JOANDER-FUL: Mets No. 29 prospect RHP Joander Suarez made the start in the first game of Tuesday's doubleheader, and allowed one unearned run and just three hits over 5.1 innings. Over his last six starts, Suarez is 3-0 with a 2.18 ERA and a 33-to-6 strikeout-to-walk ratio in 33 innings. He has tossed at least five innings in six-straight starts. More recently over his last four starts, Suarez is 3-0 with a 0.78 ERA (2 ER) and a 24-to-5 strikeout-to-walk ratio in 23 innings with opponents batting .175 against him in that span. Suarez ranks among the Eastern League leaders with a 1.19 WHIP (3rd), 108.1 innings (8th), 106 strikeouts (9th), and a .245 BAA (10th).

LAST TIME OUT: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies were swept by the Portland Sea Dogs in the doubleheader on Tuesday at Mirabito Stadium. Joander **Suarez** allowed one unearned run over 5.1 innings in the start in the first game. Jeremiah Jackson had two hits in the first game. Rowdey Jordan had hits in both games.

FOREVER YOUNG: Infielder Wyatt Young walked twice in the first game of Tuesday's doubleheader. Young is now riding a 10-game on-base streak, hitting .360 (9-for-25) with a .900 OPS, nine hits, one double, two runs batted in, and eight walks in that span. Young hit .429 (6-for-14) with three runs scored at in five games at Somerset last week. The 24-year-old currently ranks sixth in the Eastern League with a .375 on-base percentage.

PATIENT PARADA: Mets No. 25 prospect Kevin Parada has reached base safely in 29 of his last 33 games, including a 20-game on-base streak from June 27 to July 26. In 11 games in August, Parada has drawn eight walks, while he only drew nine walks in 19 games in July. He had a red-hot July, as he hit .300 with an .880 OPS, three HR, five doubles, eight RBIs, and seven runs.

JORDAN'S BRAND: Infielder Rowdey Jordan hit an RBI double in the first game and singled and walked in the second game of Tuesday's doubleheader. Jordan is riding a six-game hit streak, hitting .353 (6-for-17) with a .951 OPS, three doubles, and three runs batted in. Since beginning to bat only right-handed on July 23 at Richmond, Jordan has 13 hits and seven extra base hits (six doubles and one home run) across 17 games.

MATEO MASH: Infielder Mateo Gil singled and scored in the first game of Tuesday's doubleheader. Gil is riding a five-game hit streak at the Double-A level, dating back to his first stint with the Rumble Ponies in May. Over his five-game hit streak, Gil is hitting .333 (6-for-18) with one home run, two runs batted in, and four runs scored.

METS TOP 30: MLB Pipeline released its new in-season top 100 prospects list and a new top 30 for every organization. There are five current Rumble Ponies in the Mets top 30: #2 Jett Williams (#57 OVR), #4 Ryan Clifford (#83 OVR), #9 Nolan McLean, #25 Kevin Parada, and #26 Alex Ramírez. The Mets new No. 1 prospect is RHP Brandon Sproat (#40 OVR). Here are the Mets 2024 draft picks in the organization's top 30: #5 Carson Benge (1st round), #11 Jonathan Santucci (2nd round), #17 Trey Snyder (5th round), and #22 Nate Dohm (3rd round).
