FRISCO HAMMERS ARKANSAS IN GAME TWO OF SERIES:

The Frisco RoughRiders used a power-ridden third inning, with five extra-base hits and two home runs, to take a 9-5 win on Wednesday night over the Arkansas Travelers at Riders Field. With five runs in the third, Frisco (6-5) took its first lead of the series. Arkansas (8-3) never came back to tie. **Owen White** (1-0) logged his longest start of the season, going five innings to collect the win. White allowed three runs, all earned, and struck out three. The RoughRiders notched nine hits off of Arkansas starter Bryce Miller (0-2), who allowed six earned runs and was saddled with the loss. The RoughRiders totaled 12 hits in the contest with four doubles and three home runs. **Dio Arias** got his first two homers of the year, while **Chris Seise** launched his first. Seise led off the five-run third inning with a solo homer to right field while Arias added a two-run homer later that inning to take the lead and a second two-run homer in the seventh inning to extend it. Eight different Frisco hitters recorded a base hit. Only **Dustin Harris** went hitless, but he walked twice and added a sacrifice fly. Arkansas scored a pair of runs in the seventh inning to pull within 9-5, but **Marc Church** entered out of the bullpen to close the seventh. He went 1.1 innings before **Triston Polley** pitched the ninth inning with both relievers holding Arkansas scoreless. **Luisangel Acuña** kept rallies going in the third and fourth innings, doubling for a run batted in each frame. The 21-year-old is now riding a seven-game hit streak.

DEJA VU ALL OVER AGAIN:

RoughRiders infielder **Dio Arias** crunched two home runs on Wednesday for his second multi-home run game of his career. His first, also with Frisco, took place 363 days earlier on April 21st, 2022 against Northwest Arkansas.

THIS PEN IS NO BULL...:

To start this season, the RoughRiders bullpen has been brilliant. Through 11 games, the Riders have just allowed two home runs and own a 2.02 ERA. That is good for first in the Texas League and fourth in all of Minor League Baseball (Hudson Valley, 1.61, Harrisburg, 1.57, Down East, 1.94). Against San Antonio, the Riders pen only ceded three earned runs for a 1.08 ERA in the six games. Six different Frisco relievers have thrown at least two times without allowing a run. Overall, the RoughRiders have a team ERA of 2.97 which is the best in the Texas League (Tulsa is second with a 3.53 ERA) and 10th in all of Minor League Baseball.

LOAD UM UP:

The RoughRiders have had a league-high 17 at-bats with the bases loaded this season. As a team, they are hitting .353 (6-for-17)/.333/.824/1.157 with two grand slams and 18 RBIs. They are one of just 11 teams in Minor League Baseball with at least two grand slams this season already as **Trevor Hauver** hit one on Opening Day and **Dustin Harris** added another on Sunday in San Antonio. On the pitching side, Frisco has not allowed a hit with the bases loaded this year and only one run on a sacrifice fly.

DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:

The RoughRiders have just committed four errors through 11 games and committed their first position player error on Sunday. The team's .990 fielding percentage is third in Minor League Baseball (Clearwater and Memphis, .992).

WALK THIS WAY:

The Riders hitters worked 40 walks in the six games against the San Antonio Missions, which was the sixth-most in the minors last week. On the season, Frisco's 60 walks lead the Texas League and are tied for sixth in Minor League Baseball (among non-Triple-A teams) while their .357 team OBP is third in the Texas League. **Evan Carter** leads the Texas League (and is tied for the Double-A lead) with 12 walks and is third in OBP (.519).

I LIKE BIG WINS AND I CANNOT LIE:

The RoughRiders six wins this season have come by eight, six, seven, seven, 10 and four runs, respectively, while their five losses have come by a combined 14 runs. That gives Frisco a +28 run differential through 11 games, which is the best in the Texas League despite being tied with Amarillo (6-5 record, -11 run differential) in first in the South Division. The only team with a +20 run differential in the league is Tulsa, which is 7-4 (+25).

EVAN ALMIGHTY:

Outfielder **Evan Carter** has reached safely in 10 of the 11 games this season, batting .381 (16-for-42)/.519/.619/1.138 with a double, three home runs, 12 walks, 15 RBIs and three stolen bases. Carter is fifth in the Texas League in average (.381), tied for third in hits (16), tied for second in home runs (3), tied for second in RBIs (15), first in walks (12) and fourth in OPS (1.138). On Wednesday, Carter crushed a three-run home run and a solo homer for his second two-home run game of his Minor League career before adding another home run on Sunday. The No. 1 prospect in the Rangers system won a MiLB Rawlings Gold Glove in 2022. The reigning Tom Greive Rangers Minor League Player of the Year, Carter joined the RoughRiders for the last week of the 2022 season and the playoffs. Carter is also the second-youngest player in the Texas League this season, trailing on 19-year-old Deyvison De Los Santos of Amarillo.

ABOUT ROBY

-On his name Tekoah: Born in Hendersonville, North Carolina and, about two hours away in Georgia, there is a beautiful area named Toccoa Falls with waterfalls and outdoor activities. His parents were driving around there one day and liked the way it sounded, so they changed the spelling and named their son Tekoah.

-Originally committed to Troy University in Alabama.

-Paired a 7-3 record with a 1.19 ERA in his junior season at Pine Forest High School in Pensacola, Fla., earning the 2019 Pensacola News Journal Pitcher of the Year award...recorded 109 strikeouts against just 10 walks that season while contributing a .384 batting average and 28 RBI at the plate to lead Pine Forest to its first regional appearance in 12 years.

-Is one of several Texas minor leaguers enrolled in the club's 'RangersU Powered by ACU' program, which allows players and coaches to earn academic credit by taking online courses taught by Abilene Christian University faculty and staff in both English and Spanish.

2023 SEASON

-Entered the season as the No. 12 prospect in the Rangers system per MLB.com.

-Struck out seven over six innings on April 15th in San Antonio, allowing all four runs with two outs (two runs in the second inning and two runs in the sixth before he exited).

2022 SEASON

-Was one of the youngest starting pitchers in the South Atlantic League, pitching the entire season at the age of 20.

-Late in the season, he added a slider to give himself a true four-pitch mix.

-Led the Crawdads staff in innings pitched (104.2) and strikeouts (126).

-Over his first six starts, he allowed 23 runs (7.67 ERA), but rebounded to collect a 3.59 ERA over his last 16 games (15 starts), starting on May 24th.

-In his last five starts, Roby owned a 2.22 ERA (6 ER/24.1 IP), striking out 36 batters to just five walks.

-On August 19th, he threw an immaculate inning against Winston-Salem (nine pitches with three strikeouts).

2021 SEASON

-Made only six starts because of an elbow sprain in June, but did not have surgery.

-It was a proximal tear in the UCL, which heals easier than a distal tear without surgery.

-In six starts, struck out 38.9% of hitters (35 of 90) and held opponents to a .177 batting average against.
