SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels were swept in a doubleheader by the Rumble Ponies in Binghamton, 2-1 and 4-2. In Game 1, the Flying Squirrels took a 1-0 lead in the top of the first with a two-out RBI single by **Drew Ellis**. In the fourth, William Lugo tied the game with a double and Alex Ramirez added an RBI single to give Binghamton a 2-1 lead. In Game 2, Richmond took a 2-0 lead in the first. **Sabin Ceballos** hit an RBI double and later scored on a single by **Cal Mitchell**. In the second, Binghamton closed the score to 2-1 with a run-scoring groundout by Ramirez. In the bottom of the fourth, Ramirez tied the score with a single and Kevin Parada hit a go-ahead sacrifice fly. Ramirez drove in a run with a single in the sixth to push the Binghamton lead to 4-2.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the opener of a six-game series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. Richmond played two road series in Harrisburg this year and went 2-4 in both sets, first from April 8-13 and again from May 6-11. Along with this week's series, the Senators return to The Diamond for a three-game set from July 18-20 out of the All-Star Break.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,595) and total (435,295) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels were 10th in average attendance. It was the third straight year the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance, which had not been done prior to 2022. Last year's total attendance is the highest since 2013 (434,769) and the fourth-highest average in team history. April 4 marked the 15th consecutive Opening Night sellout, marking every home opener in franchise history to date. This year, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 7,022 fans per home game, which ranks third among all 120 MiLB clubs. Their average of 7,290 in the season's first month was the highest April attendance in franchise history.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS are 1-7 in their last eight games. They went 1-5 in last week's series in Binghamton, falling on three walk-off hits. Richmond lost four games last series and the other by two runs. Of Richmond's 32 losses this season, 17 of them have been by two runs or less (11 by one, six by two). The Richmond offense ranks tied for fifth in hits (314), tied for seventh in batting average (.223) and has the second-fewest strikeouts (366) in the Eastern League but are last in runs scored (139). The Richmond pitching staff is last in ERA (4.82). Richmond's 13-32 record is the second-worst in full-season MiLB, one game ahead of High-A South Bend (12-33).

THE SENATORS are 2-8 in their last 10 games, including going 1-5 in their home series against the Baysox last week. In the Eastern League, the Harrisburg offense ranks first in triples (20), second in hits (365), second in total bases (575), third in runs (205), third in RBIs (191) and fourth in homers (33). Harrisburg's roster features two players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Nationals prospects list, including RHP Jarlin Susana (No. 3 - on IL) and 3B Cayden Wallace (No. 9). MLB.com's top-30 Nationals prospects list features three Harrisburg players, including Susana (No. 2), Wallace (No. 10) and SS Kevin Made (No. 26).

STARTING STRONG: Richmond starting pitchers have posted a 2.19 ERA (7 ER/29.1 IP) over the last six games dating back to May 20. Last Tuesday, **Seth Lonsway** threw 5.1 scoreless innings and struck out six batters to open the series. In the finale on Sunday, he allowed four runs over 5.1 innings. Last Wednesday, **Joe Whitman** threw five scoreless innings and set a career high with 11 strikeouts prior to the game being suspended for rain in the top of the sixth inning. **John Michael Bertrand** scattered five hits and a walk over four scoreless innings in Friday night's 6-1 Flying Squirrels win. On Saturday, **Manuel Mercedes** set a season high with six strikeouts and allowed one run in five innings. **Jack Choate** allowed two runs over 4.2 innings on Sunday in the first game of Sunday's doubleheader.

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Joe Whitman** makes his ninth start of the season and his third against Harrisburg. In his last start on Wednesday at Binghamton, he set a career high with 11 strikeouts over five innings before play was suspended for rain, allowing two unearned runs in the first inning. In his last four starts since May 3, Whitman has gone 2-1 with a 2.05 ERA (5 ER/22.0 IP). He has made two starts against the Senators this year, both on the road, and has gone 0-1 with a 5.00 ERA (5 ER/9.0 IP). For the season, he is ranked ninth in the Eastern League in BAA (.205) and ninth in WHIP (1.16). On May 3, Whitman threw six perfect innings against the Patriots at The Diamond, retiring all 18 batters he faced, and set a career high with 10 strikeouts. He was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on May 5. In his first full professional season last year, Whitman split the year between Low-A San Jose and High-A Eugene, going 3-8 with a 4.63 ERA in 23 starts. He finished the year ranked ninth in the Giants organization in strikeouts (108) and tied for ninth in games started. Whitman was selected in the second round of the 2023 MLB Draft by the Giants out of Kent State, where he was the MAC Pitcher of the Year that season. Before transferring to Kent State near his hometown of Akron, Ohio, Whitman pitched at Purdue. Entering 2025, Whitman was ranked by Baseball America as the No. 10 Giants prospect and No. 7 by MLB.com. **For more on Whitman, see page two.**

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Bryce Conley makes his third start with the Nationals organization after singing on May 13. He made his Nationals organization debut on May 16 at Altoona and allowed five runs over 3.2 innings. In his last start last Wednesday, he tossed five scoreless innings against the Baysox. Conley began this year pitching with Charros de Jalisco of the Mexican League, where he was 1-0 with a 2.03 ERA in three starts. He was originally selected by the Athletics in the 22nd round of the 2017 MLB Draft out of Georgia State and reached as high as Triple-A before reaching free agency after the 2023 season. On July 22, 2019, Conley started and threw six innings in a combined no-hitter for the Stockton Ports against the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes.

DON'T RUN ON RICHMOND: The Flying Squirrels' catching unit of **Adrián Sugastey** and **Zach Morgan** have combined to throw out 25 stolen base attempts this season, which is second among all 30 Double-A teams and leads the Eastern League. Sugastey is tied for first in the Eastern League with 14 runners caught stealing. Morgan is tied for third in the EL with 11.

WAIT A MINUTE: Northern Virginia native **Bryce Eldridge** returned to the Richmond roster on April 22 after missing the start of the season with an injury. He hit a solo home run in his first plate appearance of the year. The 20-year-old first baseman played at four levels in the Giants organization in his first full professional season last year, including nine games with Richmond in September. For the year in 116 games, Eldridge hit .291 with 23 homers and 92 RBIs. He is ranked by Baseball America as the No. 21 prospect in baseball. Eldridge is also the fifth Virginia-born player to suit up for the Flying Squirrels in franchise history. After batting .111 (1-for-9) in his first three games of the season, Eldridge is batting .312 (29-for-93) in his last 25 games since April 27. On May 10, Eldridge drove a two-out, three-run homer against the Senators to give the Flying Squirrels the lead in the eighth for a comeback win. In two games on May 15 (G2)-16, he went 5-for-7 with three homers, two doubles and five RBIs. In his last 12 games since May 13, Eldridge is hitting .341 (15-for-44) with three homers, four doubles and seven RBIs.

HELLO, GAVELLO: Catcher/infielder/outfielder **Thomas Gavello** joined the Flying Squirrels from High-A Eugene on May 9. In his Double-A debut on May 10 at Harrisburg, he hit a double on the first pitch he saw in the game. He followed with two hits, including another double, in his second game the following day. Since joining Richmond, Gavello has picked at least one hit in eight-of-10 Double-A games he has played, including four doubles, and is batting .375. He has played one game at shortstop and nine games in left field, the first games of his professional career in the outfield.

CLOSE CALLS: Of the Flying Squirrels' last five loses four have been one-run losses including three last week in Binghamton's final at-bat. On the season, 17 of the Flying Squirrels' 32 losses have been by two runs or less, which is the most in the Eastern League. The Flying Squirrels have the most one-run losses (11) in the EL this year. They have lost six games by two runs. Their five losses in last week's series in Binghamton were by a combined six runs.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Diego Velasquez** is tied for fifth in hits (43). **Seth Lonsway** is second in innings pitched (46.2) and ninth in ERA (2.89). **Jack Choate** is sixth in strikeouts (48). **John Michael Bertrand** is ninth in innings pitched (43.0). **Joe Whitman** is ninth in BAA (.205) and ninth in WHIP (1.16).

TOP SKIPPER: Flying Squirrels manager **Dennis Pelfrey** has led the team to 217 wins in his career, which is a new franchise record all-time wins record for a manager. He passed the record with Richmond's 6-1 win at Binghamton on May 23. From 2011-2013, **Dave Machemer** won 216 games as Richmond's manager, leading the team to the Eastern League postseason for in 2011. Pelfrey, who has been with Richmond since the 2022 season, led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time in franchise history in 2022 and 2023. He also managed the 2021 Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship.

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster includes seven players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including **Bryce Eldridge** (No. 1), **Joe Whitman** (No. 10), **Diego Velasquez** (No. 13), **Sabin Ceballos** (No. 16), **Trent Harris** (No. 26), **Aeverson Arteaga** (No. 27) and **Jack Choate** (No. 28). There are also seven players ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Eldridge, (No. 1), Whitman (No. 7), Harris (No. 11), Velasquez (No. 15), Arteaga (No. 16), Ceballos (No. 23) and Choate (No. 27). Eldridge is also ranked No. 21 overall by Baseball America and No. 21 by MLB.com.

THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

1982: The Richmond Braves beat the Atlanta Braves, 7-6, in an exhibition at Parker Field. A crowd of 14,881 was announced, which was the second-largest in Parker Field's history at the time. Fans were roped off in left and right field. Terry Harper, who had been called up to Atlanta before the game and had to swap uniforms before first pitch, hit a two-run homer in the fourth to give the A-Braves the lead. Richmond scored five in the bottom of the inning, including an RBI single by Brook Jacoby and a two-run triple by Larry Owen. Atlanta's Bob Horner tied the game, 5-5, with a three-run homer in the fifth. Richmond moved back ahead with a run scoring on a wild pitch in the sixth and a sacrifice fly in the seventh. Jerry Royster homered for Atlanta in the ninth. **1983:** The Richmond Braves beat the Toledo Mud Hens, 3-0, at Parker Field. Bob Walk, who entered 0-6 with a 10.59 ERA, started and threw a one-hit shutout and struck out nine. Richmond scored a run in the second on a groundout and Brad Kommink added a two-run homer in the third. **1991:** The Richmond Braves lost to the Omaha Royals, 4-0. Deion Sanders, optioned from Atlanta a few days prior, made his Richmond Braves debut and went 1-for-4 with a single and a walk. **2011:** Brandon Crawford made his MLB debut for the San Francisco Giants in a 5-4 win over the Milwaukee Brewers at Miller Park. He hit a grand slam in the seventh inning for his first MLB hit, giving the Giants a 5-3 lead. **2022:** The Flying Squirrels lost to the Hartford Yard Goats, 7-3. Kyle Harrison made his Double-A debut, becoming the youngest pitcher in franchise history (20 years, 288 days). He allowed two runs over 5.2 innings and struck out nine batters, two for the second-most in a Double-A debut in franchise history. Frankie Tostado went 3-for-3 with a solo homer. Hartford scored five runs in the seventh against Taylor Rashi and Ryan Walker.
