Round Rock and El Paso will prepare for game five of the series on Saturday, with first pitch at Dell Diamond slated for 7:05 p.m. Chihuahuas RHP Pedro Avila will start against Express RHP Fer Ozuna.

A FLASHY FRIDAY NIGHT

Round Rock ended their 10-game losing streak on Friday night after a 20-hit effort. With the bases loaded and two outs in the first inning, SS Davis Wendzel delivered the goods with a double that scored two and gave the E-Train the 2-0 advantage. In the third frame, Chihuahuas CF Jose Azocar drove home two runs with a single to tie the score. The Express answered back with three runs in the fourth inning. Round Rock made it 8-2 with another three-run inning in the fifth. Sale, Fabian and CF Rafael Ortega all scored on a combination of one walk and four singles, including three that came consecutively. A four-spot in the sixth inning gave the Express some insurance. Wendzel blasted a two-run home run onto the left field berm and with two out, DH Sam Huff sent both Whatley and Ortega home with a single to give Round Rock the 12-2 advantage.

OZUNA GETS THE NOD

Express RHP Fer Ozuna is scheduled to start on Saturday against the Chihuahuas. Ozuna will make his second start and his first since April 9. He has spent the majority of his time in the bullpen this season where he's 1-2 with a 9.00 ERA (12 ER/12.0 IP). He most recently appeared in relief on May 16 against El Paso where he did not allow a run in 1.0-inning of work while fanning two.

THE BATS ARE ALIVE

Last night, four Express players set a season high in hits, as RF Sandro Fabian, 3B Justin Foscoe, and DH Sam Huff each notched four knocks in the 12-2 win over the Chihuahuas. SS Davis Wendzel also had a season-high two hits. The 14 combined hits accounted for 70% of the team's 20 total. The 20 hits were tied for the most recorded at home in club history and are the most since June 21, 2013.

RELIEVERS RECORD ZEROS

Express relievers LHP Lucas Jacobsen, RHP Chase Lee, and LHP Josh Dye did not give up a run in their respective outings. They combined for five strikeouts and two walks in 3.2 innings of work. This is the bullpen's first scoreless outing since Jacobsen's 0.2-inning relief outing on May 3 in game one of the doubleheader.

HEAVY HITTER

After recording a season-high two hits and four RBI on Friday night, SS Davis Wendzel is batting .308 (4-13) against the Chihuahuas this season and has homered in back-to-back nights. In the series, he has also notched a double, 5 RBI, 3 runs, and just three strike outs. He's riding a four-game hitting streak, which is two shy of his season-high of six from April 11 - April 18.

BEAT THE STREAK

In Friday night's dominant 12-2 win over El Paso, Round Rock snapped their 10-game losing streak, which had tied the club-high, and is the first win at Dell Diamond this month. The win keeps the series up for grabs, with two games remaining in the six-game set.

ROSTER MOVES

On Saturday, the Express added RHP Cole Winn to the 7-day Injured List and added LHP Juan Mejia from Double-A Frisco. Mejia will wear #61 and has played in both High-A and Double-A this season before coming to Round Rock. With Frisco, Mejia posted an 0-1 record and a 9.95 ERA (7 ER/6.1 IP) in three games. The southpaw has a career 3.26 ERA (92 ER/254.0 IP) since began his professional career in 2017 with Texas.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2023 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's Pacific Coast League debut. Davis spent the previous two years as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.



In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
