**Today:** It's a doubleheader Sunday on Big Lug's 28th Birthday Party on a Sunday Capital City Market Kids Day, followed by an Extra Inning of ice cream, music, bubbles and more at Capital City Market, as the Lansing Lugnuts conclude a six-game series with the West Michigan Whitecaps. The Whitecaps are 9-7 against Lansing this year, winning the first two games of this series before losing the last two to the Nuts.

**Yesterday: Whitecaps at Lugnuts, ppd.** Last night's scheduled game was called due to unplayable field conditions, setting up today's twinbill of two seven-inning games separated by approximately 40 minutes between games. This is the Lugnuts' fifth doubleheader of the season.

**On the Air:** Today's games are on MiLB TV and Bally Live, or listen in to the audio stream via StreamGuys with **Jesse Goldberg-Strassler** and **Adam Jaksa** on the call.

**On Deck:** The Midwest League takes tomorrow off. On Tuesday, the Lugs head out to Quad Cities for a six-game series, returning for the final homestand of the year against the Fort Wayne TinCaps from August 27 through September 1, and then closing out the 2024 regular season with a six-game series at West Michigan.

### LUG NOTES

**To the Show:** Last night, 2022-23 Lugnuts right-hander **Grant Holman** made his Major League debut with 2/3 scoreless innings in the A's 2-0 shutout win over the Giants, becoming the 191st Nut to work his way to the Majors and the seventh this year. Holman, a Little League World Series sensation from Chula Vista, Calif., tossed 19 scoreless innings for Double-A Midland to start the year before allowing just five runs, three earned, in 29 1/3 innings for Triple-A Las Vegas; his overall ERA in 0.55 in 48 2/3 innings.

**Re-Rank:** This week, MLB Pipeline released its updated Top 100 MLB Prospects and Top 30 Prospects by team. The updated A's Top 30 has 2023 Lugnuts shortstop **Jacob Wilson** at No. 1, last night's starter **Luis Morales** at No. 3, former 2024 Nut **Henry Bolte** at No. 5, and current Lugnuts **Kade Morris** at No. 19, **Jared Dickey** at No. 27, **Will Simpson** at No. 29 and **Ryan Lasko** at No. 30.

**Power of Will:** First baseman **Will Simpson** tops the MWL in total bases (182), RBIs (79) and extra-base hits (45), is tied for 1st in the league in runs scored (66), and trails the doubles lead by two (28-26) and the walks lead by 10 (76-66).

**Roll Call:** Infielder **Ángel Arévalo** joined the Lugnuts on the road at Great Lakes and appeared last Saturday as a pinch-runner, becoming the 948th player in team history. The Nuts have used 45 different players this season: 23 position players, 22 pitchers.

**Team Effort:** The Nuts' offense ranks 1st in the MWL in batting average (.251), total bases (1417), triples (37) and OPS (.721); tied for 1st in hits (936) and doubles (185); and 2nd in at-bats (3,727), runs (555) and slugging percentage (.380); and 3rd in OBP (.341).

**History:** **Jake Garland** (5 innings), **Grant Judkins** (2 2/3 innings) and **Colton Johnson** (1 1/3 innings) tossed the 4th no-hitter in franchise history on Thursday, June 13, blanking Cedar Rapids, 8-0. It was the first no-hitter in Lansing since April 21, 2003, a 15-0 rout of Dayton in which **Donnie Hood** hit for the cycle, the first time ever a team had thrown a no-hitter and hit for the cycle.

**The Future is Here:** **Luis Morales**, the A's No. 1 pitching prospect, tossed 2/3 of an inning in the 2024 All-Star Futures Game at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas, striking out Jeral Pérez and Deyvison De Los Santos alongside an HBP and BB. Morales was the A's representative in the prospect showcase, and the fifth Nut to play in the game.

### TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2016:** The Great Lakes Loons finished off a four-game sweep of the Lugnuts at Cooley Law School Stadium with a 5-1 victory, going from 4.5 games back of the Nuts for the second and final Eastern Division playoff berth to 0.5 games back. The Loons would pass the Lugnuts on the way to the postseason – and the 2016 Midwest League Championship, the first title in franchise history.

**2018:** On Backyard Baseball Night / Pablo Sanchez's 21st birthday, the Lansing Mighty Wombats lost to the Fort Wayne TinCaps, 3-1, at Cooley Law School Stadium. A crowd of 8,968 cheered the Wombats in defeat, stymied by 5 2/3 scoreless innings from Luis Patiño.

**In a Nutshell:** Pitched in 2023 with the Nuts, returning to the Midwest League this season... spent the off-season training in Alabama with Tyler Baum... opened the season in a tandem with Opening Day starter James González... González was promoted on May 8, so Myers made the next four starts without a piggybacker... has since pitched in tandems with Chen Zhang-Ao Zhuang, Grant Judkins and Wander Guante... notable splits:

**Respect:** Mitch posted the No. 3 score in the world in the video game *Monkey Ball*... he is also considered the top chess player in the Lugnuts' clubhouse.

**Hometown Hero:** Hometown of Lanett's motto is "The Gateway to Alabama," since it sits directly on the Eastern border to Georgia, directly bordering West Point, Georgia... pitched for Valley High School as a freshman and sophomore and Opelika High School as a junior and senior, posting a career 1.22 ERA with a fastball/curveball mix, playing third base, and batting third... father Barry starred in baseball at Jacksonville State.

**The Buc Starts Here:** Initially committed to University of Alabama, but coach instability led to Mitch joining juco Florida Southwestern State instead, making 15 appearances, 14 starts, in both 2017-18 and 2018-19... as a freshman: 5-6, 4.28, 2 CG, 73 2/3, 35 BB, 62 K, 1 HR... as a sophomore: 7-2, 3.29, 3 CG, 79 1/3, 23 BB, 88 K, 3 HR... became one of 10 Bucs to sign on with a D-I program (not including Ryan Gusto, who was drafted in the 11th round by the Astros).

**Onward to Pitt:** Upon transferring to Pittsburgh, made four starts in 2020 (2-2, 3.52, 23 IP, 4 BB, 30 K, 0 HR) before the season was shut down, with 10 strikeouts in six shutout innings vs. Lehigh... followed in 2021 as Pitt's Friday starter: 13 GS, 5-5, 3.21, 1 CG, 81 1/3, 23 BB, team-leading 83 K, 6 HR... tossed 9-IP CG at Virginia, 3/20/21, allowing three hits, one run, and whiffing five... the last Pitt Panther to appear in a game for the Nuts before Myers was also the only other Panther to play for the Nuts: T.J. Zeuch (pronounced "Zoyk"), the 21st pick in the 2016 draft, who made two starts in the Midwest League for Lansing in 2016.

**2022 Professional Debut:** After signing for \$125,000 as the Athletics' 12th-round selection in 2021, did not appear in a Minor League game until 2022, spent entirely with Stockton... led Ports in starts (22, six more than the closest teammate), innings (124 1/3, 28 1/3 more innings than the closest teammate), and double plays (10)... worked seven innings five times, 6 2/3 innings once, 6 1/3 innings twice, and six innings four times: 12 starts of 22 starts lasting at least six innings... struggled in 12 games, 11 starts, at home (7.11 ERA, .304 avg, 16 HR, in 57 innings) compared to 11 starts on the road (4.14 ERA, .269, 10 HR in 67 1/3 innings)... lefties and righties hit nearly identically: .286/.355/.536 for lefties, .285/.339/.525 for righties, though righties hit 17 of the 26 home runs allowed... struggled mightily in first innings, allowing .353/.402/.627 slash line and six home runs... opposing base stealers swiped 10 bases in 16 attempts.

**2023 with the Lugnuts:** Opened season as the Nuts' Wednesday starter... tossed first quality start of the year on April 27, allowing two runs (both in the 5th) in six innings vs. Quad Cities April 27... followed up with a second quality start on May 4 vs. Dayton, though he once again received a no-decision... struck on the back of the head by a line drive against Peoria on June 13 and spent two weeks on the Injured List, missing his scheduled start at Wisconsin before returning to action at Great Lakes on July 3... tossed another quality start (6 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 0 BB, 6 K) against Quad Cities on July 27.

**No-Hit History:** On June 13, tossed five hitless innings, walking two and striking out six, before handing the baton to Grant Judkins (2 2/3) and then Colton Johnson (1 1/3) as part of the Lugnuts' 8-0 no-hitter of the Cedar Rapids Kernels, the 4th no-hitter in franchise history and the first home no-hitter since April 2003.

**Hometown Hero:** Started four years for Jupiter High School varsity baseball ("Warriors," wearing green and gold)... totaled 229 strikeouts, 1.49 ERA and 1.13 WHIP... named two-time FHSAA All-State... honored twice as the 9A Player of the Year... also from Jupiter H.S.: Miles Mikolas and Dante Bichette (but not son Bo, who attended Lakewood High School in St. Petersburg)... family originally from New England before moving to Florida shortly before he was born; the Garlands thus all root for Boston-area teams.

**Jupiter?** How did Jake's hometown receive its name? The Hobe tribe lived in the area, a Spanish mapmaker miswrote their name as Jobe, which was then miswritten again as Jove, which was then mistranslated to Jupiter. Misunderstandings the whole way down to the city's incorporation in 1925. Jupiter is located on the eastern coast of Florida in Palm Beach County on the Atlantic Ocean.

**The Bandit Connection:** Burt Reynolds was born in Lansing in 1936, and died in Jupiter in 2018.

**The U:** Attended the University of Miami (Coral Gables), a baseball program founded in 1940 with four NCAA championships and 25 CWS appearances... played for head coach Gino DiMare... true freshman year was the pandemic-shortened 2020 season, making six relief appearances before the year was shut down... returned in 2021 as a member of the rotation: 16 games, 13 starts, totaling a team-high 68 innings (5.69 ERA, 38 K, 14 BB, .286 avg.)... improved in 2022 to a 3.99 ERA in 65 1/3 innings (54 K, 11 BB, lowering home runs from 10 to four)... fifth of six Hurricanes drafted in 2022, going 514th overall in the 17th round to Oakland... the last Miami product drafted by the A's: Jemile Weeks (1st round, 12th overall, 2008)... two other Hurricanes have played for the Lugnuts: 3B Mark Sobolewski and OF Adam Finnieston.

**Path to Lansing:** After signing for \$100,000, made three appearances, one start, for the Arizona Complex League A's, tossing three total innings... opened 2023 pitching in relief in Stockton's second game of the year, started by rehabbing American League All-Star Paul Blackburn... earned the honor of **California League Pitcher of the Week** with his very next outing, firing five perfect innings on April 13 at Fresno with seven strikeouts (69 pitches, 47 strikes)... finished his time in Stockton with back to back six-inning outings against Fresno and Rancho Cucamonga before getting called up to the Lugnuts to replace Jorge Juan on May 15... dominated in Lugnuts debut May 18 vs. Lake County: 95 pitches, 59 strikes, 7 innings, 2 hits, 1 run, 2 walks, 10 strikeouts, in 5-2 win.
