SPRINGDALE, AR – The Northwest Arkansas Naturals went back-and-forth with the Corpus Christi Hooks Tuesday night, but came up a run short as the Hooks took the series opener, 8-7.

- After Corpus Christi jumped out 2-0 in the top of the first inning, the Naturals cut the deficit in half in the bottom of the frame, as **Logan Porter** drew a bases-loaded walk to score **Nick Loftin**.
- In the third inning after the Hooks scored two more, Loftin doubled to begin the inning, then scored on a **Seuly Matias** sacrifice fly. **Robbie Glendinning** and Porter both walked, then came around on a two-run double from **Jake Means** to tie the game, his second in as many trips to the plate.
- Northwest Arkansas jumped ahead in the fourth, as the inning opened with three straight hits, from **Maikel Garcia**, Loftin and **Michael Massey**. Garcia scored on Massey's single, then Loftin crossed on a sac fly from Glendinning to push the advantage to two runs.
- Loftin and Massey each collected three hits in the game, with Loftin scoring all three times while Massey added his Double-A best 45th RBI in the fourth inning.
- Alec Marsh** made the longest start of his career, striking out nine across a career-best 6.1 innings, while throwing 96 pitches. He excited with the score tied at 6-6 and reliever **Yefri Del Rosario** allowed his first three batters to reach base, the third being a three-run triple that put the Hooks ahead for good.
- Del Rosario struck out his next two and **Jonah Dipoto** struck out four across 2.0 scoreless innings to follow him but the Naturals could only add one additional run, as Matias led off the bottom of the seventh with a solo home run, his eighth homer of the year.

THIS DAY IN NATURALS HISTORY

The Naturals are 4-7 all-time when playing on June 1

On June 1, 2009, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals beat the Frisco RoughRiders, 11-2 at Arvest Ballpark, as the top six hitters in the Naturals lineup all recorded at least two hits. Leadoff hitter and **Ed Lucas** went 4-for-5, while third baseman **Corey Smith** went 3-for-5 with a home run and six runs batted in, as he connected on a three-run homer in the eighth inning. Second baseman **Kurt Mertins** went 2-for-4 with two doubles, also scoring four runs as he walked twice. Starting pitcher **Blake Johnson** earned his third win of the year, as he allowed just one run across 7.0 innings, while striking out three.

FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in *Advanced Rookie* Burlington (2019) and *High-A* Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 17 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- Nine of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: **Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Michael Massey, Jake Means, Drew Parrish, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter** and **Ángel Zerpá**.

WHAT YOU KNOW ABOUT PITCHING DEEP?

In the month of May, Naturals starting pitchers have thrown 112.2 innings of the staff's 219.1 total (51.4%), up from 44.3% of the team's April innings.

- As a staff, the Naturals 4.43 ERA in the month of May ranked 3rd in the Texas League, with 13 of 25 starts lasting 5.0 innings or longer and 20 of 25 going 4.0 innings or more.
- In 24 May games, Naturals starting pitchers have a 4.23 ERA (53 ER in 112.2 IP) with 136 strikeouts (10.86 K/9) and a .225 opponents' average.
- Two-time Texas League Pitcher of the Week Drew Parrish has thrown 6.0 innings or more in each of his last EIGHT outings, including four scoreless: 6.0 IP on 4/26 vs. AMA & 5/26 @ MID and 7.0 on 5/7 @ SPR & 5/13 vs. WCH.

EXTREME ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM

When looking at the Naturals' numbers one game to the next, it appears rather black and white with what leads to a win or loss.

- When scoring six runs or more, the Naturals are 20-4, while when scoring five runs or less, just 2-19.
- The Naturals are 17-5 when recording 10 hits or more, but when they get nine hits or less, are just 5-18.
- The Naturals are 21-8 when out-hitting their opponent or hits are tied, but 1-15 when out-hit by their opponent.
- When the Naturals score first, they are 16-7, whereas 6-16 when the opponent scores first.

ONE RUN GOES A LONG WAY

The Naturals are 2-11 in one-run games this season, meaning 11 of their 23 losses this season have been decided by just one run.

- Six of the Naturals' last Eight losses have been by just a run, as well as seven of 12 losses in the month of May.
- The Naturals have had the winning run at the plate in five losses this season (all one-run losses) and had the tying run at the plate or on base in 12 losses this season (including nine of their one-run losses).

TUCKER BRADLEY: PROFESSIONAL HITTER

Tucker Bradley has acted as a second leadoff hitter for much of 2022 for Northwest Arkansas, batting 9th in the order in all 32 games he's started, but that is a spot he has thrived in.

- Bradley ranks among the top hitters in the Royals organization, with the third-highest batting average (.317) among qualified hitters in the system, also ranking third in slugging (.542) and OPS (.925), while fourth in on-base percentage (.383). He also ranks tied second in triples (3), seventh in hits (38) and total bases (54) and tied seventh in extra-base hits (14).
- Two of Tucker's five home runs this year have been grand slams, the first two of his pro career. e extended the Naturals' lead in the fifth inning on April 23 in Frisco with his first grand slam, then broke a scoreless tie to give the Naturals the lead in the fifth inning on May 13 vs. Wichita.

Yo, You WANNA SEE SOME REAL SPEED?

Through 45 games, the Naturals have stolen 63 bases in 75 attempts (average 1.40 steals/game, 84.00% success rate) and pulled off a double steal 10 times.

- 63 steals ranks third in the Texas League, sixth in Double-A and tied 30th in the Minors.
- Maikel Garcia's** 16 steals (in 18 attempts) ranks third in the Texas League and tied seventh in all of Double-A, while **Nate Eaton's** 12 steals (in 13 attempts) ranks tied eighth in the Texas League.

It's GONNA BE MASSEY

Since the calendar flipped to May, second baseman **Michael Massey** has been one of the top hitters in the Texas League, batting at a .381 (37-for-97) average with a 1.016 OPS across 24 games, while recording a league-best 37 hits and ranking second with 29 runs batted in.

- On Sunday, Massey snapped a season-high seven-game hitting streak, with two or more hits in the first five games against Midland, but was named the league's Player of the Week for the second time this year.
- Michael has reached base in 36 of 43 games he's played this year, with already 17 multi-hit games, including 12 in May.
- The second baseman leads not just the Texas League, but all of Double-A with 45 runs batted in, raking 6th in MiLB as well, seven back of Omaha's Vinnie Pasquantino (51), the Minor League leader ... he also ranks second in the Texas League in hits (60), eighth in batting average (.337) and total bases (98) and tied 10th in doubles (14) and extra-base hits (22).
- He is scattered all across the Royals' organizational leaders, ranking first in batting average and hits, tied first in doubles, second in runs batted in, extra-base hits, total bases, slugging percentage (.546) and OPS (.937), tied third in home runs, fourth in on-base percentage (.376) and tied fourth in runs scored (30).
- Massey's turnaround at the plate truly began April 22, when he entered the day hitting just .213 and proceeded to homer in three consecutive games, April 22 to 24 in Frisco ... he went from having no home runs through the first 11 games of the season, to having eight in his last 30e, leading the Naturals in homers.

GAR-SEE YA ON BASE

Shortstop **Maikel Garcia** has reached base in 39 of the 43 games he has played in this season, reaching base twice on 28 occasions, 14 multi-hit games.

- In 205 plate appearances, the Venezuelan has reached base 82 times (53 hits + 29 walks), for a .402 on-base percentage.
- Garcia has walked 29 times and struck out 36 times, a 1.24 K/BB rate.
- The shortstop places among the Texas League leaders in several categories, ranking third in steals (16), tied sixth in hits (53), tied seventh in walks (29) and runs scored (36) ... he ranks among the Double-A leader in steals (tied seventh) and runs scored (tied ninth).
- His 14-game hitting streak between April 27 and May 12 is the longest on the Naturals this year and tied for the 15th-longest in club history ... it is also tied for the second-longest in the Texas League this season ... in those 14 games, he hit .397 (23-for-58) with six doubles and a .970 OPS.

PUSHIN (P)ORTER

Catcher **Logan Porter** has quietly flown under the radar as one of the top hitters in the Royals system so far in 2022.

- Among qualified Royals minor league hitters, Porter has the highest on-base percentage (.447), and ranks second in batting average (.318), third in OPS (.924) and fourth in slugging percentage (.477).
- Porter has reached base in 27 of 30 games he's played this season, with hits in 21 of 30 and 12 multi-hit games, including nine in May.
- In the month of May, Porter hit .343 (24-for-70) with a team-best 1.017 OPS and he had drove in 13 runs with 11 walks.

Players of the Week (2)

- April 25 to May 1: 2B Michael Massey ... hit .417 (10-for-28) across six games with a league-best 19 total bases and nine runs batted in, while tied for the Texas League lead with 10 hits. His 1.221 OPS ranked third among players with at least 20 at-bats, while his .417 average tied for second among that same group.
- May 23 to May 29: 2B Michael Massey ... hit a league-best .481 (13-for-27) across six games in Midland, while tied for the league lead with 19 total bases. He drove in nine runs as well, doubling three times with one home run, a go-ahead grand slam on May 24 and collected multiple hits in each of the first five games of the series.

Pitchers of the Week (2)

- May 2 to May 8: LHP Drew Parrish ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 7 @ Springfield ... held the Cardinals to just two hits and one walk while striking out four. He retired the first eight he faced and the final five, with five 1-2-3 frames.
- May 9 to May 15: LHP Drew Parrish ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 13 vs. Wichita ... held the Wind Surge to just three hits and no walks while striking out nine. Between the second and sixth innings, he retired 13 straight batters, retiring the side 1-2-3 in the first inning, as well as the third through sixth.

**#36 CHRIS WIDGER • MANAGER**

- Chris Widger will manage the Naturals after guiding the River Bandits to a High-A Central championship in their first season as a Kansas City affiliate in 2021. In doing so, he was named the Minor League Manager of the Year by *Baseball America* following the 2021 season.

- Abraham Núñez enters his fourth season as Northwest Arkansas' hitting coach after serving in the same capacity with High-A Wilmington (2015-2018), Class-A Lexington (2014), Rookie Advanced Burlington (2013) and the Dominican Royals (2012).

**#27 CHRISTIAN COLÓN • ASSISTANT HITTING COACH**

- Christian Colón returns to the organization as the Naturals Assistant Hitting Coach in 2022, following a 12-year professional career.
- He was the Royals first-round pick in the 2010 MLB Draft, scored the winning run in the 2014 AL Wild Card game and had the game-winning hit in the title-clinching Game 5 of the 2015 World Series.
- After being drafted in 2010, Colón ascended to Northwest Arkansas by 2011 and between 2011, 2012 and 2014, played 202 games for the Naturals ... In 2011, Colón led the Texas League in sacrifices (21), while leading the team in at-bats (491) and hits (126). His 21 sacrifices that season are the most a Naturals player has ever recorded in a single season, while 28 overall are tied for the club record.
- During his playing career, he made stops in Miami (2017) and Cincinnati (2019-20) ... spent 2021 with the Rich Baseball-owned Buffalo Bisons (Triple-A, Toronto) before announcing his retirement.
- He also played in parts of four seasons in the Puerto Rican Winter League.
- Christian lives in Cave Springs, Ark. (15 minutes North of Arvest Ballpark) with his wife, Kayla, and three daughters, Marley, Mia and Lucy.

**#23 MIKE JIRSCHLE • BENCH COACH**

- Mike Jirschle enters his first season as the Bench Coach for Northwest Arkansas after spending last season in the same role for Manager Chris Widger in Quad Cities.
- He served as a Special Assistant to the General Manager in 2020 and was on the Royals coaching staff as the Third Base Coach from 2014-19 and won the World Series in 2015.

- Jirschle was originally selected by the Texas Rangers in the fifth round of the 1977 MLB Draft and played in 999 minor league games over 13-plus seasons in the Rangers and Royals systems.

- Danny Accola is entering his seventh season with the Royals organization and first as the certified athletic trainer with the Naturals, after serving in the same role with the Quad Cities in 2021.
