### JUMBO SHRIMP BLANKED 3-0

The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp were shut out 3-0 by the Gwinnett Stripers on Wednesday at Coolray Field. The Stripers scored everything they needed in the first inning. J.P. Martinez notched an RBI ground out for the game's first run and Yuli Gurriel followed with an RBI double to make it 2-0. The score remained that way until the fifth. Phillip Evans lifted a sacrifice fly to get the tally to 3-0. The Jumbo Shrimp mustered only four hits against Taylor Widener and Grant Holmes, who pitched 4.0 scoreless innings to pick up his fourth save.

### FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 31 of Jacksonville's 47 games (66.0 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer, including 13 of the club's last 16 contests. After beginning the year 12-3 (.750) in these narrowly-decided contests, the Jumbo Shrimp have suddenly struggled in games determined by no more than three runs; Jacksonville has lost 15 of its last 16 games decided by three runs or fewer for an overall record of 13-18 (.419) in these affairs.

### RUN, DON'T WALK

Despite yielding 402 hits thus far, tied for the fifth-most in the International League, Jacksonville's 1.36 WHIP ranks second in the circuit. The Jumbo Shrimp have excelled at not giving out many free passes to first base for opponents. The club's 165 walks are the second-fewest in the IL heading into play on Thursday. Jacksonville has issued three walks or fewer in 26 of the squad's 47 games in 2024 (55.3 percent).

### ALWAYS THE BRIDE, NEVER THE BRIDESMAID

Jumbo Shrimp infielder Jonah Bride has had two short stints in the major leagues this season, batting 2-for-12. With Jacksonville, however, Bride is 40-for-131 (.305/.450/.626/1.076) with 10 doubles, one triple, 10 home runs, 26 RBIs, 31 walks and 22 runs scored in 37 games played. The Owasso, Okla., native ranks second in the IL in OPS, third in slugging percentage, fourth in OBP, tied for sixth in extra-base hits (31), tied for ninth in both home runs and walks and 15th in batting average. Among the 132 qualified hitters in the IL, Bride ranks fourth in swinging-strike rate (5.1 percent) and 15th in line drive rate (30.5 percent).

### HAIL TO THE VICTOR

Jacksonville outfielder Victor Mesa Jr. missed the first six games of the season with an injury, but the 22-year-old has quickly made up for that lost time. In 38 games thus far with the Jumbo Shrimp, Mesa Jr. is 43- (T-15th in IL) for-154, slashing .279/.349/.461/.810 with seven doubles, seven home runs, 28 RBIs (T-19th), 17 walks and 27 runs scored. In 123 games last season with Pensacola, Mesa Jr. struck out in 22.9 percent of his plate appearances. He has shaved that to 17.9 percent this season with Jacksonville.

### LITTLE GUY, BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A, Javier Sanoja was just 6-for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5-foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances, meaning he was still making contact and putting the ball in play. That has manifested itself in a huge way of late; Sanoja has reached base safely in 13 of his last 14 games, mustering six multi-hit contests. During this span, he is 21-for-56 (.375/.455/.500/.955) with five doubles, one triple, seven RBIs, nine walks and six runs scored. Among the 176 IL hitters with at least 100 plate appearances, Sanoja has posted the highest opposite-field rate (51.1 percent) and the third-lowest swinging-strike rate (3.0 percent).

### TOUGH TIMES DON'T LAST

Thanks to a 3-0 loss to Gwinnett on Wednesday, Jacksonville has lost 17 of its last 20 games. The Jumbo Shrimp have struggled particularly on offense during this stretch. Offensively since April 30, when this run began, the club ranks 27th in Triple-A in batting average (.233), 29th in OBP (.319), 30th in SLG (.351), 30th in OPS (.670), 25th in hits (157) and 29th in runs scored (75). Jacksonville has scored three runs or fewer in 11 of these 20 games, falling from 1.5 games back of first in the standings to 11.5.

### SHRIMP BITES

The Jumbo Shrimp are 3-8 against Gwinnett in their last three sets... Jacksonville has now been shut out five times this season, tied for the most in the IL with St. Paul... The Jumbo Shrimp have lost their last six road games... Valente Bellozo will make his Triple-A debut on Thursday. In his last two Double-A starts, he went 13.0 innings and yielded only three runs on seven hits and two walks with 13 strikeouts.

### ABOUT VALENTE

-Bellozo was originally signed by the Houston Astros as a non-drafted free agent on July 3, 2017.

-After reaching as high as Double-A Corpus Christi, Bellozo was traded from Houston to the Miami Marlins on April 6, 2024 in exchange for infielder Jacob Amaya, who had recently been designated for assignment.

-Bellozo has pitched for his hometown Aguilas de Mexicali of the Mexican Pacific League in each of the past two offseasons.

### 2024 SEASON

-Bellozo was promoted to Jacksonville from Double-A Pensacola on May 22. In his final start with the Blue Wahoos, the right-hander yielded just one run on two hits in a career-high 7.0 innings on May 16 at Montgomery. He struck out eight Biscuits without walking a batter.

-At the time of his promotion, among the 110 Southern League pitchers with at least 10.0 innings pitched, Bellozo ranked 24th in walk percentage (5.3 percent). He also ranked 14th in strikeouts (39) among qualified hurlers in the Southern League.

### 2023 SEASON

-In 11 games (seven starts) of the first half of the season with High-A Asheville, Bellozo went 2-2 with a 7.35 ERA (49.0 IP, 62 H, 14 BB, 51 K, .308 BAA). However, over 11 appearances (six starts) in the campaign's second half with the Tourists prior to his August 29 promotion to Double-A Corpus Christi, Bellozo was 1-1 with a 4.93 ERA (45.2 IP, 44 H, 12 BB, 43 K, .247 BAA).
