**Last Night: Captains 8, Lugnuts 7.** The Caps' Jace LaViolette, Nolan Schubart, Esteban González and Ryan Cesarini each homered to help the Captains build an 8-2 lead, and then held on tight to stave off the Nuts by a run in front of 1,454 on Thursday night at Classic Auto Group Park. Jared Sprague-Lott, Pedro Pineda and Myles Naylor homered in the loss.

**On the Air:** Adam Jaksa and Jesse Goldberg-Strassler, the Nuts' broadcast tandem since 2019, deliver the call on [milb.streamguys1.com/lansing](https://milb.streamguys1.com/lansing).

**On Deck:** The Lugnuts play in Lake County through Sunday. The next home game: 7 days away, following the All-Star Break, beginning a three-game mini-series July 17-19.

### LUG-NOTES

**Cooperstown Bound:** A member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, Carlos Beltrán went on to be voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, was named a nine-time All-Star, and won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and the 2017 World Series during a 20-year MLB career. On July 27, Beltrán will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown.

**Pinch-Skipper:** Lugnuts manager Javier Godard takes his annual break this week – each member of the coaching staff gets one week off during the year – and is replaced as interim manager by Tim Esmay ("Ez-may") the Athletics' quality control and field coordinator. Esmay formerly served as the head coach at Arizona State University, taking the Sun Devils to four NCAA Regionals, two Super Regionals and the 2010 College World Series, then managed Winston-Salem in 2015, Great Falls from 2017-2019, and the Arizona Complex League A's in 2024-2025.

**Prospecting:** The Nuts' roster has four players on MLB Pipeline's Top 30 rankings of A's prospects: No. 15 (Steven Echavarria), No. 17 (Zane Taylor), No. 22 (Nate Nankil) and No. 29 (Nathan Dettmer). Baseball America's re-ranking of A's prospects placed Echavarria at No. 16, Zane Taylor at No. 18 and Nathan Dettmer at No. 21.

**Lugnut All-Stars:** Among the 2026 MLB All-Stars are 2017 Lugnut Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. (Toronto Blue Jays first baseman, A.L. All-Star starter at first base, who announced he will sit out the ASG, replaced by the A's Nick Kurtz in the starting lineup); 2019 Nut Otto López (Miami Marlins shortstop, N.L. reserve); and 2022 Nut Mason Miller (San Diego Padres closer).

**Lugnut Future Star:** 2025 Lugnuts shortstop Leo De Vries is on the American League All-Star Futures Game roster alongside fellow Athletics prospect / Midland RockHounds southpaw Jamie Arnold. De Vries competed in the Futures Game last year, too, when he was in the Padres' organization... and struck out on three pitches against fellow 2025 Lugnut Gage Jump.

#### Lugnut League Leaders:

- Zane Taylor leads the MWL in ERA (3.43), ranks 2nd in innings (76), 3rd in WHIP (1.28) and 6th in opponent avg. (.244).
- Samuel Dutton is 3rd in the league in innings (75 2/3), 6th in ERA (4.76) and 9th in WHIP (1.50).
- Steven Echavarria is 7th in innings (70 1/3), 3rd in lowest average (.234), 5th in WHIP (1.38) and tied for 3rd in starts (15).

- Daniel Bucciero earned a call-up to Lansing from Stockton after batting .619 / .692 / 1.095 July 1-5: 13-for-21, 9 R, 4 2B, 2 HR, 4 BB.
- Myles Naylor is batting .300 / .356 / .475 in his last nine games: 12-for-40, 7 R, 4 2B, 1 HR, 3 RBI, 4 BB.
- Pedro Pineda is batting a sizzling .385 / .484 / .654 through eight games in July: 10-for-26, 5 R, 1 2B, 2 HR, 4 BB, 7 K.
- Bryan Arendt works in a battery with Nathan Dettmer for the fourth time (three games this year in Stockton, 1-2 record).
- Rodney Green, Jr. reached base 4x yesterday (1B, 2B, two BBs); it was the second time in 2026 he had reached 4x (April 30).
- Carlos Pacheco is receiving back-to-back starts for the first time since June 25-26.
- Nathan Dettmer is coming off 7 K in 5 2/3 IP on the 4th of July at Dayton... allowed 5 R on 9 H and 5 BB in 5 IP at LC, May 24.

## JULY 10 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2015:** Juan Kelly's first hit with the Lugnuts was a tie-breaking home run off infielder-turned-emergency-pitcher Jimmy Allen in the 15th inning, and the Lugnuts beat the Great Lakes Loons, 6-5, at Dow Diamond. It was the second time in the season that the Lugnuts had won at Great Lakes in the 15th inning or later on a home run off a Loons position player pitching (Rowdy Tellez off Josmar Cordero, 16th inning, April 16th). Kelly had been 0-for-6 with three strikeouts entering the at-bat.

**2022:** Five pitchers combined to strike out 15 Great Lakes Loons in a 4-0 Sunday win, with Jake Walkinshaw whiffing nine in four scoreless innings, Brock Whittlesey fanning one in two frames, Angello Infante striking out one in 2/3, Kumar Nambiar notching two strikeouts in 1 1/3, and Trayson Kubo struck out two in the ninth.

**2023:** Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. wins the MLB Home Run Derby, outslugging Julio Rodriguez in the final.
