A House Divided... Friday night's theme at Bowling Green Ballpark honors the two biggest public schools in Kentucky. The Bowling Green Hot Rods have featured three different Kentucky Wildcats alumni and two former Louisville Cardinals during the 2026 season. Current infielder Ryan McCoy and RHP Kaleb Corbett attended UL, LHP Dominic Niman took a graduate school year at UK.

Another One Swipes the Dust... The Hot Rods are up to a franchise-record 268 stolen bases this season. The Hot Rods stole three bases in Thursday's 11-2 win over the Greensboro Grasshoppers. The 268 steals surpasses the 2024 Hot Rods squad, who stole 262 bases.

Santa Maria's Scorching... Infielder Tony Santa Maria delivered his 47th stolen base, which leads the 2026 South Atlantic League, on Thursday night to go along with a three-hit game and an RBI. The 24-year-old is batting .343 with runners in scoring position this season and has three RBI during this series.

Month of Myers.. Outfielder Noah Myers is tied for first the SAL with a .492 OBP. The third-year Hot Rod is currently on a 20-game on-base streak since July 23. He is the fifth 2026 Hot Rods player with a 20+ game on-base streak.

Summer Thrill... Outfielder Brendan Summerhill has posted four hits and four runs driven in during this series with Greensboro. The Tampa Bay Rays' No. 28 prospect has hit in all six games since earning his callup, batting 8-for-17 (.471 AVG) with a home run and six RBI in five games.

Fastballs for Fritton... LHP Dominic Fritton starts on the mound Friday night. The 23-year-old has posted 13 strikeouts in his first two starts with the Hot Rods. Fritton led the Carolina League with 111 strikeouts when he was promoted to Bowling Green.

Flew Takes Flight... Nathan Flewelling belted his 21 st home run of the season Tuesday night. Flewelling tied 2018 Bowling Green backstop Ronaldo Hernandez for the most single-season home runs by a catcher in franchise history.
