (+3), 10th in pitching (4.61ERA) and 2nd in defense (.984; ranked 13th in batting, .250). Such a result was the product of a league-high 27 losses by three runs or fewer (22-27, .449, 13th), as they played in the fewest games decided by at least four runs (12-11, .522, 9th). In the second half, they went 19-21 in close games, while going 11-22 in blowouts.

Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 76 grand slams and 1,872RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

Not So Fast

On the basepaths, the 2024 Clippers established a franchise record of 200SB, (80% success rate) with four players topping 20 for the first time in club history. As a team, they were successful on 30 consecutive attempts (6/16-6/30/24) and 36 straight tries (7/23-8/7/24, including 8SB on 7/31/24 vs. Syracuse). Last season was a different story entirely, as they finished with the worst stolen base percentage in the IL (72%, 127SB and 49CS).

Three True Outcomes

While not breaking records last season, the Clipper pitching staff topped 660BB for the third time ever (all in last three years, franchise record of 767BB in 2023) and cleared 1,300K for the fourth time (all in the last four years, franchise record of 1,392K in 2024). The homer rate was down considerably last year, but the three true outcome rate still ended around 39% (the 2024 season saw franchise high of 40.5%; last six seasons have all been at least 37.0%, no seasons above 33.4% prior).

Return of the Defense

The Clippers were 1st in the IL in defense (.985), a season after turning in their worst fielding percentage (.978) since 2009. They had only two series with more than 5E (8/26-8/31 at Louisville, 9/17-9/21 vs. Omaha), topping out at 3E in a game twice and playing flawlessly 86 times on the year (44-42, .512; 16G errorless streak from 6/20-7/8, longest in the IL over the last 20 years). Behind the plate, Clipper catchers did not have a passed ball from 9/22/24-5/28/25 (53G; 3,949 pitches with men on base between).

Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

Good Baseball

Milan Tolentino moved a pair of runners into scoring position with a bunt single on 4/7 at Worcester and those runners came around to tie the game in an eventual win. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 84-22 (.792) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 1-1 (.500, blew 7-run lead in loss) mark this season (went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses this season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (t-17th, .439).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 393-411 (.489), 363-365 with Columbus (.499).
