**MAY 7<sup>th</sup> WORCESTER (16-16) at BUFFALO (18-14) 6:05 pm**

Worcester Red Sox RHP Grant Gambrell (1-3, 4.35) vs. Buffalo Bisons RHP Paolo Espino (0-1, 6.06)

**Seven Games in Buffalo** – The Worcester Red Sox – winners of 6 of their last 7 games - begin a 7-game series and roadtrip tonight in downtown Buffalo when they face the Buffalo Bisons (AAA-Toronto) at 6:05 pm at Sahlen Field. The game can be heard on NASH 98.9 FM, The Pike 100.1 FM, and the rest of the WooSox Radio Network. The teams will play an extended 7-game series this week/weekend because the clubs were postponed on consecutive days back on April 3 (rainout) & April 4 (snowout) at Polar Park in Worcester just over a month ago. Since the Bisons do not come back to Worcester during the first half of the International League schedule (that ends on June 23), the make-up of the April 4<sup>th</sup> postponement will be played tomorrow as part of a doubleheader in Buffalo at 5:05 pm. The WooSox will be the home team in Game 2 of tomorrow's twin bill.

**This Series** – The 7-game set breaks down this way...tonight at 6:05 pm, tomorrow a make-up doubleheader at 5:05 pm, Thursday & Friday both at 6:05 pm, and then Saturday & Sunday both at 1:05 pm. The WooSox will return to Worcester after the series finale on Sunday, take next Monday off, and then begin their longest homestand of the season on Tuesday, May 14 when they open a 12-game homestand that includes 6-games vs. 1<sup>st</sup>-place Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (AAA-Yankees) and defending International League Champion Norfolk (AAA-Baltimore) and top prospect INF Jackson Holliday. The 12-game WooSox homestand runs from May 14-26.

**A Hot Stretch** – Worcester has won 3 in a row and 6 of their last 7 games since April 28. During those 7 games the Sox have out-scored their opponents by a combined, 45-22 (including one game at Toledo and the last six at home vs. Lehigh Valley). In this 7-game stretch the WooSox are batting .299 as a team (69-for-231) with 19 doubles & 7 HR to raise their team batting average from .230 on April 27 to their current season-high of .246. Sox pitchers meanwhile are 6-1 with a 3.14 ERA (22 ER in 63 IP) to lower their team ERA from 5.36 on April 27 to their current 4.83.

**All Even on the Year** – The WooSox (at 16-16 on the year) have climbed back to the .500 mark for the first time in just over a month since they were 3-3 on April 5. A victory tonight would push them over .500 for the first time since they were 2-1 on March 31.

**Looking for Four of a Kind** – A WooSox win this evening would also tie their longest winning streak of the season. They had a season-high 4-game winning streak (from Game 2 on April 14 – April 19) that came immediately on the heels of a season-long 4-game losing skid (April 10 – Game 1 on April 14).

**Buffaloed a Month Ago** – The WooSox and Buffalo last met exactly one month ago on April 7<sup>th</sup> in Worcester when the Bisons capped a victorious series by beating the Sox, 10-5 to take 4 of 5 during the abbreviated series. So the Sox trail the season-series, 4 games to 1. The Bisons spoiled Worcester's home-opener on April 2 with a 2-0 win in 10-innings. The next two games were postponed due to weather (rain & snow). The teams split a make-up doubleheader on April 5 as the WooSox held on for a 9-7 victory in the opener but Buffalo gained the split with a 5-0 triumph in the nightcap. Buffalo won both games over the weekend on April 6 & 7 by scores of 10-6 and 10-5.

**Stats vs. Buffalo** – Sox pitchers are 1-4 with a 6.64 ERA vs. the Bisons this season (31 ER in 42 IP) with 4 HRA while WooSox batters are hitting .216 (33-for-153) with 3 HR. Buffalo has out-scored Worcester, 34-20 in the 5 games thus far.

**Beating the Bisons** – Worcester went 15-8 vs. Buffalo last season – their most wins against any International League foe. The WooSox were 10-3 at home vs. the Bisons compared to 5-5 in Buffalo.

**Home Getting Sweeter & Sweeter** - Worcester has won 9 of their last 12 home games dating back to April 16. As a result, the WooSox are 10-7 at home and 3-games over the .500 mark at Polar Park for the first time this season. Worcester went 43-33 at home last year.

**Comeback Kids** – Worcester has 8 CFB victories this season including 3 wins in their last at-bat of the game.

**One Has Been a Lonely Number** – Worcester is 0-6 in 1-run games this season. Last year the WooSox went 21-24 in 1-run games. The Sox are 3-3 in 2-run games this season. Last year they were 13-10 in that category.

**Series Math** – Worcester is 3-3-0 in their first six series of 2024 (3 wins, 3 losses, and no splits). They finished 13-8-5 in their 26 series last season...13 winners, 8 losers, and 5 splits. The WooSox went 8-3-2 in their 13 series at Polar Park and 5-5-3 in 13 sets on the road.

**Hit Me With Your Best Shot** – Sox batters are 1<sup>st</sup> in the 20-team International League by being hit by pitch 28 times this season.

**Rankings** – Worcester is 12<sup>th</sup> in the IL in team batting with a .246 average while Buffalo is 2<sup>nd</sup> at .276. On the pitching side, the Sox are 11<sup>th</sup> in team ERA (4.83) while the Bisons are 18<sup>th</sup> with a 5.54 ERA.

**April Recap** - The WooSox finished 10-14 in April (after going 2-1 in March) while batting .244 with 22 HR. Sox pitchers were 10-14 with a 5.55 ERA with 25 HRA. Worcester out-scored their opponents, 129-123 in April. The month also featured five postponements, four doubleheaders, 29 player transactions, 10 players promoted to Boston (not including any rehabbers), and a total of 41 players used (19 position players & 22 pitchers). Worcester went 11-14 last April and by the end of April, 2023 they were tied for 5<sup>th</sup>-place and 7 games back. They were in 8<sup>th</sup>-place and 6 GB at the end of this April.

**A Winning Tradition** – The 2023 Worcester Red Sox went 79-68 to post a winning season for the third time in as many years of existence. Worcester finished with a 43-33 home record compared to 36-35 on the road last year. The 2021 WooSox went 74-54 during their abbreviated inaugural season while the 2022 WooSox finished 75-73.

**Finish Line** – In the overall International League Standings for the 2023 season, out of 20 IL teams, Worcester finished in 7<sup>th</sup>-place with a 79-68 overall record. In the 1<sup>st</sup> half standings last year, the WooSox went 39-36 while they improved to 40-32 in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half. This season, for the second time ever, the IL will again invoke a split season with the first half starting tonight and ending on June 23 while the second half will run from June 25 – September 22.

**Month to Month** – Worcester went 12-14 last March/April, 13-14 in May, then had three straight winning months going 16-9 in June, 13-10 in July, and 16-11 in August, before finishing 9-10 in September.

**Seven Days a Week** – The WooSox were 0-1 on Monday last season, went 9-12 on Tuesdays, 11-11 on Wednesdays, 12-13 on Thursdays, 14-12 on Fridays, 20-6 on Saturdays, and 14-13 on Sundays in 2023.

**We Interrupt This Program** – Worcester had a total of 14 games either postponed (11) or canceled (3) last year due to weather. They have had five postponements thus far this season (three at home and two on the road).

**You Need a Scorecard** – The 2023 WooSox built on a pair of all-time Red Sox Triple-A records as they made **271 player transactions** during the 2023 campaign and set a new all-time Red Sox Triple-A record for players appearing in a single season. The WooSox used **79 different players** in 2023 (33 position players and 46 pitchers) to better the mark of 75 different players in 2022 (31 position players and 44 pitchers). Ironically, the 2021 WooSox set the previous mark of 72 different players (31 position players and 41 pitchers).

**Two Dozen to Go** - 24 different WooSox players were promoted to Boston during the 2023 season (not counting Red Sox rehabbing players) including Jarren Duran, Chris Murphy, Brandon Walter, David Hamilton, Wilyer Abreu, Ceddanne Rafaela, and many others.

**PORTLAND SEA DOGS UPDATE** – The Portland Sea Dogs (16-9) are coming off a series victory at home vs. Reading as the Sea Dogs took 5 of 6 vs. the Fightin’ Phils. So, the Red Sox Triple-A affiliate in Worcester won 5 of 6 from Lehigh Valley (AAA-Philadelphia) last week/weekend at Polar Park and the Sox Double-A affiliate did the same against the Phillies Double-A club. Portland continues their 12-game homestand with the opener of a 6-game set against the Binghamton Rumble Ponies tonight with Red Sox RHP Brayan Bello making a rehab start. Bello, 3-1 with a 3.04 ERA for Boston this season, has been on the Red Sox injured list since April 21 with right lat tightness.

**WOOSOX PLAYER MOVES** – The Red Sox today transferred LHP **Brendan Cellucci** from Worcester to Double-A Portland and RHP **Ryan Zeferjahn** from Portland to Worcester. Zeferjahn, 26, will be making his WooSox and Triple-A debut. He has been dominant in 7 games with the Sea Dogs this season going 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA – 13.2 IP, 9 H, 2 R, 0 ER, 3 BB, 22 SO.

Ryan was with Double-A Portland for the bulk of last season going 0-4 with a 5.02 ERA in 34 relief appearances with 2 saves. He struck out 68 in 43 innings for a 14.23 SO/9 IP ratio which was best on the Sea Dogs staff. Zeferjahn was Boston’s 3<sup>rd</sup> round selection in the 2019 June draft out of the University of Kansas where he became the first Jayhawk pitcher ever to record 100+ strikeouts in consecutive seasons - he did so as a sophomore in 2018 (100 SO) and a junior in 2019 (107 SO). Ryan spent the majority of 2022 with Single-A Greenville going 2-4 with a 5.79 ERA in 28 games (5 starts) with 73 SO in 60.2 IP. He finished the year with Portland posting a 3-0 mark and a superb 0.84 ERA in 6 relief appearances to help the Sea Dogs qualify for the Eastern League playoffs. The 6’5”, 210 lbs. Kansas native pitched for Falmouth in the Cape Cod League in 2017.

The WooSox have already sent 10 players to Boston in the 5½ weeks since the season started...INF David Hamilton, INF Romy Gonzalez, LHP Brennan Bernardino, INF/OF Bobby Dalbec, RHP Cooper Criswell, LHP Joe Jacques, LHP Cam Booser, C Tyler Heineman, RHP Zack Kelly, and RHP Naoyuki Uwasawa. Those ten do not include OF Rob Refsnyder and INF Vaughn Grissom who were injury rehab recalls from Worcester to Boston. Dalbec is back with the WooSox, Gonzalez is currently on a rehab assignment with Worcester, Heineman are currently on Boston’s injured list, and Jacques was claimed off waivers by Arizona. The rest of those players are still with the Red Sox.

- ON 2022: "I'm just grateful to even be out here because a couple years ago, it was a pretty dark time. I didn't know if I was going to be able to do it again. So it's just taking advantage of every opportunity that I get" ... "Nothing was really helping. So it finally got to the point where it was just affecting the way I was throwing and affecting my numbers and stuff. As you can see from my stats prior to this year, they weren't very good. So I was just battling with that and it's tough to play at the professional level and play with an injury. So it definitely took a toll on my body and on my arm. Fast forward to about halfway through 2021, I finally just said, 'Hey, guys. I can't pitch on this anymore. I need to get it looked at.'" ... **Underwent MRI, CT Scan ... Scan found benign tumor, which required five surgeries to "become 100%"**
- Chris Sale "took me under his wing" during comeback process when both were rehabbing in Fort Myers: "He was like, 'Hey, man. Everything's going to be all right. You're just going to have to deal with the lows right now but I promise you the highs will be worth it'"

- 2019 TRADE: Orig. a 3rd round pick of KC in 2019 draft ... Acquired in three-team deal that sent Andrew Benintendi to KC, returned to BOS w/Franchy Cordero, Luis De La Rosa in a three-team deal along w/Josh Winckowski, Freddy Valdez from NYM (also sent Khalil Lee from KC to NYM)
