BAYSOX SPLIT SATURDAY DOUBLEHEADER

Chesapeake took game one by a final of 3-1 over Harrisburg. **Frederick Bencosme** gave the Baysox the lead with a double in the top of the sixth. **Silas Ardoin** also notched an RBI single in the first inning. **Nate Webb** tossed two scoreless innings of relief and got the win, while **Gerald Ogando** picked up his third save. The Baysox dropped game two, 7-1, with their only offense coming on a first inning single from **Creed Willems**. **Nestor German** struck out seven, but took the loss. The defeat in game two snapped Chesapeake's five-game winning streak.

CREED CRUSHES

C Creed Willems is tied for sixth in the Eastern League in doubles (11) and tied for seventh in extra base hits (18). The Orioles No. 12 prospect has the fourth-most homers in the league in the month of May (4). The 21-year-old is the youngest position player on the Baysox.

ENRIQUE ELECTRIFIES

OF **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** tallied his fourth-career Double-A game with three or more hits on Friday, and his first such game of the season. In 38 career Double-A contests, the O's No. 3 prospect is batting .295, with a .395 on-base percentage and .805 OPS. The Baysox are 8-2 this season in games started by Bradfield, who missed 32 games earlier this season due to injury.

WALK THIS WAY

C Silas Ardoin leads the Eastern League in walks (34). Ardoin drew the most walks in the league in the month of April with 18. No player had drawn more walks in the circuit since April 23 than Ardoin. Last season, he drew 47 walks in 104 games.

ACTION JACKSON

Over his last 12 games, IF **Jeremiah Jackson** is batting .327 with two home runs, seven doubles, and a .938 OPS. The first year Baysox shortstop is second in the league in doubles (15). **The next home run for Jackson will be the 100th of his pro career.** A former Mets farmhand who played 158 games with the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Jackson has homered in every Eastern League ballpark aside from FNB Field.

BULLPEN BEASTS

Chesapeake's bullpen holds a 2.88 ERA, which is third-best in Double-A and fifth-best in MiLB. Baysox relievers threw 14-consecutive scoreless innings to open this week in Harrisburg - the most of any Minor League team - and have allowed just two runs in 22.2 innings this series (0.79 ERA).

ONE RUN WONDERS

Friday night was Chesapeake's 13th one-run victory of the season - **the most of any Minor League team.** The Baysox have also played more one-run games (21) this season than any other MiLB side.

SCOUTING THE SENATORS

The Harrisburg Senators enter Sunday with a record of 20-24 on the season. The Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, Harrisburg's 105 runs in the month of May are tied for most in the Eastern League. The Senators roster features two active members of the Nationals Top 30 prospect list (per MLB.com) - IF Cayden Wallace (No. 10) and IF Kevin Made (No. 26). Harrisburg is managed by returning skipper Delino DeShields, who appeared in four games for the Baysox in 1999 during his playing career.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Kyle Luckham is Sunday's projected starter for Harrisburg. Luckham started Tuesday against the Baysox and allowed a pair of unearned runs in 5.2 innings on six hits with five strikeouts. Luckham is currently 5th in the Eastern League in ERA, among qualifiers. This is his third season spending time with the Senators. He also made a spot start in Triple-A Rochester earlier this season. Luckham was originally a 15th round pick of the Nationals in 2022 out of Arizona State. This is his fourth professional season.

No. 16 Orioles prospect (FanGraphs)

Learned a new changeup grip during offseason, relies on it heavily now

2025: Leads O's minor leaguers in ERA, WHIP, and K. Delivered first scoreless Double-A start with 5.0 shutout IP and 6 K on 5/18 vs AKR. Has struck out eight batters in three of his first five Double-A outings. Threw 21 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the season. Piggybacked Orioles' rehabber Trevor Rogers and struck out season-high eight batters in 4.1 shutout innings in Double-A debut on 4/23 vs ALT. Promoted to Double-A Chesapeake on 4/22. Started season in High-A Aberdeen. Made three starts and did not allow an earned run in 16.1 IP with 18 K over 5 BB. Pitched career-high 7.0 scoreless IP on 4/16 vs BRK. Named to Orioles Spring Breakout roster.

2024: Spent first full season in Minors in Single-A Delmarva primarily as a starter. Struck out 3rd-most batters in Carolina League and 7th-most in O's system (122). Recorded a 2.98 ERA with 73 K over 9 BB in second half. Best month was August (0.68 ERA in 26.2 IP with 37 K over 3 BB).

Career Notes: Debuted professionally in '23 with Delmarva.

College: Pitched three seasons at Nebraska primarily as a reliever before transferring to Dallas Baptist for one season as a full-time starter. Named Second-Team All-Conference USA after going 9-2 with 4.19 ERA. Struck out 92 batters in 86 innings of work, which is 9th-most in a single-season in DBU history.

Personal: Drafted by the Orioles in the 8th round of the 2023 Draft out of Dallas Baptist. First player from DBU selected in that year's draft. Native of Kansas City, MO. Attended Liberty High School and played for his dad, Kirk, who was head coach.

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

Roberto Mercado returns for his second season as Baysox Manager in 2025 after completing his first year at the Double-A level last season. The 17th manager in franchise history, he led the Baysox to a 62-75 overall record, oversaw 18 player promotions to Triple-A and coached two former Baysox who would go on to make their Major League debuts in the same season. The New Britain, CT native also managed the Surprise Saguaros of the Arizona Fall League this past offseason, where he led them to a league-best 18-10 record and a Fall League Championship Game appearance.

Before the Baysox, Mercado spent two seasons as manager of the Aberdeen IronBirds - the Orioles' High-A affiliate. Mercado received the Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award in 2022 by the Orioles.

Prior to joining the O's, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut and served as Dean of Students for over 18 years.

JORDIE HENRY

Pitching Coach

Jordie Henry enters his first season as Baysox Pitching Coach in 2025 and his third season as a member of the Orioles' system. Previously, Henry served as the pitching coach at High-A Aberdeen where his staff recorded 1,357 strikeouts last season – 2nd-most in the South Atlantic League and 2nd-most in IronBirds franchise history. Before joining the Orioles, Henry was the Director of Pitching at Prime Sports Performance in Baltimore – a private athletic development training facility. He also worked as a pitching coach and instructor at the high school and summer collegiate levels. Henry pitched collegiately for four seasons at Wayland Baptist University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Josh Bunselmeyer returns for his second season as Baysox Hitting Coach in 2025 and his sixth as a member of the Orioles' system. CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE



The Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión™" or "Fun Cup™" - a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League Baseball™ teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

BOWIE PIT BEEF



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
