SUNDAY SLIPS AWAY: The Omaha Storm Chasers led the Indianapolis Indians, 5-3, through three innings thanks to a home run and four RBIs from **OF Kyle Isbel**, but allowed an eight-run sixth inning to ultimately fall, 12-5, in the series finale at Victory Field. In the sixth, the Indians sent 12 men to the plate, scoring eight runs on four walks and five hits, including a grand slam. It was the most runs the Chasers have allowed in a single inning this season. Omaha used a season-high seven pitchers for the second consecutive Sunday and issued 10 walks, one shy of tying a season high.

THE FUTURE IS HERE: **INF Bobby Witt Jr.** and **1B Nick Pratto** were promoted to Triple-A Omaha from Double-A Northwest Arkansas on Sunday, July 18, and are poised to make their Triple-A debuts this week at Werner Park. Witt Jr., the No. 1 prospect in the Kansas City Royals organization and the No. 8 overall prospect according to *Baseball America*, hit .292/.367/.564 in 60 games with the Naturals, leading Double-A Central in total bases (164) and RBIs (50) while tying for the league lead in hits (71), ranking second in home runs (16), and fourth in OPS (.931) at the time of his promotion. Pratto, the No. 10 prospect in the Royals organization and the No. 94 overall prospect overall prospect according to *Baseball America*, hit .273/.405/.573 in 60 games with the Naturals, leading the league in extra-base hits (32) and walks (46), ranking second in OPS (.978), third in home runs (15), and fourth in RBIs (43). Both Witt Jr. (2nd overall, 2019) and Pratto (14th overall, 2017) were first round picks by the Kansas City Royals in the MLB Draft and started for the American League in the 2021 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Coors Field in Denver, Colo. on July 11.

PROSPECTS AT WERNER PARK: With the additions of **INF Bobby Witt Jr.** (No. 8) and **1B Nick Pratto** (No. 94), the Omaha Storm Chasers roster now includes four of MLB's Top 100 overall prospects according to *Baseball America*, including **LHP Daniel Lynch** (No. 22) and **RHP Jackson Kowar** (No. 68). Witt Jr. is the highest-ranked position player prospect to play for Omaha since **OF Wil Myers** (2012), who was ranked as the 28th-best prospect by *Baseball America* in 2012 and earned *Baseball America* Player of the Year honors. The Storm Chasers roster also includes nine of the Royals organization's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*, including Witt Jr. (No. 1), Lynch (No. 2), Kowar (No. 4), **OF Kyle Isbel** (No. 6), Pratto (No. 10), **OF Edward Olivares** (No. 19), **RHP Tyler Zuber** (No. 20), **INF Lucius Fox** (No. 22), and **RHP Scott Blewett** (No. 25).

STEALING THE SPOTLIGHT: The Storm Chasers are second in Triple-A East and first in the Midwest Division with 76 stolen bases, including five on Sunday, which tied a season high. Omaha has only been caught stealing 13 times, giving them a league-best 85.4% success rate. The Chasers stole 65 bases in 76 attempts (85.5%) in the first 61 games of the season while the league used experimental 18" x 18" bases and have 11 steals in 14 attempts (78.6%)—the most in the league—since the switch to the standard 15" x 15" bases on Tuesday, July 13.

HOME SWEET HOME: The Omaha Storm Chasers are 22-7 (.759) at Werner Park—the best home winning percentage in Triple-A East—but 18-17 (.514) in road games this season. In 29 home games, the Chasers are batting .279/.347/.502 with 56 home runs and a 3.88 ERA. In 35 road games, Omaha is batting .253/.335/.460 with 57 home runs and a league-worst 5.64 road ERA. The Chasers are 12-5 over their last three home series and 8-10 over their last three road series.

FOR OMAHA: **LHP Daniel Lynch** makes his 11th start (12th appearance) with Omaha and his third this season against the St. Paul Saints. In his last start on 7/15 @ IND, Lynch struck out six batters and walked none in 3.2 innings, allowing one unearned run on two hits in a rain-shortened start. The left-hander has allowed 14 runs on 18 hits—including five home runs—in 10.1 innings in two starts against St. Paul, both at CHS Field. He allowed seven runs on a career-high 10 hits in 5.1 innings in his last start against the Saints on 7/1 @ STP. The 34th overall pick in the 2018 MLB Draft out of the University of Virginia, Lynch is the best left-handed pitching prospect in baseball according to *Baseball America*.

FOR ST. PAUL: **RHP Chandler Shepherd** makes his 11th start (13th appearance) with St. Paul. He threw a season-high 6.0 innings on 7/15 vs. COL, giving up five runs on nine hits with five strikeouts and one walk. Shepherd has made two starts against Omaha this season, allowing a season-high 11 runs on a season-high 14 hits in 3.2 innings on 6/10 vs. OMA and tossed 5.0 shutout innings with two hits allowed on 7/4 vs. OMA.

DOPPLER RADAR: At 21 years old, **INF Bobby Witt Jr.** becomes the youngest player on the Chasers' roster and the first player in franchise history born after Dec. 31, 1999... The average age on the Storm Chasers current active roster is 25.6 years old... Omaha welcomes St. Paul to Werner Park for the second and final time this season, winning four of six against the Saints during Opening Week at Werner Park from May 4-9.

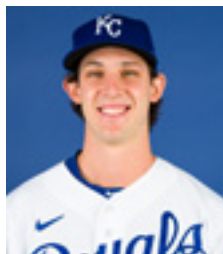

- Allowed a career-high 10 hits and seven runs on 7/1 @ STP, his second start at CHS Field allowing seven runs
- Tied a Triple-A best with seven strikeouts on 6/25 @ IOW in 5.0 shutout innings
- Recorded back-to-back starts of 5.0+ IP, ≤ 1 run allowed, and 6+ strikeouts vs. Indianapolis on 5/25 and 5/30
- Made Triple-A debut on 5/18 @ IOW, striking out seven in 6.0 innings in first career relief outing, pitching behind RHP Jesse Hahn, who made a rehab start
- Was on Omaha's preliminary 2021 roster before being called up by Kansas City on 4/3
- Made Major League debut on 4/3 vs. CLE, allowing three runs on four hits in 4.2 innings
