HIT PARADE: After registering just one hit through the first three innings, the Storm Chasers put up a season-high 10 runs on 13 hits—including three home runs—in a 10-7 win over Indianapolis. **INF Alcides Escobar** went 4-for-4 with a home run and four RBIs, **INF Ryan McBroom** went 3-for-4 with a double and a homer, and **INF Emmanuel Rivera** hit a solo homer to give Omaha the lead for good in the seventh inning. All three of Omaha's home runs on Wednesday were go-ahead home runs. It was Omaha's eighth game with 10+ hits in 19 games; the offense is averaging just below nine hits per game. **LHP Gabe Speier** allowed one baserunner but notched his eighth consecutive scoreless appearance in the ninth inning to earn his fourth save.

ELECTRIC ESKY: After starting his Storm Chasers career 2-for-23 (.087), **INF Alcides Escobar** went 4-for-4 with a home run and tied a career-high with four RBIs on Wednesday. Escobar's two-run homer in the seventh traveled an estimated 447 feet. Since his professional debut in 2004, Escobar now has 20 career four-hit games and eight career four-RBI games, including four four-RBI games at the Major League level with Kansas City. The last time Escobar had four RBIs in a single game was on July 28, 2019, when he went 3-for-5 with a home run for Triple-A Charlotte (Chicago - AL) against Pawtucket (Triple-A Boston), which was his second four-RBI game of the 2019 season. His first four-RBI game came on July 7, 2006, while playing for Brevard County (High-A Milwaukee). Wednesday was his first career game at any level with four hits and four RBIs.

THE BIG "O": **OF Edward Olivares** ranks in the top 10 in Triple-A East in nearly every offensive category. Olivares is fourth in AVG (.384), fifth in OBP (.464), sixth in SLG (.658), third runs scored (18), second in hits (28), tied for ninth in home runs (5), tied for sixth in RBIs (16), and tied for sixth in stolen bases (6). He is also second in the league in wOBA (.483) and third in wRC+ (200). The 25-year-old did not play for the first time this season on Wednesday after hitting leadoff in each of the team's first 18 games. Overall, Olivares has recorded nine multi-hit games while hitting safely in 15 of 18 games and reaching base safely in 16 of 18 games, which includes a nine-game hitting streak and 14-game on-base streak to begin the season.

PROSPECT-STUDDERED ROTATION: Each member of Omaha's starting rotation is one of the Kansas City Royals top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America*. **LHP Daniel Lynch**, who made his first Omaha start on Tuesday, is the No. 2 prospect in the Royals organization, while **RHP Jackson Kowar** is No. 4, **RHP Carlos Hernández** is No. 15, **RHP Ronald Bolaños** is No. 18, and **RHP Scott Blewett** is No. 25. Lynch (No. 21) and Kowar (No. 84) are also both top-100 prospects overall. The Storm Chasers roster currently boasts eight of the Royals' top 30 prospects with the inclusion of position players **OF Kyle Isbel** (6), **OF Edward Olivares** (19), and **INF Lucius Fox** (22).

RIVALRY RENEWED: Tuesday marked the first game between Omaha and Indianapolis since 1997, when both franchises were members of the American Association. Omaha is 267-280 (.488) all-time against Indianapolis during the regular season and 9-11 (.450) in four postseason meetings. Omaha defeated Indianapolis in the 1978 American Association Championship Series while Indianapolis claimed American Association Championship Series wins in 1982-, 1988, and 1989.

BREEZING ABOARD: **C Meibrys Vilorio** extended his on-base streak to 12 games on Wednesday. In that span (since May 6), Vilorio is 13-for-38 (.361) with a .468 on-base percentage. His overall on-base percentage of .451 ranks 9th among Triple-A East hitters with a minimum of 50 plate appearances. Vilorio has drawn a walk in four straight games.

FOR OMAHA: **RHP Ronald Bolaños** makes his third start of the season for Omaha after allowing four runs (three earned) on three hits with five walks and five strikeouts in 5.1 IP against Iowa last week. Wednesday marks just his third start because of a missed start on 5/13 at Columbus, when he was a late scratch in advance of being appointed as the 27th man for Kansas City's scheduled doubleheader on 5/14 at Chicago (AL). Bolaños was returned to Omaha following the doubleheader, which he did not appear in.

FOR INDIANAPOLIS: **RHP James Marvel** makes his fourth start of the season for Indianapolis following 5.1 IP with one unearned run on three hits with four strikeouts and three walks in his last outing on 5/21 at St. Paul. Marvel posted a 2.67 ERA in his first 11 Triple-A starts in 2019 after being named an Eastern League All-Star with Double-A Altoona en route to making his Major League debut with Pittsburgh on Sept. 8, 2019. In four starts with the Pirates, Marvel recorded an 8.31 ERA with nine strikeouts and six walks in 17.1 innings.

DOPPLER RADAR: **OF Kyle Isbel**, a left-handed hitter, pulls the ball 59.3% of the time, the fourth-highest pull rate among qualified Triple-A East hitters... **INF Ryan McBroom** has the seventh-highest pull rate at 57.1%.
