**TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER:** The Curve hook up with the Erie SeaWolves for the first of three series between the clubs this season. Jaden Hamm and Troy Melton lead the pitching staff for the SeaWolves with Max Anderson and Trei Cruz highlight the position player group.

On the mound, RJ Petit starts a bullpen day for Erie. Petit tossed two scoreless innings for Erie on Tuesday night in relief. Petit has a career 3.70 ERA Petit has pitched in 88 games and started 2 for Erie in his 3 seasons with the Club, he has 143 strikeouts in 125.1 innings at the level.

IT'S ABOUT HOW YOU START: Curve starters tossed 15 scoreless innings to begin the season (Barco, Dotel, Solometo, Chen). Overall, Curve starters held a 1.09 WHIP, 2nd among Double-A staffs and 3.14 ERA, 3rd among Double-A clubs through play on May 9.

**JEBBING**: Utilityman **Mitch Jebb** has a reached in 15 straight games, during which he's batting .393 (22-for-56) with 4 2B, 5 BB and 7-7 SB. His .405 on-base percentage this season is 6th in the Eastern League.

CAPTAIN JACK: Infielder Jack Brannigan is on a lengthy on-base streak of his own; 14 games, entering play on Friday, May 9. He's picked up 13 hits and walked 7 times during this stretch, recording a .754 OPS.

**RELIEVERS ROLLING**: The Curve bullpen has several individuals throwing the ball well to begin the season. Righty relievers **Cam Sanders** and **Wilkin Ramos** have allowed a run in only one outing all season. Curve relievers have struck out 161 batters in 30 games this year, 3rd-most by a Double-A pitching staff.

WE'RE AT THE DOTEL HOTEL: Starter Wilber Dotel matched his career-high with 10 strikeouts on Sunday, May 4 against Akron. It was the first 10-K performance by the Curve since Thomas Harrington struck out 10 Somerset Patriots last July 20, 2024. Dotel enters play on Friday, 7th in the Eastern League in strikeouts (33) and 9th in batting average against (.194).

SCAN THIS BARCODE FOR OUTS: Lefty Hunter Barco tossed 25.2 consecutive scoreless innings to begin the season, the longest stretch franchise history. Barco was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Month for the month of April. Barco was one of 2 qualified pitchers in the minors with a 0.00 ERA at the time of his promotion to Triple-A on May 6.

**ENTER SANDMAN**: Righty **Cam Sanders** became the first Curve reliever to pick up 7 saves in a calendar month since **Matt Eckelman** saved 8 games in June of 2019. **Justin Kaye** (June, 2005) and **Matt Peterson** (June, 2007) hold the record for saves in a month by a Curve pitcher with 9.

A YOUNG MAN'S GAME: Infielder Termarr Johnson opens as the youngest position player in the Eastern League at 20 years old, just two days younger than Reading's Aidan Miller. Among Double-A players, he is the 7th-youngest player at the level; the youngest is San Antonio's Ethan Salas (SD, 18.8 years old). Johnson has reached base safely in 31-of-41 games with the Curve and has a hit in 20-of-27 games to begin the season.

OUT FOR A WALK: Altoona hitters are 7th among all Double-A clubs with 127 walks in 30 games this season.

**THE PIRATES ARE THIEVES**: Altoona enters play on Friday, May 9, 5th among Double-A clubs with 47 stolen bases in 55 tries. **Mitch Jebb** leads the club with 12 steals, 1st among Double-A players.

**WE'LL SEE THEM ALL**: For the first time since the 2019 season and the creation of the six-game series, the Curve will face every team in the Eastern League this season. Altoona will face New Hampshire and Binghamton on the road only, while Hartford and Reading will only play the Curve at PNG Field.

Prior to his time in Boston, Fox served as a first base coach for the Marlins and managed the Rangers Single-A Clinton team in 2006.
