**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels lost their third straight game, falling to the SeaWolves, 6-5. Richmond led, 5-4, entering the ninth. With two outs, an error allowed the inning to continue and Gage Workman tied the game with a double. Daniel Cabrera followed with a walk-off single. The SeaWolves opened a 3-0 lead in the first inning. **Andy Thomas** got the Flying Squirrels on the board with a solo homer in the second, his second this year. **Luis Matos** closed the score to 3-2 in the third with an RBI single. In the sixth, **Riley Mahan** tied the game with an RBI double and **Carter Williams** gave the Flying Squirrels a 5-3 lead with a two-run single. Wenceel Perez pulled the SeaWolves within a run in the seventh with a sac fly. Richmond starter **Kai-Wei Teng** allowed three runs, all in the first, and worked a season-high 4.2 innings, the longest outing for a Flying Squirrels starter this year. Thomas finished the game with a career-best four hits, going 4-for-4 with a homer.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the fourth of a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. The two teams met for a six-game series at The Diamond from April 18-23, with Richmond winning four-of-six. The SeaWolves return to The Diamond for a six-game set from May 30-June 4 and the Flying Squirrels close the regular season at UPMC Park from September 12-17. The Flying Squirrels are 13-13 against opponents from the Southwest Division and 7-5 in games following a loss.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** are in first place in the division, one game ahead of Akron. They split last week's six-game series at home against the Curve and have dropped four-of-their-last-five games, including each of the first three games in this week's series. The Flying Squirrels offense is ranked third in the Eastern League in batting average (.239). The Richmond pitching staff leads the EL in ERA (3.28) and ranks third in strikeouts (279).

**THE SEAWOLVES** were swept in five games against the Sea Dogs from April 26-30 before taking four-of-six against the Baysox in Bowie last week. They have won seven-of-their-last-nine games overall. In the Eastern League, the Erie offense ranks second in runs (153), second in homers (35) and second in RBIs (142). Erie's roster includes 10 of MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects, including RHP Wilmer Flores (No. 3), INF Colt Keith (No. 4), RHP Ty Madden (No. 5), INF Wenceel Perez (No. 8), C Dillon Dingler (No. 14), RHP Dylan Smith (No. 15), LHP Brant Hurter (No. 21), RHP Elvis Alvarado (No. 23), RHP Austin Bergner (No. 27) and INF Gage Workman (No. 29). Baseball America's top-30 Tigers prospects list includes Flores (No. 3), Madden (No. 4), Keith (No. 5), Dingler (No. 7), Smith (No. 17), Perez (No. 19), Hurter (No. 26) and Workman (No. 27). Baseball America also including the following Erie players on their Best Tools list: Perez (best hitter for average), Andrew Magno (best curveball), Flores (best control), Dingler (best defensive catcher) and Workman (best defensive infielder and best infield arm).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Ryan Murphy** makes his fifth start of the season and seventh-overall appearance. He last pitched on Saturday against the Curve and allowed two runs over 2.2 innings of work, striking out three. He has faced the SeaWolves twice this year, both at The Diamond. On April 18, he allowed three runs over four innings in a start. He pitched out of the bullpen on April 23 and surrendered two runs in 3.2 innings with our strikeouts. Last year, Murphy began the season with High-A Eugene and went 1-0 with a 2.90 ERA in seven starts. He was promoted to Double-A Richmond in late-June and made two starts before being placed on the injured list for most of the rest of the season. Murphy was selected in the fifth round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of Le Moyne College near Syracuse, N.Y., and was the highest-drafted Division II player that year. **For more on Murphy, see page two.**

**FOR ERIE:** Right-hander Wilmer Flores makes his seventh start of the year and his third against the Flying Squirrels. He pitched on Saturday at Bowie and worked five innings, allowing two runs, to pick up his first win this year. He pitched in Richmond on April 18 and allowed a season-high seven runs and eight hits in 2.2 innings in a loss. He started at The Diamond on April 23 and threw four scoreless, two-hit innings in a no-decision. Flores made two starts against the Flying Squirrels in 2022, both at The Diamond. On June 11, he surrendered two runs over five innings. On September 17, he threw six scoreless innings and allowed one hit in a win. In both of his 2022 starts against Richmond, he struck out a season-high eight batters. For his career against the Flying Squirrels, Flores is 1-1 with a 4.59 ERA (9 ER/17.2 IP) in four starts. Flores attended Arizona Western College, making just six relief appearances prior to signing as a free agent with the Tigers in 2020. In 2021, Flores pitched his first professional season, going 6-4 with a 3.68 ERA in 14 outings between the FCL and Low-A Lakeland. Flores is the younger brother of Giants infielder Wilmer Flores.

**LUCY, I'M HOME:** Shortstop **Marco Luciano** was activated with the Flying Squirrels on May 2 and made his official Double-A debut on May 3. He joined the Richmond roster for last year's Eastern League playoffs, going 1-for-8 at the plate in the Division Series against Erie in September. Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the Giants' No. 1 prospect and the No. 30 prospect in baseball. MLB.com has him rated as the Giants' No. 2 prospect and No. 20 overall. Baseball America also rates Luciano as the Giants' top power-hitting prospect. Last Thursday night, Luciano drove a 394-foot solo homer for his first Double-A hit. He has reached base in each of his six games started this season.

**FULL MUNGUA:** After going 0-for-15 over a three-game stretch from April 23-26, **Ismael Munguia** is batting .340 (16-for-47) with a homer, six doubles and five RBIs over his last 12 games, including six two-hit games. He kicked off the stretch on April 27 in Bowie with a homer on the third pitch of the game, his second Double-A home run. Munguia is tied for fifth in the league in hits (31) and tied for fourth in runs scored (19). For the year, he is batting .346 (9-for-26) in the first inning.

**MATOS MANIA:** **Luis Matos** reached base in each of his first 17 Double-A games, the second-longest on-base streak in the Eastern League this season. He has reached base in eight-of-his-10 games since then and in 26-of-28 games overall this season. For the year, Matos has struck out just 12 times in 119 plate appearances (10.1 percent), the second-lowest rate in the league. Matos clubbed his second Double-A homer in Sunday's win over the Curve and collected two hits, including a double, on Tuesday night to open this series against the SeaWolves. He drove an RBI single on Thursday. For the season, Matos is ranked ninth in the Eastern League in hits (29).

**BURGOS THE KING:** Reliever **Raymond Burgos** has pitched nine games without allowing an earned run this season, tied for the longest streak in the Eastern League, even with Harrisburg's Amos Willingham. The only run Burgos has allowed overall this season was an extra-innings placed runner in a loss to the Curve on May 3. Among Eastern League relievers (min. 8 G, no starts), Burgos ranks first in runners left on base (94.1%). He is one of two EL pitchers (min. 10 IP) with a 0.00 ERA this year, along with Bowie's Jensen Elliott.

**OLD FRIENDS:** Erie's roster includes former Flying Squirrels outfielder Diego Rincones, who signed with the Tigers as a free agent in December. Rincones played 142 games with Richmond over the 2021 and 2022 seasons, batting .269 (140-for-520) with 20 homers and 80 RBIs. Three total former Flying Squirrels are playing with other teams in the Eastern League this year. Pitcher Gray Fenter, who was with Richmond last season and with Bowie in 2021, is now with Somerset. First baseman Frankie Tostado, a member of the Flying Squirrels in 2021 and 2022, is now playing for Harrisburg.

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** In the Eastern League, **Tyler Fitzgerald** is ranked third in batting average (.324), seventh in OBP (.410), fourth in SLG (.588), fourth in OPS (.998), tied for first in triples (3) and tied for eighth in extra-base hits (11). **Ismael Munguia** tied for fifth in hits (31) and tied for fourth in runs scored (19). **Riley Mahan** is tied for seventh in RBIs (7). **Andy Thomas** is tied for ninth in walks (19). **Luis Matos** is ninth in hits (29). **Kai-Wei Teng** is eighth in ERA (2.63), tied for fifth in strikeouts (36), fourth in BAA (.171) and third in WHIP (0.96). **Juan Sanchez** and **Nick Swiney** are tied for second in wins (3). **Evan Gates** is tied for seventh in saves (3).

**WHERE THE SEAWOLVES RANK:** Among the Eastern League leaders, Wenceel Pérez is fifth in batting average (.306) and tied for ninth in runs (18). Colt Keith is tied for second in RBIs (20), tied for fifth in hits (31), tied for fifth in extra-base hits (12) and tied for fifth in total bases (54). Trei Cruz is ninth in SLG (.494). Gage Workman is tied for third in triples (2). Angel De Jesus is tied for first in games pitched (11).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Marco Luciano** (No. 1, No. 30 overall), **Luis Matos** (No. 5), **Mason Black** (No. 9), **Carson Seymour** (No. 12), **Landen Roupp** (No. 13), **Ryan Murphy** (No. 20), **Nick Swiney** (No. 24) and **Randy Rodriguez** (No. 30). Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the organization's best power hitter and Roupp is rated as having the best curveball. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Luciano (No. 2, No. 20 overall), Matos (No. 7), Black (No. 10), Roupp (No. 13), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).
