THIS DATE IN HISTORY

Russell Branyan hit three home runs in the Sounds' 10-8 win over New Orleans on May 16, 2008. All three of Branyan's homers were 2-run blasts. He hit one in the 2nd inning, another in the 3rd, and the last in the 8th. He finished the night 4-for-5 with 6 RBI and 3 runs scored.

Today's Game: The Nashville Sounds host the Memphis Redbirds today in the finale of a six-game series. Weston Wilson delivered the knockout punch with a walk-off base hit in the bottom of the 10th inning to give the Nashville Sounds a thrilling 4-3 win over the Memphis Redbirds in front of a sellout crowd of 10,861 fans at First Horizon Park Saturday night. Right-hander Thomas Jankins makes his third start for the Sounds against right-hander Miles Mikolas for the Redbirds.

Thomas Jankins: 25-year-old Thomas Jankins makes his third start for the Sounds today. He set career-highs in his last start in hits (12) and runs (11) against Memphis on May 11. In 2019, Jankins went 11-5 with a 4.19 ERA in 25 games (23 starts) with Triple-A San Antonio and Double-A Biloxi. Jankins finished tied for fifth in the Pacific Coast League for wins (10), logged 10 quality starts and four starts of 6+ IP and one or less runs allowed. In his 2019 debut, he tossed the only complete game of his career on April 7 vs. Birmingham. The Massachusetts native was named a Southern League All-Star in 2018 after he went 10-9 with a 4.42 ERA with Double-A Biloxi. The Brewers drafted Jankins in the 13th round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft.

Miles Mikolas: 32-year-old Miles Mikolas gets the ball today for the Redbirds. He is making his third Major League rehab start after being placed on St. Louis' 10-day injured list on May 1. In his last start at Nashville on May 11, he pitched 4.0 innings and surrendered three runs on five hits. He missed the 2020 season after undergoing surgery to repair a flexor tendon in his right arm. He was selected to represent St. Louis in the 2018 All-Star game and finished 6th in the National League Cy Young Award voting. The Florida native was selected by the San Diego Padres in the 7th round of the 2009 First-Year Player Draft.

2021 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the Triple-A East Southeast Division standings in 2021: First: 0, Second: 0, Third: 1, Fourth: 9, Fifth: 2, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0.

Walk-Off Wilson: Weston Wilson gave the Sounds their first walk-off win of the 2021 season last night. It was Nashville's first walk-off win since July 13, 2019 vs. New Orleans (Patrick Wisdom).

Come Early, Come Often: With two consecutive sellouts and possible third today, the Sounds have taken the lead in average attendance in the minor leagues. At 6,659 fans per game through the first five games of the season at First Horizon Park, the Sounds have the highest per-game average in Minor League Baseball. Triple-A El Paso is second at 6,504 per game and Double-A Rocket City is third with 6,138 fans per game.

Punching K's: The Sounds pitching staff struck out a season-high 15 batters last night. It was the most strikeouts recorded by Nashville since June 15, 2018 (at El Paso).

NL MVP in Nashville: 2018 National League MVP winner Christian Yelich joined the Sounds on May 14 for an MLB rehab assignment. Milwaukee placed Yelich on the injured list on May 4 with a lower back strain. He is batting .353 (12-for-34) in 10 games with the Brewers.

Start the Streak: Dee Strange-Gordon has hit safely in a team-high seven straight games, batting .290 (9-for-31) with 6 runs, 1 home run and 2 RBI.

The Milwaukee Era: A new era of Nashville Sounds baseball began on February 12, 2021 when the club announced its affiliation with the Milwaukee Brewers. The affiliation with Milwaukee came after the Sounds signed a 10-year Professional Development License (PDL) with Major League Baseball as part of the 20-team Triple-A East League. Within the Triple-A East League, the Sounds are a member of the seven-team Southeast Division.

There's History Here: The Sounds enjoyed 10 years as the Brewers' top affiliate from 2005-14. The 2005 season culminated with the Sounds winning the Pacific Coast League Championship - the City of Nashville's most recent championship in any sport. Nashville compiled a 723-713 (.503) record during the 10-year stretch and made three consecutive postseason berths from 2005-07. In 2007, the Sounds won 89 games, the second-most in franchise history (97 in 1980).

Top Prospects: Nashville opened the 2021 season with four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 5 prospect, left-handed pitcher Aaron Ashby is the No. 7 prospect, outfielder Corey Ray is the No. 24 prospect and left-handed pitcher Clayton Andrews is the No. 25 prospect.

How Sweet It Is: Manager Rick Sweet is at the helm for the Sounds in 2021, as he was in 2014 when he led the club to a 77-67 record. Sweet has managed for all or parts of 30 seasons in the minor leagues and has compiled a managerial record of 2,035-1,925. The 2,035 wins are 11th-most all-time among all minor league managers. 10th on the list is Lefty O'Doul who won 2,094 games from 1935-57.

That Doesn't Hurt So Bad: The Sounds have five Major League rehabbers on the roster. Outfielder Christian Yelich (May 4 - lower back strain), infielder Daniel Robertson (April 26 - concussion), outfielder Derek Fisher (April 1 - strained left hamstring), infielder/outfielder Jace Peterson (April 23 - cryotherapy on left thumb) and infielder/outfielder Tim Lopes (March 8 - right oblique) are all on the current roster.
